Our changing world

State policies grow increasingly aggressive each day as attempts to combat spread of COVID-19 continue

As of Monday, March 16 there are 15 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Albany County with 90 people under mandatory quarantine and another 367 under precautionary quarantine. There are 950 confirmed cases in the state, 2,134 in the country and at least 145,317 in the world.

Those numbers will most surely change by the time this paper hits the streets on Wednesday, March 18.

Delmar power outage

Thousands went dark for two hours in Delmar, Elsmere

BETHLEHEM

— Witnesses described a loud crash and the ground shaking around the Adams Street substation as power was knocked out for more than 2,500 residents just after noon on Friday, March 13.

A transformer failed at the National Grid substation located near the intersection of Adams Street and Hudson Avenue in Delmar.

The power went out at approximately 12:05 p.m. in portions of Delmar and Elsmere, including shops in Delaware Plaza.

The Hannaford Supermarket closed its doors as the store went dark.



Numerous stoplights stopped working across Delmar due to the power outage, affecting vehicular traffic and causing temporary confusion at intersections.

the call. According to National Grid's website, the power

was to have been restored by 2 p.m.



Motor vehicle accident

DELMAR — A two-vehicle crash occurred on Friday, March 13 at 12:28 p.m. at the intersection of Elsmere and Herber avenues.

According to police reports, 61-year-old Albany resident Richard J. Thomas was crossing Elsmere Avenue from Herber Avenue to East Poplar Drive in his 2012 Hyundai. In doing so, it entered the path of a 2014 Chevrolet, driven by 73-year-old Delmar resident Kathleen A. Timmany, and the vehicles crashed.

No citations were issued that day. Delmar-Bethlehem EMS responded to the scene, assessed the vehicle occupants and no one was hospitalized.

Host of charges

GLENMONT — A 44-year-old Menands man was arrested on a host of charges on Tuesday, Feb. 18, at 8:21 p.m. at 760 Route 9W.

Bethlehem police, Albany County paramedics and Delmar-Bethlehem EMS responded to a motor vehicle collision. Police noted a green Nissan Maxima in the woods around 200 feet off Route 9W's southbound shoulder.

An investigation determined the vehicle was traveling northbound on Route 9W at a speed that caused the driver to lose control, strike a guardrail, cross the road's double-yellow lane markers into the southbound lane, strike a few trees and come to a stop.

Police observed its driver standing beside the car and he identified himself as Jose L. Villafane.

While Albany County paramedics and Delmar-Bethlehem EMS attended to Villafane's injuries, police interviewed him and noted an odor of alcohol from his breath, his slurred speech and bloodshot eyes. Villafane allegedly said he consumed alcohol before driving. Since he was injured, field sobriety tests were not conducted.

Villafane was transported to Albany Medical Center Hospital and arrested at 9:04 p.m.; his vehicle was towed. He is scheduled to appear at the Bethlehem Town Court on Tuesday, March 3, at 5:30 p.m.

Villafane was charged with a DWI, speed not reasonable and prudent, failure to keep right and driving with an open container of alcohol.

BCHS senior is a champion wordsmith

Wrote about social justice, volunteerism, investment strategy

BETHLEHEM — A Bethlehem Central High School senior won first place statewide and seventh place nationwide in the national InvestWrite competition.

Maggie Reynolds, 17, received the first-place trophy and \$200 worth of credit gift cards on Wednesday, Feb. 26, from InvestWrite's sponsor, the Securities Industry and Financial Markets Association (SIFMA).

"That's really crazy, I would not have ever guessed that this would happen so I'm really surprised about it," she said.

According to the district's website, the InvestWrite competition took place last fall and required students to pen an essay about a dream they want to achieve; include a hypothetical financial plan to pay for that dream and pitch to virtual investors; describe stocks, bonds or mutual funds that can help the investment; and

offer short- and long-term investment advice.

Reynolds chose to write about a hypothetical \$750,000 investment plan for Refugee and Immigrant Support Services of Emmaus (RISSE), an Albany-based non-profit immigrant and refugee services organization, where she has been a volunteer for a year and a half.

"I thought that would be the perfect thing to write about and do more

research on like what things it could invest in," she said. "I've volunteered there, tutoring immigrants for the naturalization test. I've gotten to know a lot of people there."

When asked why she focused on RISSE, she said she would like the organization to expand to have locations in Troy and Schenectady one day.

"I wrote about the stocks and bonds that I would invest in to have a high

rate of return to be able to expand the organization successfully," she continued.

Reynolds added her volunteerism and essay stem from her interest in social justice and political science; she also has a background in investment strategy.

"Writing the essay wasn't super difficult, it was pretty enjoyable because it was something about what I'm interested in," she said.

Reynolds first heard of

the competition from her economics teacher, Jason Majewski, who mentioned it in class and encouraged her to do it last October.

"This year, students were asked to reflect on a famous quote by Oprah Winfrey who said, 'Whatever our dreams, ideas, projects, we plant a seed, nurture it and then reap the fruits of our labor,'" said Majewski. "The essay prompt is exactly what I hope for all my students. Every student has a dream and the potential to make a difference. It is my job to help them along the way with opportunities to build his or her human capital."

He continued, "Maggie Reynolds is an awesome student, who with this investment opportunity, showed what is possible with goals and hard work." Once Reynolds drafted her essay, he looked through it and offered advice to her before she submitted it.

"I then didn't know I won until Mr. Majewski told me to come to his room one day so I didn't know what was happening," Reynolds said. "I was very surprised because I submitted it a while ago and I didn't really expect that winning or anything like that would happen."

Reynolds continues to volunteer at RISSE, which gave her a shout-out on its Facebook page on Tuesday, March 10.

"I hope that since I did talk about RISSE in my essay and it's published by the school, I hope that people do read it and more people start to volunteer or do things at RISSE," she said. "I want to give credit to them. I think it's a successful well-run organization but it's always good to get more volunteers and people committed to it."

Looking ahead, Reynolds wants to study political science and history at a university this fall. "I don't know where yet because many college decisions are coming back in the next couple of weeks but I'm still really interested in social justice too so I want to keep working with immigrants and volunteering, which can involve economic classes for political science," she concluded.

BCHS to snooze morning bell in fall

Considering student wellness and bus transportation

BETHLEHEM — Bethlehem Central High School is considering moving its morning bell from 7:35 to 8 a.m. as early as this fall.

First considered in 2018, the district's School Start Time Committee announced the proposal at the Feb. 26 Board of Education meeting this year.

It did not recommend a delayed morning bell for the district's five elementary schools though. But the middle school's start time may be altered by five minutes to accommodate the high school's new start time.

Both plans for the middle and high schools have not been confirmed.

"There is still quite a bit of work to be done before this could be implemented for September," said Superintendent Jody Monroe. "What the actual schedule might look like and what our new high school dismissal time will

be are details that need to be finalized first. After those are determined, our focus will turn to stakeholder outreach so our students and staff, parents and the community at large are fully informed of the reasons for the switch and what, if any, impact will accompany this change."

Monroe added that the delayed morning bell is

being considered because the district wants to continue addressing student wellness.

A recent transportation study found school bus transportation, routes and schedules can still serve students and have little or no impact on the district's budget.

This in-depth feasibility study was conducted by

a district-hired private transportation consultant, School Bus Consultants (SBC), in 2019.

An initial proposal to have the high school start at 8:30 a.m. — which would have forced the elementary schools to start at 7:35 a.m. and finish and 1:35 p.m. — was rejected last September. The Board of Education felt it was "such a drastic

change for elementary students and instead asked the consultants to focus on a transportation plan that could allow both the middle school and high school to start at 8 a.m.," according to the district's website.

SBC found that the district now runs under a three-tier system with most of its buses serving three

bus runs — the high school, middle and elementary schools.

It studied the possibility of a two-tier system where the entire fleet could be distributed to "accommodate both high school and middle school within the same timeframe." However, middle and high school students would still ride in separate buses.

"For more than a year and a half, this committee has had student wellness as its number one priority and the extra sleep time, experts tell us, is key to our students feeling more alert and being better prepared for the school day," Monroe said. "They have worked hard examining any potential impact on students, staff and families, talking with transportation consultants, considering fiscal challenges and respecting differing viewpoints.

More updates regarding a new high school morning bell are expected in the near future and there are "opportunities for feedback" soon from district families and students. "We hope to make that move a reality sooner rather than later," she concluded.

Gov. Andrew Cuomo, along with governors in New Jersey and Connecticut, closed all bars, restaurants, casinos, movie theaters and gyms on Monday to help stop the spread of the coronavirus.

“Our goal is to slow the spread of the virus to a rate that the healthcare system can manage, and we’re doing that through aggressive testing and strong social distancing protocols,” Cuomo said in a statement.

Cuomo later issued an executive order mandating state and local governments to reduce non-essential workers, a minimum of 50 percent of the workforce.

Albany County Executive Dan McCoy said as more testing is done there will be more positive results. He warned those under precautionary quarantine to stay in their homes or run the risk of being placed on mandatory quarantine, which is legally binding.

He is also asking for people to volunteer for the Albany County Medical Reserve Corps to help respond to COVID-19. To do so, call the county Health Department at 518-447-4610.

Social distancing

It will be easier to list what is still open than what is closed. Last week Cuomo banned all events with an attendance of 500 or more, and any venue with less capacity can only have half the maximum number of people. On Sunday, March 15, the federal Centers for Disease Control advised everyone to avoid events with 50 or more people.

Many municipal buildings are shut down — including all town buildings in Colonie with the exception of public safety — and many public services are suspended until further notice.

School districts across the Capital District are closed — and all school-related activities canceled — until at least March 20 with others closed until April 19. North and South Colonie school districts, and others in the Capital District are providing meals to students on a take-out-style basis.

College campuses across the Capital District are closed and are implementing distance learning to help stop the spread of what the World Health Organization categorized as a pandemic.

Any and all dates businesses or organizations have set to re-open are tentative as the entire situation remains in flux.

“We are now in a phase of community mitigation where we need to stop the spread from close contact between individuals in large gatherings,” McCoy said in a statement.

Why it's different

There are many similarities between COVID-19 and the common flu but there are some stark differences too.

While COVID-19 is not as deadly, or even as widespread as the influenza virus, right now it is new and any type of vaccination is estimated to be months away and people do not have an immunity to it.

According to Johns Hopkins University, as of March 16, there were 179,073 cases worldwide with 4,138 in the U.S. It is difficult to know how many cases of the flu there are each year since it is not known how many people do not get tested and just suffer through until the symptoms subside. According to Johns Hopkins there are as many as one billion cases worldwide and between 9.3 to 45 million cases in the U.S.

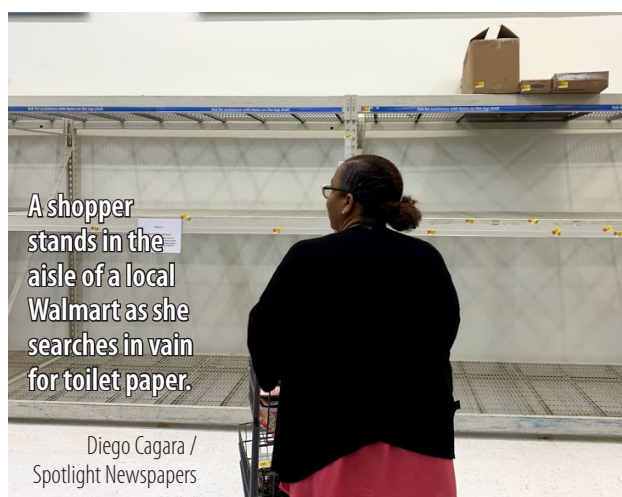
The flu also kills more people in the aggregate. According to Johns Hopkins, as of March 15, COVID-19 caused 5,833 deaths worldwide and 57 in the U.S. The flu kills between 12,000 to 61,999 people each year in this country alone and between 291,000 and 646,000 worldwide.

The death rate of the flu, though, is less than 1 percent. The death rate for COVID-19 is not nearly as solid of a number but is higher by most estimates and ranges from 1.4 percent to 3.7 percent. That estimate soars to nearly 15

percent for those more than 80 years old.

Symptoms of COVID-19 and the flu are similar and they include fever, cough and shortness of breath but can also cause body aches, sore throat, vomiting and diarrhea.

The World Health Organization, which has been studying COVID-19 cases from China and across the globe since late last year, believes around 80 percent of the people who are infected will have mild symptoms and may not even know they are sick or if they are sick they may attribute it to a cold or the flu. Some 15 percent are categorized as severe infection requiring oxygen and 5 percent of the cases are critical and require ventilation.

By far the most vulnerable are the elderly and those with underlying health and/or immunological conditions. The near national shutdown

is in place so as not to carry the virus to that population of people. Children are not overly susceptible to COVID-19 and according to the WHO, there has not been one death of a child under 9 years old in the world and 0.2 percent of all deaths were between 10 and 19 years old. Just 0.9 percent of all those infected in China were 9 years old or younger.

A major difference between the two is the flu's incubation period, the time from infection to appearance of the symptoms. It takes two to 14 days for symptoms of COVID-19 to show. The virus can be unknowingly be transmitted during this time.

How to avoid COVID-19

The Center for Disease Control has some common sense behaviors to avoid contracting COVID-19:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing and before eating or preparing food.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Stay at home if you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue or sneeze or cough into the bend of your elbow.
- Practice social distancing.

What's closed?

What is closed or canceled is constantly changing, and it is advisable to contact a venue or business prior to attending to see if the activity is still going on.

- All bars and restaurants were closed to the public but could still offer take out.
- Gyms, movie theater and casinos are now closed.
- Jails and nursing homes are limiting or banning visitors
- Bethlehem, North and South Colonie school districts are closed until at least March 20. Check their websites for more information.
- The state Capital is closed to the public.
- The Roman Catholic Diocese of Albany has canceled all masses except weddings and funerals.

- The Bethlehem and Colonie libraries are closed
 - All winter high school state championship tournaments are indefinitely postponed and all spring sports are on hold until at least April 19.
 - Global Youth Day at the Crossings in Colonie on March 21 is canceled.
 - Students in Local Government Day slated for March 21 is canceled.
 - Bethlehem's Senior Services Department has canceled many programs including all health and wellness programs, CANstruction, Krause's Homemade Candies, weekly Thursday Senior Citizens Club and Game Day, and all discussion groups and congregational meal programs.
 - Bethlehem Parks and Recreation Department has also canceled all winter and spring programs, events and trips.
 - The state museum is closed.
 - Concerts, plays and other forms of entertainment are closed nearly across the board.

Everyone has a role to play

The CDC, state DOH, and Albany County Department of Health have made it very clear that WE individually also have key roles to play. WE must wash our hands more often. WE must practice good coughing and sneezing etiquette. WE must stay home when we feel unwell. And WE must check on our

vulnerable neighbors to make sure they're well, and perhaps even help by going grocery shopping for them.

The COVID-19 outbreak in New York is serious.

We in town government are taking it seriously. We as individuals need to take it seriously as well, and each do our part to limit its spread and help our neighbors.

Based upon impacts and disruptions caused by coronavirus (COVID-19) on residents, families, and businesses, effective at 1 p.m. on Monday, March 16, all town buildings, including Town Hall, Senior Center, Parks and Recreation, Highway, and Water and Sewer will have strictly limited public access until further notice.

All town parks, trails, and open space remain open.

Police and EMS will continue responding to all emergencies.

The Transfer Station is expected to reopen on Tuesday, March 17 as planned.

Highway crews will continue with the winter clean-up. Water and Sewer will respond to emergencies. Building and Fire will continue with regular inspections.

All services will be performed under recommended health guidelines.

We did not lightly make this decision.

We understand the importance of public access to town facilities and hope to restore full access as soon as possible. We urge you to call or email town departments as noted on the town's website where you

can also access most town services.

Please note that, given impacts on staff and their families, it may take a little longer for the town to respond to inquiries.

In its daily update on Monday, March 16, the Albany County Department of Health (DOH) reported 15 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the county, with one person hospitalized, and that there are 90 people under mandatory quarantine and 367 people under precautionary quarantine.

This is for the birds

The different types of bird feeders

Birds are big business. That may come as a surprise to people who have never given much thought to the warm-blooded vertebrates who fly over their heads every day, but tens of millions of people have a passion for birds.

A 2016 survey from the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service found that more than 45 million people in the United States watch birds around their homes and away from home every year. While statistics aren't as current in Canada as they are in the United States, past studies have indicated birding is wildly popular among Canadians, with roughly 30 percent going wildlife-viewing while on out-of-town trips of one or more nights. That positively affects the economy, contributing billions of dollars to the tourism industry in both the U.S. and Canada every year.

While birding trips can help birdwatching enthusiasts see birds they otherwise may never see in person, bird feeders can be a great way to bring more birds into your own backyard. Choice of bird feeder can affect just which birds come to your back yard, and the following are some bird feeder options for birding enthusiasts to consider.

- Window feeders: Small and easily attached to windows with suction cups, window feeders are easy to maintain and bring birds right to your window. Birds that visit window feeders stand in the seed while feeding, so they must be cleaned and refilled on a daily basis.
- Tray or platform feeders: The online birding resource All About Birds (allaboutbirds.org) notes

that tray feeders attract the widest variety of seed-eating feeder birds. That makes them ideal for birding enthusiasts who want to attract a variety of birds to their properties. Tray feeders are simply platforms that hold seed and provide a place for birds to stand while they eat. All About Birds recommends tray feeders with screened, rather than solid, bottoms, as these trays promote complete drainage. Frequent cleaning is necessary with tray feeders, as bird droppings can quickly soil seed.

- Hopper or house feeders: These feeders are enclosed and feed seed out through the bottom. Hopper feeders are great for people who don't want to be bother with daily maintenance, as they can hold several pounds of food at one time, greatly reducing the number of times homeowners will need to refill them. In addition, hopper feeders don't need to be cleaned as often as other feeders. However, All About Birds notes that hopper feeders, which need to be thoroughly cleaned roughly once per month, are harder to clean than other feeders.

- Tube feeders: Tube feeders deliver seeds to birds through screens or ports. Small perches attract birds to tube feeders, making these ideal for small birds. Some tube feeders contain perches designed for birds that can feed upside down, potentially attracting a greater variety of birds to your backyard. But All About Birds notes that seed can collect on bottom-most feeding ports, providing a breeding ground for mold and bacteria. As a result, tube feeders should be inspected and cleaned regularly.

Bird feeders can draw an array of birds to your backyard.

For the sake of your safety

The entertainment scene is closing doors as part of a nationwide effort to stop the spread of a pandemic

People attend the arts to escape the weight of current events, but the weight of current events has proven to be too much for the arts to bear amid the spread of COVID-19, or novel coronavirus.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recently recommended to organizers throughout the country to cancel or postpone in-person events consisting of 50 people or more for the next eight weeks.

The edict comes after bold steps had already been taken by major players across the country, starting with Austin canceling its annual South by Southwest festival. The festival was canceled nearly two weeks ago after a string of participants such as Google started backing out. The move is projected to cost the Austin community an estimated \$400 million. The figure was derived by a study commissioned by the city that estimated income generated by last year's event.

In New York City, Governor Andrew Cuomo had previously directed Broadway to shut down shows until April. Once Albany County reported its first two cases of COVID-19 last week, area theaters followed suit.

Within hours, the Palace, The Egg,

Troy Savings Bank Music Hall, Cohoes Music Hall and each of the houses under Proctors Collaborative announced the postponement of shows running into April.

The timetable of these closures could change after the CDC's latest recommendation. Until that time, here is a partial list of closings within the local arts and entertainment scene.

Albany Center Gallery shut down all events and will remain closed to the public until April 3.

Albany Symphony canceled its Sunday Symphony Family Concert on Sunday, March 22.

Upstate Concert Hall has canceled or postponed several of this month's shows. Visit upstateconcerthall.com for more details.

Rivers Resort and Casino has restricted casino guests to 500 at one time. Guests also must sit at least one seat in between each other. The VIP Lounge is closed until further notice. And all entertainment inside the Event Center, Van Slyck's and Duke's Chophouse are canceled for at least two weeks.

Adirondack Thunder and Albany Patrons cancelled the remaining games of their respective seasons.

Albany Pine Bush Discovery Center has canceled all classes, programs and rentals until Friday, March 27. Center and trails are still open.

The Palace Theatre's marquee continues to scroll shows scheduled for April and beyond, but statements taped upon the front doors read similar to notices shared by other houses across the Capital District: There are no shows.

COHOES — The name Planned Parenthood has become rife with commentary.

Both sides of the political aisle use the organization — a mainstay in women’s healthcare, especially in areas of poverty and lower income — as a bargaining tool. While Planned Parenthood does more than abortions, the hot-button issue is automatically uttered at any mention of the organization.

branch on Saturday, March 21, at 7 p.m. The benefit, named the Women's History Month celebration, will bring the power of the female to Cohoes Music Hall. Tickets are \$22.50 and can be purchased at eventbrite.com.

"Originally, it was Kim's idea," Bell said. A big supporter of women in music, he's always pushing for more representation in the scene. Bell is known for his showcases and festivals where he pushes for more women headliners. When a touring act is in town, Bell and Neaton will try to find a good local opener — in many cases, they're thrilled to put up a strong, female artist.

"I sometimes feel like women aren't taken as seriously as men are in this industry," Bell said, "and I try to do my part in changing that. I'm always trying to get our women artists on the bill. I'm always pushing for them to get through whatever door we have."

March is Women's History Month, the inspiration for the show's name. Bell and Neaton put their heads together and decided there is no better time for the show. A week later, Neaton told Bell she wanted to make the show a benefit for Planned Parenthood.

"I've been a patient of Planned Parenthood for over half of my life," Neaton said. "They provide wonderful services. It isn't just your physical health, either. They

will ask how you're doing and how you're feeling in your relationship. It's full service and extremely beneficial."

According to statistics from Upper Hudson Planned Parenthood chief experience officer Katherine Bruno, 15,449 people visited one of three centers: Albany, Troy and Hudson in 2019. Statistics show 2,185 abortions were provided. It shows 11,356 visitors received information on birth control and other preventative measures. In the three offices, 21,764 tests and treatments for sexually transmitted diseases were administered. That includes almost 5,000 HIV tests.

Women received 1,591 breast exams and pap smears. Of those exams, 145 were sent on for abnormalities. Statistics show 966 visits were for transgender health care services.

Like Neaton mentioned, Planned Parenthood does look for more than sexual wellness. Three-hundred and ninety two wellness counseling sessions were performed, with 14,051 anxiety and depression screenings administered.

"Many of our visitors are below the poverty line or without insurance and have nowhere else to go," Bruno said. "We are always so grateful for fundraisers like [the Cohoes Music Hall one] because donations and benefits help us offset costs for those who need the assistance."

Neaton said picking the acts for the benefit was easy; she and Bell are fans, and now friends, with the artists. When Neaton began putting the benefit together, she was quickly able to gather a strong bill of talent and passion.

"What makes this work so well is how everyone is rallying around a common cause," Neaton said. "Keeping these conversations going and continuing to host events like these is how we continue to make a difference after Women's History Month is over."

Zan Strumfeld, the namesake of quartet Zan and the Winter Folk, faced a bit of a challenge while picking out her band's setlist. Neaton asked each act to perform two songs, followed by a cover of a selection from a female songwriter. Strumfeld, a "huge supporter" of Planned

Oh, my corona

Who is at elevated risk for COVID-19?

C COVID-19 continues to dominate headlines across the globe. This novel coronavirus first made headlines in late 2019 after an outbreak in Wuhan, the sprawling capital city in China's Hubei province. The virus has since spread beyond China's borders, leading to school closures and changes in public life, such as the shutting down of professional sports leagues, that many might never have thought they would see in their lifetimes.

Despite the relative infancy of COVID-19, doctors have learned much about it, including who might be most at risk. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, early information out of China revealed that some groups are at higher risk of getting very sick from COVID-19 than others. Older adults and people who have serious chronic medical conditions are at the greatest risk of getting very sick from COVID-19. Heart disease, diabetes and lung disease are the chronic medical conditions that appear to make people especially vulnerable to sickness from COVID-19.

How people in at-risk groups can

reduce their risk of getting sick


The CDC notes that it is especially important that people at elevated risk take actions to reduce their risk of getting sick with the disease. The following strategies can be part of a proactive approach that may help at-risk people lower their risk of getting sick from COVID-19.

- Stock up on health supplies. Contact your physician and arrange to obtain extra necessary medications so you do not have to leave your home should an outbreak occur in your area. If that's not plausible, the CDC recommends signing up for mail-order medications. Stock up on over-the-counter medications and medical supplies, including everyday items like tissues, so you don't have to leave the house if an outbreak occurs.

- Stock up on groceries. Make sure you have enough groceries on hand so you can stay at home if restrictions on leaving home are put in place during an outbreak.

- Embrace the basics. Basic strategies like avoiding people who are sick; washing your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after blowing your nose, coughing, sneezing or spending time in public; avoiding touching your face, nose, eyes, etc.; and avoiding crowds can help to reduce your risk of getting sick from COVID-19.

Santana from jail

Vapor Vespers' 'One Act Sonic'

Spaghetti Eastern Music's Sal Cataldi teams up with Mark Nuro for a unique blend of sounds

Anyone in the mood for ambient, industrial funk, fuzz and jazz? No? Try this out. It's, shall we call it, entertaining.

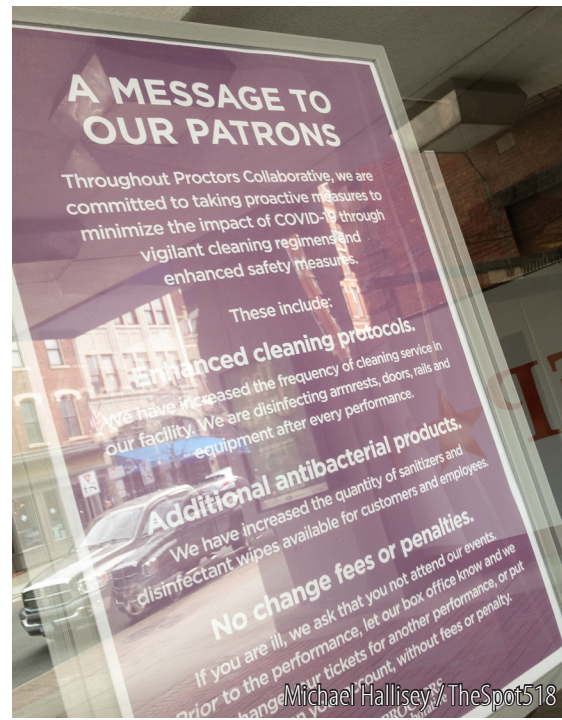
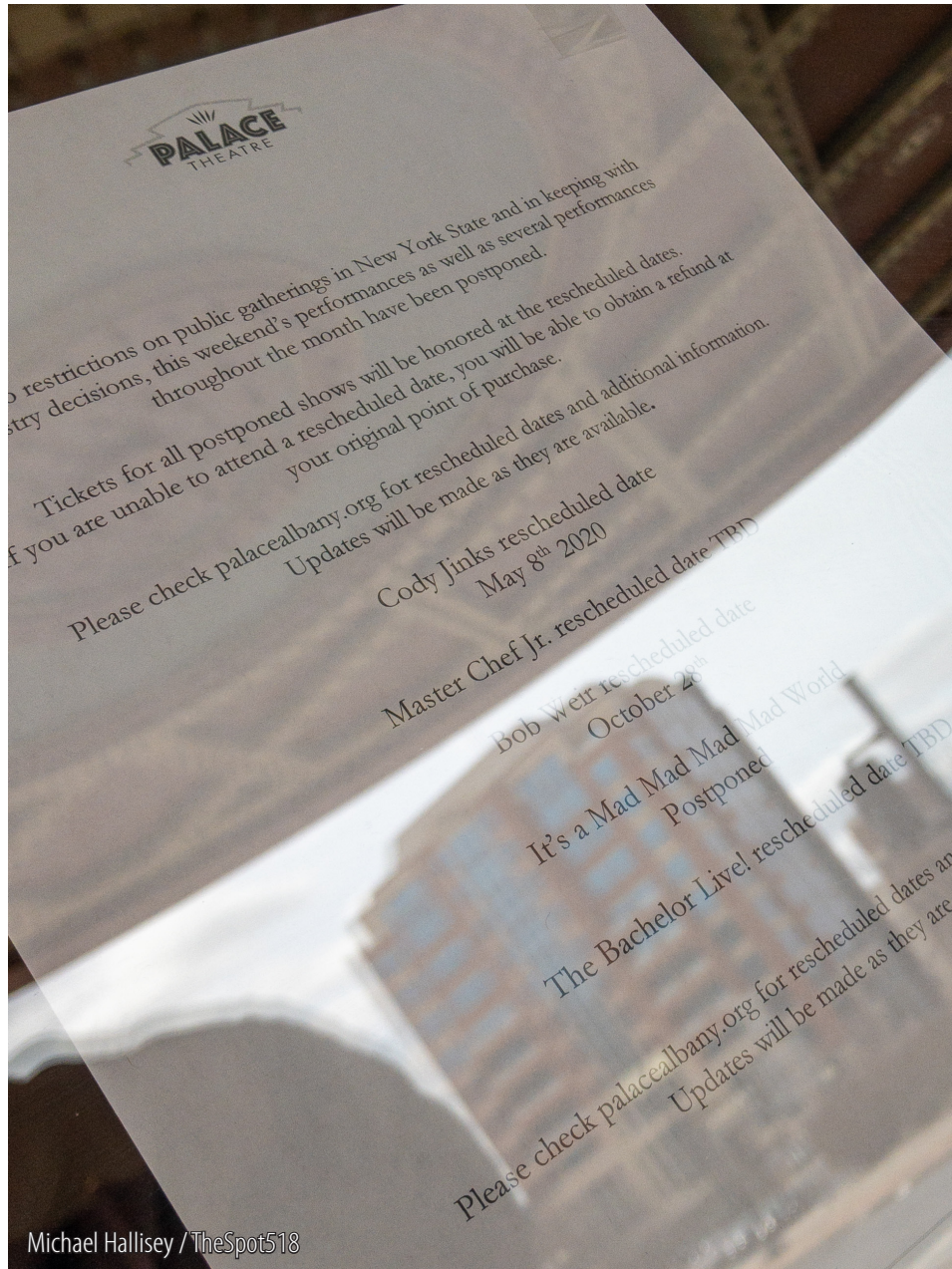
