Gipsy Moths

The Bethlehem Environmental Council will again check the occurrence of Gipsy Moths in the Town. Last year they were found in seven localities. Natural predators do a reasonably efficient job of controlling this pest which, should it reach epidemic proportions, would defoliate most of our trees and shrubs so continued vigilance is required.

The caterpillar, in early summer, is about one inch long, dark-colored, and with long hairs. The common tent caterpillar, with which it might be confused, is larger, multi-colored, and short-haired in June and July. If you find cater-
