Vote Again!

Residents of the Bethlehem Central School District will have the chance to vote again next week on two budget propositions, interscholastic athletics. and pupil instructional supplies.

The polls will be open next Wed., Aug. 7, from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., in the Middle School gymnasium:

These two budget propositions were defeated by the voters on July 10, along with a proposition allowing for purchase of equipment — on which there will be no re-vote.

The Board of Education voted unanimously at a special meeting on July 18 to submit the two propositions to a second elec-The Board was legally required to re-submit the athletics item, because it received petitions containing more than 3,000 signatures of district residents, requesting another vote. The petition drive supporting a re-vote on interscholastic athletics was spearheaded by the Bethlehem Athletic Association.

Petitions for another vote on the pupil supplies item were. also submitted to the Board, containing the signatures of 1,232 residents. The Board decided to include the item, on the re-election ballot, due to the impact its omission from the budget would have on district parents and to the narrow, (13-vote) margin of its original defeat.

.While there has been insufficient time for the school district to prepare and mail any information on the re-vote directly to district residents, Board members strongly urge voter support of the two propositions.

The proposition to provide pupil instructional supplies totals \$58,300, and would add

If this amount is not included in the contingency budget which it cannot be according to State Education Law without voter approval - parents of all district pupils would be legally required to pay for their children's supplies.

If this proposition were defeated again, parents would have to pay an average of \$13.20 per child for supplies. The district has been advised by State Education Department officials that it would have to bill parents for supplies, prior to the start of the school year. and that those children whose parents don't pay the bill could not receive the supplies.

Board and staff members feel very strongly that defeat of this proposition would be most unfortunate, in terms of possible educational inequalities and also the administrative costs and time that would be in-.curred.

School tax rates will not be as high as were originally projected because both the assessment increase in the Town of Bethlehem and the district's budget balance are higher than were estimated when a budget had to be submitted to the voters in June.

If both the propositions pass and are added to the contingency budget, the Bethlehem tax rate increase will amount to about \$4.79 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation, and the New Scotland increase will be about \$16.83 per \$1,000. In spite of the lower-than-predicted tax rate increases, however, these two items must receive voter approval or they cannot be included in the contingency budget.






