Dear Sir,

On March 20, 1974, I wrote a letter to Supervisor Kohinke urging his support and Town Council support for an Architectural Review Board for the Town of Bethlehem. I have not yet had a reply. In my letter I expressed concern about the development of Delaware Avenue from "Gasoline Alley" of the 60's to the "Banker's Row" of the 70's without any concept or plan for the total environment. I indicated that our builders are attempting to create a colonial-type atmosphere, while our commercial builders are building "ticky-tackey boxes." One look at the last two bank buildings along Delaware Avenue will reveal one with a concern for the aesthetic and the other with a concern for cost. As a result, one is quite good-looking and the other is merely a box with windows.

Wouldn't it have been better to have developed an architectural design for the ENTIRE four-corners area and then have future buildings conform to the plan, than to have a rather random building pattern that has developed so far? I think an Architectural Review Board composed of experts in architecture, landscape architec-

ture, real estate and other related professions would help to reduce the number of structures which are visually offensive or inappropriate to the town. I sent our Supervisor a copy of Architectural Review Boards which were established in the Village of Bellerose and the Town of Warwick, N.Y. as possible models. It is my sincere hope that the Town Council will discuss the matter soon and that action is taken before Delaware Avenue is completely developed.

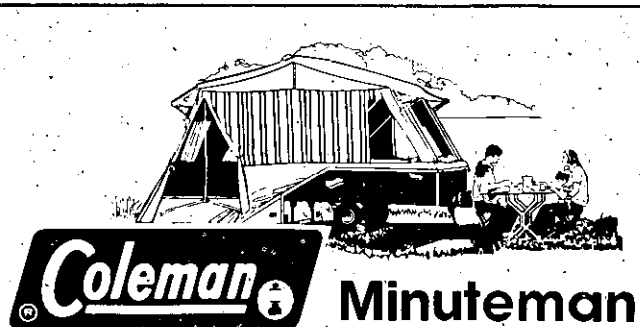
Badlands
