# INDUSTRIAL GIANT

The final phase of construction, the installation of manufacturing equipment, has begun at the Owens-Corning Fiberglas Corporation plant being built outside Delmar on Waldenmaier Road.

The plant, which is scheduled to begin operation in mid-1975, is initially expected to employ more than 250 persons.

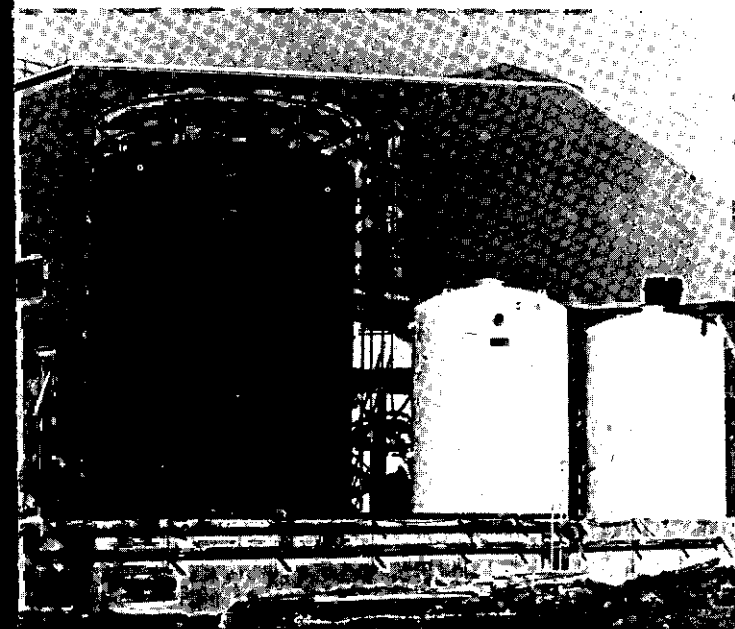
"The plant building is almost completely enclosed and we intend to begin heating the facility in December," explained plant manager Richard Webb. "We are now moving in the process equipment and will be installing the manufacturing line during the coming months."

Webb said, "We expect to have the office portion of the plant in condition to be occupied by mid-March. Landscaping will begin this spring."

The new facility will manufacture glass fiber insulation for residential, commercial and industrial applications, principally for the Northeastern portion of the nation. The 80,000 square foot building, parking lot and auxiliary buildings require little more than 20 of the site's 200 acres.

Owens-Corning, the world's leading manufacturer of glass fibers, has headquarters in Toledo, Ohio; 19 plants operating in the U.S.; subsidiaries in Europe, Brazil and Columbia; and affiliates in seven other countries. The company employs more than 20,000 people.

The new Delmar facility will employ the latest environmental control technology developed for manufacturing facilities of this type.
