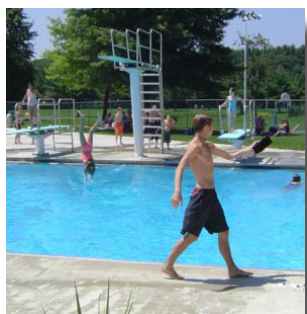

Down in a hole

City of Albany to investigate leak under Delaware Avenue this week

DELMAR — If you've recently driven through Delaware Avenue between Booth Road and the Normans Kill, you would have noticed the message boards stating "ROAD WORK TO BEGIN 12/4/19."

The City of Albany Department of Water and Water Supply will investigate and repair a suspected leak somewhere along a near one-mile stretch of Delaware Avenue, starting on Wednesday, Dec. 4.

One of the two large, electronic traffic message boards is located near Delmar Beverage Center and the other near Old Delaware Avenue. A few construction vehicles were already parked near the Speedway gas station as of Friday, Nov. 29.

the card has since been made available in the Spotlight's Nov. 27 issue, at the Delmar Turkey Trot, the Bethlehem Chamber's office on weekdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., and at every Delmar Farmer's Market throughout December.

William Simcoe, the department's deputy commissioner, said the nature and extent of that suspected leak are not confirmed, but it is not being treated as an immediate emergency.

"A couple of weeks ago, we started getting calls about a puddle there and we took some samples," he said. "We think it's our leak and then we put up the leak detectors to see if we can locate it. There aren't a lot of spots to put in the leak detectors. On Monday [Dec. 2], we'll do a test pad and try to get a better location. We're doing some investigative work to make sure we're digging in the right location and then we'll dig to repair it."

This would then lead to the official start of work on Wednesday, Dec. 4.

Simcoe said repairs to the leak could take a few days, but a pending snowstorm forecasted for Sunday and Monday could affect the project's timeline.

On Friday, the National Weather Service reported a forecast of a snowstorm with an undisclosed amount of accumulation on Sunday and Monday, Dec. 1 and 2, which is expected to impact local travel.

When asked if there is a possibility of a water main break during the repairs, Simcoe said, "We'll be taking this main down so we will have to shut it down and partially drain it and hopefully repair it. It is a process where we have to carefully take pressure off the main."

The work's impact on traffic would depend on where the exact location of the suspected leak is, which has not been confirmed yet. Simcoe said that the state Department of Transportation has created a traffic plan for this and "we'll try to maintain two-way traffic. It depends on where we have to dig."

Bethlehem Police Department Cmdr. Adam Hornick wrote in an email to Spotlight News that his crew and the town's Public Works department are aware of the project.

"Our officers and Town Department of Public Works officials saw water in the road there for the last few weeks and alerted Albany officials," he stated. "They have told us that there will be one-lane traffic in each direction during the work."

George Kansas, the commissioner of Public Works, has been the town's main contact person for the state Department of Transportation and City of Albany for this project, according to Simcoe, but Kansas was not available for comment on Friday.

Town Supervisor David VanLuven said he has been in contact with Simcoe about the project and its purpose too.

Delaware Avenue is home to several retail businesses, including Delaware Plaza. While it is the holiday season now, Simcoe said local retailers have been notified, and that they will continue to be notified with information.

Spotlight News reached out to the DOT and Delaware Plaza managing director Debbie Nolan Murray. A DOT spokesperson referred to Simcoe's department for comment while Murray was not available in time of this publication.

Early snow slams region

First snowfall dumps more than 13 inches across Capital District, closes schools

ALBANY COUNTY — It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas...with a thick blanket of fluffy, white snow covering the ground.

The area's first snowfall broke a 50-year-old record by nearly 10 inches.

Gov. Andrew Cuomo ordered non-essential state employees to stay home. The University at Albany canceled Monday classes, anticipating students returning from Thanksgiving break would be challenged by the storm as they returned back to school. By Monday morning, more than 300 schools and institutions closed for the day.

The Capital District accumulated snow at a speedy interval, falling as early as Sunday afternoon. For Sunday, Dec. 1, the National Weather Service reported 13.3 inches in Albany. The previous record for the day was 3.7 inches, set in 1969.

Snow was forecasted to continue until 4 a.m. Monday morning, dumping another 5 to 11 inches of snow through Tuesday morning. Snow totals are expected to reach anywhere from 12 to 24 inches, according to the Weather Service.

Winter storm warnings will be in effect until 7 a.m. Tuesday, with heavy snow tapering off around daybreak. Up to half an inch of snow is possible Tuesday, with continuing cold temperatures. Light snow showers were forecasted for Wednesday.

The temperature reached a high of 28 degrees and a low of 17, with an average of 23. This figure was 13 degrees colder than average.

Coat drive for veterans

Keeping veterans warm for the winter season

ALBANY — The annual Albany County coat drive for veterans is happening now through Monday, Dec. 9.

County Executive Daniel P. McCoy said, “There are thousands of veterans living in Albany County and each of them deserve to know how much we appreciate everything they have done for us and let them know Albany County cares about our veterans.”

He continued, “At the beginning of my administration, we asked for new or gently used coats, but have expanded to include hats, scarves, gloves and boots and have been

able to provide thousands of warm pieces of clothing over the past seven years.”

The drive originally started in 2012 to help equip veterans with what they need for the winter season.

This year, it is the result of a collaboration between Crossgates Mall and Best Cleaners.

Clothes are cleaned by the latter, then distributed by the Homeless and Travelers Aid Society (HATAS) and the Veterans Miracle Center.

“The Albany County Cares Program provides desperately needed winter coats to homeless persons within Albany County. Every gently used or new coat is given to a homeless man, woman or child in need,” said Liz Hitt, the executive director of HATAS. “Please help us keep our neighbors in need warm and dry this holiday season by donating today.”

“Once again the VMC is honored to be included in this program to support our veterans in need.

Since mid-October the demand for warm winter coats has increased and we are struggling to fill all of the requests,” said Melody Burns, Director of Operations at Veterans Miracle Center. “The donation of a warm winter coat will put a smile on the face of our veterans who utilize our services and ensure a little warmth for the winter ahead.”

She added, “Since opening in November 2014, the Veterans Miracle Center has been serving our veterans in need. The support of our community has made it possible to meet the daily needs of almost 12,000 veterans to date.”

Clothing items may be dropped off at any Best Cleaners, a box outside Lord & Taylor on the lower

level at Crossgates Mall or at Albany County office buildings at 112 State St., 162 Washington Ave. and 175 Green St. through Monday, Dec. 9.

“As always, Crossgates is happy to offer up space to our local partners and help support our community. Albany County Cares Coat Drive is a prime example of this,” said Erin Moore, Crossgates Management Office’s assistant marketing director. “Together, Albany County and Crossgates make it easy and convenient for mall employees and shoppers to simply drop a coat in the collection box on their way to work or to go holiday shopping.”

She concluded, “It is great to know that the coats donated will go to veterans, and their families, within the Capital Region.”

Residents 'pooled' to offer input

Town Board hears the public's comments on dive pool situation

BETHLEHEM — More than a dozen Bethlehem residents appeared before the Town Board during its Nov. 26 meeting to mostly voice their support for saving the dive pool, either by repairing the original or having a replacement one.

The town has been considering two options — a new replacement dive pool or a new double-slide pool — as the original dive pool, built in 1973, is beyond repair.

The Town Board also voted to approve more design work on both pool options in order to put them out to bid. After the public comment period, Jason Gallo, the town's

Parks and Recreation administrator, noted that the double-slide pool would need two lifeguards, unlike how a dive pool needs just one, and anyone over 48 inches, or four feet, can use

it. "I think that we should keep the diving pool because some kids want to learn how to dive and they can get really good at it and swimming is really

good for your health," said Joe, a young boy whose comments induced applause from the public. "And if you dive and some people want to learn how to swim and dive, that can be really

useful. Sometimes when you want to show off since you might know how to dive, you might want to do that. And that's all I have to say."

Applause also ensued when a young girl named Lilly chimed in, "All I want to say is I want to dive and I've never dived. So next year, if the diving [pool] ever comes back, I want to try to dive."

Adults also shared their perspectives. "I'm a staunch supporter of the dive board option; I don't think you have that anywhere else," said Delmar resident Mary Witting. "I do think this is a great opportunity for our children and for our future. I don't think slides offer that opportunity."

Resident James McGaughan said he had expected the original dive pool to be repaired regardless of the cost since it had been a popular attraction for more than four decades.

He also brought up how the town had already gauged public input last summer.

"We already did a survey," he said. "So I hear a lot about 'Let's do a new survey, let's get new evidence.' In the academic world, we call this p-hacking where you constantly change parameters until you get the answer you want. You already did your survey and you found out that 68 percent of the town wants to rebuild it at any cost."

McGaughan was referring to a free online 10-question dive pool-related survey that was taken by 1,230 residents this past summer.

The results showed that 826 residents, or 68 percent, said they believe the dive pool should be repaired regardless of the cost.

Also, 876 people, or 72

in, "When you look at communities that are bustling and are strong, you find a strong commercial sector. And whether it's restaurants, hardware stores, banks, opticians, beverage centers, breweries or more, these are places where people cross paths and connect and they're also places that give so much back to our community."

He continued, "If you want to

percent, said they would still visit the pool complex if the dive pool was no longer part of it.

Furthermore, 745 people, or 62 percent, said they would prefer a slide pool if the town decides not to rebuild the dive pool.

"As we stand here today, we already lost one summer," McGaughan continued, referencing how the original dive pool was closed this past summer. "We're looking at potentially losing another summer and I think instead of taking a whole bunch of time, I think it's time to make a decision and move forward."

In contrast, one resident, Emily

Field, was the only one who did not support a dive pool moving forward. Field, a mother of three young children, said that she initially understood why other residents feel nostalgic about the dive pool and prefer retaining it for the future.

She also brought up that she first learned to swim and dive at the town's pool complex more than 30 years ago, and has made new memories there again when her young son dared her to go off the high diving board two summers ago. However, she said her middle child, aged five with special needs, is not able to swim in a pool like her son.

"It may be a number of years before she will learn that skill," Field said. "A slide option would be fun for all of us. Ask your kids, what do they want? ... We are extremely lucky to live in this community

and have all these wonderful opportunities. But just because something has always been, doesn't mean it always needs to be."

Prior to the meeting, the dive pool situation had already been on the public's mind as 1,857 people signed an online petition called "Save the Bethlehem Town Park Dive Pool" from Nov. 19 to 22.

Resident Stephanie Dwyer started the petition and said, "We're telling you that it's important to us. Why change something that's worked since it opened? People want their voices to be heard."

Her petition closed when Town Supervisor David VanLuyen announced on Friday, Nov. 22 that the Town Board will use the next two months to continue discussing with the public about how to move forward with the dive pool situation.



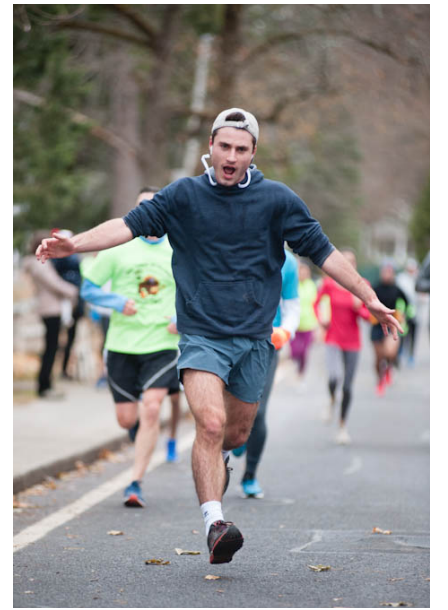

LETTER TO THE EDITOR

Stop the Glenmont roundabout

Dear Editor,

I urge the stoppage of the planned roundabout construction in Glenmont reported on in the Nov. 20 Spotlight edition. I do so for two reasons: it will be difficult to impossible for pedestrians to cross the street to the many stores and facilities at this location and because the perceived traffic problem can be addressed by less costly left hand turning lanes.

The public pronouncement of the need for this costly construction project is two fold: speed up delays in traffic and prevent accidents by turning vehicles. Both are misleading at best and not sufficient justification for this expensive project.

The pedestrians crossing Route 9W and Glenmont and Feura Bush Road are varied and numerous. Conditions at this location are not the same as the roundabout in Slingerlands on New Scotland Road. where there

are few, if any, pedestrians. People of all ages and abilities cross these roads facilitated by the sidewalks on Feura Bush Road. I often see people with babies in carriages or strollers crossing. Children on bikes frequent this location. People walk to the various stores all year long even in winter. I think there are people who walk to the Price Chopper mall to get the CDTA No. 7 bus into Albany as an alternative to driving. Pedestrian safety is paramount over a small reduction in motorist commute time.

The current presence of a full traffic light enables people with various abilities and disabilities to safely cross this intersection. There is at least one group home, located on Feura Bush Road. There may be more in the future.

I fear that the planned flashing red lights will not stop motorists encountering pedestrians especially those motorists who are in the process of increasing vehicle speed while exiting the roundabout.

Four of the six planned crosswalks are located where vehicles are exiting the roundabout and increasing speed. When motorists do stop for pedestrians, there is a risk of the vehicle getting rear ended.

The public presentation of the designs noted that the delay will be shortened only at the Feura Bush intersection and did not address total commute time. The shorting of time is estimated to be 30 seconds. We are spending \$5 million for 30 seconds.

Due to the several traffic lights between this intersection and the intersection of 9W and Corning Hill Road, this single roundabout will not meaningfully shorten the commute time, especially during the rush hours.

Although the public presentations refer to a reduction in current right-angle and head-on crashes, it lacked the exact numbers of such accidents, the time of day that the reputed accidents occurred,

the underlying causes, their frequency and a comparison to other heavily trafficked areas.

Perhaps eliminating the right turn permitted by both the traffic lights and the right on red allowance will significantly reduce these accidents without road modifications. This alternative does not seem to have been pursued.

There are alternatives that do not seem to have been explored. The simplest is construction of traffic light controlled left hand turning lanes. Pedestrian bridges over the roads is another alternative. This used to be very common. A ramp bridge over the roads could easily be built and would not interfere with the roundabout. Design would require a gentle ramp to accommodate wheel chairs. Yes, I have seen people cross these streets while in motorized wheelchairs or similar devices.

The current motorist backup is not a day long problem but

rather presents itself for about two hours a day, the morning and evening commute times.

The plan calls for spending almost \$5 million from various sourced grants. This may increase due to increased costs either unexpected or inflation.

The town has more important priorities such as the extension of sewers, and preservation of open space.

We should be doing things that encourage the reduction in carbon emissions.

We should be working with CDTA to extend the bus routes further on 9W to encourage greater use of public transportation.

The irony of slowing down Delaware Avenue, the other major road construction planned, for the benefit of bicyclists, and speeding up 9W to the detriment of pedestrians is not lost on the voters.

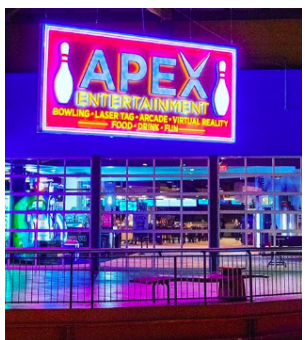

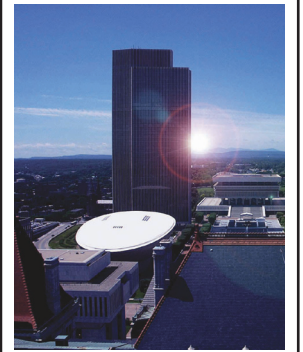

Alanis coming to SPAC

Alanis Morissette to bring Garbage, Liz Phair to SPAC as part of Jagged Little Pill tour

SARATOGA SPRINGS — Next year marks 25 years since Alanis Morissette shared her anger to the world with the release of her five-time Grammy Award-winning album “Jagged Little Pill.”

Since then, she doesn't seem so angry.

On Monday, Dec. 2, the Canadian-native announced a 31-stop, “Jagged Little Pill” 25th anniversary tour to launch next June. The bill will feature a nostalgic touch of 90s magic, with performances from Morissette, Garbage and Liz Phair. The tour stops at Saratoga Performing Arts Center on Wednesday, July 8, 2020.

Peering through her social media, Morissette looks ironically content with a husband, kids and nothing that resembles the angst and frustration of life and love as a 20-something in the 90s.

Her hit single “You Oughtta Know” quickly became an anthem for Gen-Xers who felt cheated out of love. By the time her tour made it to the RPI Fieldhouse in February 1996, she couldn't start a concert without an arena full of people singing the song back to her on cue.

“Why are you so angry,” she asked in jest.

“Jagged Little Pill” went on to sell more than 33 million copies, earning her the distinction as the first Canadian musician to earn double diamond status in record sales. Morissette earned nine Grammy nominations, and took five trophies home, including Album of the Year. Rolling Stone magazine named the album among its 500 Greatest Albums of All Time in 2003.

Garbage blasted onto the scene with its self-titled, debut album in the Summer of 1995. “Stupid Girl” and “I'm Only Happy When It Rains,” fueled enough popularity for recognition from Grammy voters who nominated the band for Best New Artist, Best Rock Song and Best Rock Performance by a Duo or Group.

Liz Phair's “Exile in Guyville” is also on Rolling Stone's list of 500 Greatest Albums of All Time. The album was re-released in 2018 to celebrate its 25th anniversary.

Let's try this again

Apex Entertainment will fill void left behind by Lucky Strike Social

ALBANY — Another recreational venue plans to open its doors at Crossgates Mall before the end of the year.

Apex Entertainment has planned a soft opening for its recreational venue at Crossgates Mall within the next two weeks. This will be the third location for the Massachusetts-based company since opening its maiden storefront in Marlborough, Massachusetts two years ago. It has another location in Syracuse.

The 57,000-square foot space was occupied by Lucky Strike Social until it shuttered its doors in June. Apex Entertainment offers a similar blend of adult and family-friendly entertainment. Attractions will be paired with a restaurant that offers American cuisine, a full-service bar and a 2,500-square foot space for corporate meetings and social gatherings. Despite the similarities, the venue promises to have a different look.

"We have redone the entire location," stated Sam Miller, Apex Entertainment's marketing manager. "It looks nothing like it used to."

Apex Entertainment falls in line with the caliber of attractions Crossgates continues to lure in for its visitors. Instead of a retail-heavy collection of storefronts, the mall also provides a dining and hospitality destination to complement the shopping experience.

In recent years, Crossgates has signed new leases to Dave & Buster's, Funny Bone comedy club, Skyloft and Spa Mirbeau. Last October, it opened the doors to Tru by Hilton, a 192-room, dual-brand hotel off Western Avenue. Packaged together, it turns Crossgates Mall from a shopping location to a tourist attraction.

Apex Entertainment's Crossgates location is said to boast more than 65 arcade games, including a virtual reality experience, two escape rooms and a 4,000-square foot laser tag arena. It will also have 22 bowling lanes, four for Candlepin.

One notable omission from Apex Entertainment's list of amenities is that of a concert venue. Lucky Strike Social had welcomed a wide-range of entertainment inside its Jupiter Hall; live music, review shows and mixed martial arts events.

When Skyloft opened in April, it drew more attention to the live-music space left behind by the previous tenant, Rascals Steakhouse. Skyloft is co-owned by Ivan Spiers, who also co-owns Daryl's House Club in Dutchess County. With an established pipeline for attracting national music acts, Skyloft threaten Lucky Strike Social before it opened.

Skyloft opened its live music venue with a show featuring Jaimoe's Jassz Band in late April. Within two months, Lucky Strike Social closed its doors, with tentative reports Apex Entertainment planned to move in.

Lucky Strike Social continues to maintain more than 20 locations throughout the country, including locations in Boston, New York, Chicago and Honolulu.

The right way to leave a job

A new year often sparks change. Many people aspire to change jobs at the dawn of a new year, and such changes are more frequent than one might think.

According to a 2018 report from the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the average person changes jobs between 10 and 15 times during his or her career. In addition, many workers spend five years or less in each job.

• Don't shirk responsibilities. It can be tempting to slack off when another job awaits. The popular job-hunting site Monster.com says it can be human nature to do less when long-term accountability is removed. However, you never know when you might need a referral or even a new job. Leaving a bitter taste in the mouth of your employer at the end of your work history can put a black mark on your



employee record.

• Take coworkers' feelings into consideration. Be open and honest with coworkers, but do not gloat that you are leaving the company and they are not. And if anyone has strong feelings about your departure, accept their point of view

and do not react outwardly. Take things in stride as much as possible.
