Roadside service

Glenmont family serves up free ziti dinners in the name of community and neighborly love

BETHLEHEM — A Glenmont family has set up a so-called drive-thru at the intersection of Feura Bush and Jefferson roads to offer free dinners to people every sunny weekend from 12 to 2 p.m. and to spread neighborly kindness amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

Parents Jonathan and Lindsay Wagner and their children Maggie, 16, Makayla, 8, and Brady, 6, began giving away 100 free ziti dinners on Saturday, March 21. As the family sat outside with a table full of to-go dinners, they were grateful that many passers-by stopped — including a Bethlehem Police Department officer who helped with traffic — to inquire what was going on and took many dinners home, all while maintaining distance.

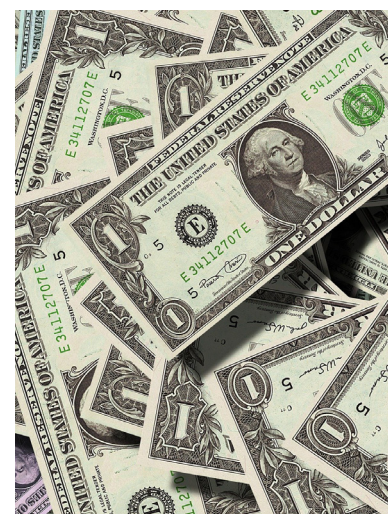
“We gave them away for free and a lot of people gave donations as well,” said Lindsay, adding that she posted about the drive-thru on her Facebook page to help get the word out. “It was really awesome that from our Facebook post, others posted about it on other pages.”

Stimulus package to aid small businesses

The \$2 trillion stimulus package passed last week includes \$350 billion for small businesses to help deal with the losses associated with COVID-19.

The Paycheck Protection Program of the Keeping American Workers Employed and Paid Act will provide federally guaranteed loans to small employers to maintain a payroll and other operating expenses for eight weeks.

If the employer keeps all employees, the portion of the loan used for cover payroll and employee benefits, interest on mortgage obligations, rent, and utilities would be forgiven.

This proposal would be retroactive to Feb. 15 to help bring workers who may have already been laid off back onto payrolls.

Small Business Administration size standards would be eligible to apply for the loans. Self-employed individuals and "gig economy" individuals would also be eligible.

Covered payroll costs include salary, wages, and payment of cash tips up to an annual rate of

pay of \$100,000; employee group health care benefits, including insurance premiums; retirement contributions; and covered leave.

The size of the loans would equal 250 percent an employer's average monthly payroll. The maximum loan amount would be \$10 million.

The cost of participation in the program would be reduced for both borrowers and lenders by providing fee waivers, an automatic deferment of payments for one year, and no prepayment penalties.

Loans would be available immediately through existing SBA-certified lenders, including banks, credit unions, and other financial institutions, and SBA would be required to streamline the process to bring additional lenders into the program.

The Secretary of Treasury is authorized to expedite the addition of new lenders and make further enhancements to expedite delivery of capital to small employers.

The maximum loan amount for SBA Express



loans would be increased from \$350,000 to \$1 million. Express loans provide borrowers with revolving lines of credit for working capital purposes.

The bill also:

- Provides grants to SBA resource partners, including Small Business Development Centers and Women's Business Centers, to offer counseling, training, and related assistance to small businesses affected by COVID-19.

- Provides funding for the Minority Business Development Agency's Minority Business Centers to provide these services.

- Provide protections to small business contractors affected by COVID-19

by requiring federal agencies to extend contract performance periods and promptly pay small business contractors.

- Allows for expedited access to capital by establishing a program for small businesses who have applied for an emergency disaster relief loan to request an advance of up to \$10,000 on the loan to provide paid sick leave to employees, maintain payroll, and pay other debt obligations.

- Authorizes the SBA to offer resources and services in the 10 most commonly spoken languages, other than English.

- Allows four months of unemployment insurance instead of three months.

- Provides \$150 billion for a state, tribal and local Coronavirus Relief Fund.

- Provides \$10 billion for SBA emergency grants of up to \$10,000 to provide immediate relief for small business operating costs

- Provides \$17 billion for SBA to cover six months of payments for small businesses with existing SBA loans.

New York state also passed a law to help workers impacted by COVID-19 including those who are under a mandatory or precautionary quarantine.

For employers:

- With 10 or fewer as of Jan. 1 must provide unpaid sick time during the period of quarantine except those employers with a net income of more than \$1 million, which must provide five days of paid sick leave.

- Employers of 11 to 99 must provide five days of paid sick leave

- Employers of 100 or more must provide up to 14 days of paid sick leave

- Public employers must provide at least 14 days of

paid sick leave.

- Benefits would not be available to employees deemed asymptomatic or not yet diagnosed with any medical condition and is physically able to work, through remote access or other means.

- Employees who are returning from personal travel to one of the destinations on the Center for Disease Control travel advisory list are not eligible for paid sick time even though they are strongly encouraged to self-quarantine for two weeks.

- For employers with less than 99 employees with workers out for longer than the proscribed timeframes outlined above, the employee can apply for Paid Family Leave and New York State Short Term Disability at the same time.

- PFL can also be used to care for a dependent minor child under such a mandatory quarantine of isolation order but it does to apply to cases where the child's school is closed and requires daycare.

Here comes the cavalry

National Guard begins delivering food

ALBANY — The National Guard began delivering food to those who are in quarantine on Tuesday, March 30.

Nearly 20,000 pounds of food was brought to the Times Union Center from the Regional Food Bank of Northeastern New York and was being sorted for distribution said Albany County Executive Dan McCoy during his daily press briefing on Monday, March 29.

As of Monday, there were 199 cases of COVID-19 in Albany County, up 12 from Sunday, with 559 under mandatory quarantine and another 223 under precautionary quarantine. There are 15 hospitalized with seven adults in the ICU.

When this paper went to print last Monday, there were 122 confirmed cases in Albany County with 634 under mandatory quarantine and 490 under precautionary quarantine.

The large drop in the number under precautionary quarantine is largely because some 400 people associated with Farnsworth Middle School spent their two weeks in isolation and were released. None of those people tested positive.

Dr. Elizabeth Whalen, head of the Albany County Health Department, said there is a shortage of tests across the country so there has not been any widespread community testing for the virus. Instead, tests are limited to those who are admitted to the hospital with symptoms of the virus — fever, cough and shortness of breath — and those health care workers who have come in contact with the patient.

“New York City is still doing widespread testing so we are getting an idea of what the timeline looks like and they are talking about the apex in a couple weeks,” she said. “I don’t think people understand that we have not yet reached the apex yet and where we

could be in the coming weeks. It is of utmost importance for people avoid contact with other people especially if you are in a vulnerable group, over 60 or if you have other health issues.

“This is the foreseeable future for county residents.”

Also, McCoy said, the county Industrial Development Agency is exploring ways to provide small businesses that have been hit hard by shutdowns with grant and loans to help keep them afloat. He is working with the Legislature and more news should come on that later this week.

Statewide, as of Monday, there were 66,497 confirmed cases with 1,218 deaths and 9,517 hospitalized.

When this paper went to print last week, there were 20,875 cases and 157 deaths.

Other developments this week include:

- A man in his 70s with “multiple underlying health problems” became the county’s first death to COVID-19. The man, who was not being identified at this time, died at St. Peter’s Hospital on Saturday, March 28. A 95-year-old man died in Saratoga County, 92-year-old Walter Robb, a GE pioneer, died in Schenectady County and a nursing home resident died in Columbia County.

- McCoy said there were reports of restaurants serving people food

and drink inside the establishments rather than by the widely accepted curb side pickups and vowed to crack down with the help of the Sheriff’s Department and the New York State Liquor Authority. Those in violation run the risk of a \$10,000 fine, a potential loss of its liquor license and McCoy promised to “embarrass” the violators on social media.

- On Saturday, the City of Albany reported two firefighters tested positive, including one EMT.

- Tulip Fest is postponed, and there is not another date scheduled. The festival, which features tulips, music, food and arts and crafts, was slated for May 8 through May 10.

- The number of people, 80,500, filing for unemployment in New York state last week is 520 percent greater than last year, with the number filing for the first time jumping by at least 284 percent. To help manage the unprecedented increase in volume, the DOL is implementing a new filing system based on the first letter of the applicants first name. Those with a last name ending in the letters “A” through “F” are to file on Monday, “G” through “N” on Tuesday, and “O” through “Z” on Wednesday. Anyone who misses the designated days is asked to file on Thursday through Saturday. Nationwide, some 3.3 million people filed for unemployment last week.

She continued, “A woman in Troy, who didn’t have a car and was desperately in need of dinners, reached out and we drove out and dropped off 14 dinners because there were eight people in her house. There was also a couple in need in Albany that we delivered to because we still had at least 10 dinners left to give.”

Lindsay said they originally set up their drive-thru on Jefferson Road but realized not many people were passing or driving by there; they then decided to move to the aforementioned intersection which had more traffic.

“We got the idea from watching the news and seeing what’s going on in the world,” she said. “It was an idea to offer for local families, including the elderly who especially need meals, but still practice social distancing. It’s no questions asked. If anyone’s in need who can’t make their own food themselves or can’t

go get groceries or not have enough, we’ve set it up so people could safely come and pick up dinners.”

She added that her family makes the dinners from home and she purchased food containers from Amazon. “My kids also drew messages like ‘Enjoy’ and decorated the food covers. My daughter, Makayla, drew art on them,” she said.

Looking ahead, Lindsay said her family wants to continue giving away free dinners at the drive-thru “as long as the need is there. I’m thinking of reaching out to local businesses

like McCarroll’s or restaurants about using their supplies to make the food. But I want to be conscious of not taking away supplies from people who need them too.”

She also wants to change it up and try making different types of dinners, like spaghetti and meatballs.

She concluded that during this challenging time, “It’s just all about acts of kindness and we want to pass it along to the community. It’s been a great thing to see. I’ve never lived through anything like this before and it’s amazing to see the community come together like this.”

Town Hall meeting held remotely amid pandemic

Bethlehem to purchase 21 acres to expand Henry Hudson Park

BETHLEHEM — The town will continue holding board meetings remotely amid COVID-19.

Town Supervisor David VanLuven said the meetings will be held via Zoom, a live video conferencing service, that allows board members and essential staff to hold virtual meetings in real-time.

After the meeting ends, the recorded video is available on bethlehemtownny.iqm2.com/Citizens/Default.aspx.

Gov. Cuomo issued an executive order on March 12, that town governments can “meet and take such actions authorized by the law without permitting in public in-person access to meetings and authorizing such meetings to be held remotely by conference call

or similar service, provided that the public has the ability to view or listen to such proceeding and that such meetings are recorded and later transcribed.”

VanLuven said, “We feel it’s better to keep businesses of town meetings moving forward.”

Although the virtual meetings do not allow the public to participate in real-time, he said, “I can’t stress enough that people can still

communicate with us by phone or email all the time and even in normal times, they don’t have to wait until a town board meeting to share their comments or concerns.”

Town to acquire lands for park

The Town Board voted unanimously on Wednesday, March 25 to approve the purchase of two adjacent land parcels totaling 21 acres to expand Henry Hudson Park.

The vote took place during a virtual Zoom meeting and Town Supervisor David VanLuven said the expansion looks to protect 3,000 feet of the Vroman Kill shoreline. According to town documents, the land purchases will also “protect the site from development and conserve the natural resources found in the area. ... No development is planned ... thus, the purchase[s] will not result in any adverse environmental impact.” The

acquired lands would be used for passive recreation too.

One parcel took up 11 acres along Lyons Road and was owned by resident Howard Vagele; the other was 10 acres out of a 17-acre parcel owned by resident Steven Downs along Dinmore Road.

“I look forward to bringing everyone together for a proper ribbon-cutting when the [pandemic] has passed,” VanLuven said.

To curb the COVID-19 spread, Bethlehem and Colonie closed town buildings to the public and canceled many senior-oriented events, social gatherings and programs. This caused many seniors to stay home as a precaution and have limited resources to benefit from.

William Vail, the Bethlehem Senior Services acting director, said his department suspended transportation — town-owned cars and vans — for seniors through April 6, and will reevaluate it on April 1. Such transportation helped bring seniors to run errands or go for medical appointments.

“We generally run vans that hold 13 people but we’re not putting 13 seniors on a van anymore,” he said. “Immediately, we’ve had to adapt to the circumstances as they unfold.”

However, Town Supervisor David VanLuven said that only one person, a senior who requires transportation to their dialysis appointments, is the exception to this rule. An assigned driver and a disinfected bus now serve that individual. “The Senior Services department has been very impressive,” VanLuven said. “People don’t realize they’re necessary and what resources they have that are often taken for granted.”

Vail brought up that his department also continues to run the food pantry, albeit with a reduced staff of three inside Town Hall, that serves families in need. “We have frozen meats, butter, cheeses, sometimes eggs and milk, and a great deal of non-perishable food items,” he said. “We get our food from the Regional Food Bank [of Northeastern New York] for example. We also consistently get donations from our wonderful community and there’s a drop-off at McCarroll’s.”

He added that families must call his department at 518-439-4955, ext. 1173 or 1175 to order from the food pantry and

schedule an appointment to pick it up outside a side door at Town Hall. Such appointments are 20 minutes apart, minimizing physical contact with other families.

Diane Conroy-LaCivita, the executive director of the private, non-profit Colonie Senior Service Centers, said her organization’s workforce has been reduced to 12 people. However, they still provide hot meals for struggling Colonie seniors every day, provide transportation and help do grocery shopping and pick up seniors’ prescriptions.

“I want to give credit to our amazing staff who work seven days a week,” she said.

Christine Cary, the Town of Colonie Senior Resources Department’s director, wrote in an email that the COVID-19 pandemic brings up additional concerns, like how seniors may feel isolated because of their age, health and are not as connected on social media and the internet.

“The staff of Senior Resources is reaching out to seniors who have been served by [the Colonie Senior Resources Department], providing wellness checks to

ensure their basic needs are being met,” she wrote. “If they are in need of assistance we are making linkages to community partners such as Colonie Senior Service Centers, Albany County Department of Social Services and other community organizations to assist with meals, transportation and other essential needs.”

Joyce Becker, a Bethlehem Town Board member and the town’s Senior Projects’ assistant treasurer, said addressing isolationism among seniors is important.

“I think the most important thing is checking on your neighbors and residents who are older,” she said. “It doesn’t have to be in person. I also encourage older folks to reach out to their Senior Services office and ask them questions if they’re concerned.”

She continued, “We’ve heard stories about the Great Depression from our parents and grandparents so this pandemic is a repeat in some ways of that. In my mind, I remember my mother and father talking about the Great Depression and this really hits home. Let’s stop and think about what we really need in order to exist, not what we want.”

Becker connected her last point with how stores like Walmart, Price Chopper and Target have designated special hour-long shopping times for customers aged 60 and older, which are one hour before the stores open to the general public.

“Seniors can look into home delivery of groceries too.”

Looking ahead, Vail, Becker and Cary agreed that towns and residents should not stop looking out for one another, especially seniors and those in need.

Cary wrote that while reaching out to seniors, “I am finding very much a sense of neighbors helping neighbors, which is encouraging as I believe the support will be needed long term. Mostly they are appreciative that they are being checked on and welcome the phone visit.”

Vail brought up that the Albany County Sheriff’s and Bethlehem Police departments maintain a list of Bethlehem senior residents who are isolated.

“We’ve put together an emergency special needs registry of people who are isolated and have minimal resources like families and friends not able to check up on or visit them,” Vail said. “We’ll call everyone on that registry to check up on them and ask what they may need. We’re also encouraging any others to call us if their secure system like resources, families and friends falter.”

Becker said she has never experienced a global pandemic that has such dramatic effects at the local level. “This is now totally something new to our country and it’s bigger than us. Working together in town government as a team is important and I can’t say enough how great our employees are,” she concluded. “Stay safe and reach out if you need assistance.”

Schools transition to online learning

School buildings closed to the public through April 15

While Gov. Cuomo announced last Friday that all schools statewide must stay closed until April 15, numerous Capital District schools are working to transition to online learning for its teachers and students.

Bethlehem Central School District Superintendent Jody Monroe said K-12 students began formal virtual learning on Monday, March 30, after reaching out to district families about whether their children have easy access to a tablet, computer or laptop, as well as the internet. The district also loaned Chromebooks to K-5 students whose families indicated in a districtwide online survey last week that they don't have a device.

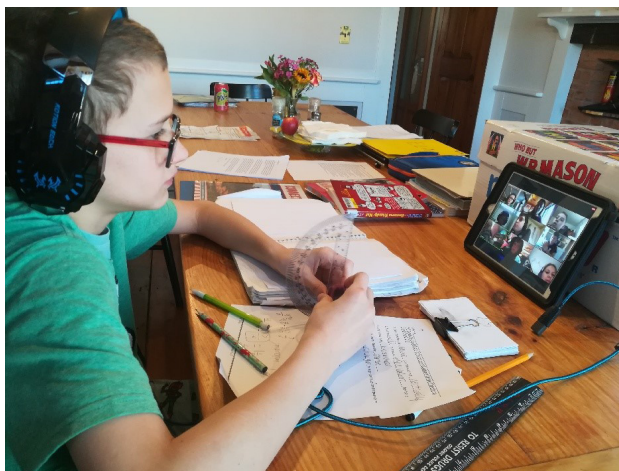
"We don't have a full one-to-one device availability for every elementary school child but I believe we have enough because not everyone requested one," Monroe said. "For K-5 students, when you have two parents working from home with their devices, it's harder for many kids to share a

device." She added that students in grades six through 12 have already been loaned Chromebooks and are more likely to own their own devices, unlike younger children.

Monroe said she met with the district's Instructional Leadership Team — made up of around 40 administrators, teachers and curriculum supervisors — two weeks ago to discuss how to move forward. "We obviously want students to come back and we don't want to be closed for the rest of the year yet," she said. "The staff's biggest concern is less about content but more about maintaining connections with the kids. The team came up with guidelines for teachers to meet their kids and what resources are available to them."

Students would generally use apps like Google Meet, Google Classroom and Zoom to study with teachers in real-time.

According to the district's website, elementary school teachers will work with a daily schedule by grade level that gives structure and routine for students and parents. For more information, visit sites.google.com/bethlehemschools.org/learningfromhome/home. Middle school instruction and resources are organized by the student's team and

high school teachers will individually teach content and provide resources for each course.

Monroe, however, acknowledged that Bethlehem Central "is not like a college that works with much older students. While we have lots of online resources, K-12 classrooms going virtually online does not really work automatically. Our younger learners need hands-on attention and some students are English-language learners or have special needs, and we need to support them. Being online is helpful but it doesn't really replace the teachers in the classrooms."

Loudonville Christian School, which has 250 students from 35 school districts across K-12 grades, transitioned to virtual learning in mid-March,

can work "for the long term until we hear from the state. While we want to prioritize the health of our staff and families, it's hard to tell how long we'll stay like this at this point. We want to be realistic."

Bigham expressed gratitude to students and parents being supportive during the transition. "We want what's best for the kids and parents have been overwhelmingly pleased about how engaged their kids are. We still hold kids accountable for online attendance."

Ravena-Coeymans-Selkirk Central School District Superintendent Brian Bailey said, "This has been an extraordinarily challenging time for everybody and it's a completely different way. It's tested us emotionally and professionally."

He said that the district's staff uses online tools like Google Classroom, have a special outline for how to operate office hours remotely and check up on students' families via phone and email. Since virtual learning began in mid-March, the district initially focused on reinforcing prior learning instead of teaching new content to students, to ease the transition.

Bailey added that the district began reaching out to families about device availability. "We don't necessarily have a device for each student but I don't have a concern about device shortage," he said. "We basically have a device for every middle school child and in high school, every student is pretty close to having their own device too."

He, however, acknowledged that not every student has easy internet access or optimal reception since some families live in rural areas. He said that the district worked with local internet providers Spectrum, Mid-Hudson Cable and StateTel to offer discounted or free access for families through May.

"Having internet access significantly increases student access to educational resources

and we want as many families as possible to have this opportunity," he wrote in an email. For more information, visit www.rcscsd.org/rcs-letter-to-parents-caregivers-march-27-2020.

"The most important thing that we recognize is that everyone's situation at home right now is different, families and staff alike," Bailey said. "We cannot presume that everyone has the same access to resources, childcare, or even time to focus and attend to lessons at home."

Bethlehem Central, Loudonville Christian School and Ravena-Coeymans-Selkirk also have resources for students with special needs and those seeking social or emotional support.

At Bethlehem Central, Monroe said her district's counselors and social workers have been in touch with students via phone and Google Meet to maintain a schedule of interaction. "Some kids may be struggling with the whole transition and what's happening with the world and our counselors are available for that. They work from home too."

At Loudonville Christian School, Philippi brought up an example of how each high school grade level has a designated virtual "hangout session" on Wednesdays which was typically study hall or lunchtime in school.

"It's in the middle of the day where they wouldn't have classes during the time," Philippi said. "They can hang out, have fun, do homework together and so on."

At Ravena-Coeymans-Selkirk, Bailey said that students with special needs are assigned a consultant teacher who checks in with their families to ensure they have the online resources they need.

"Engagement is an essential component in education and while the pandemic has forced everyone to adapt a bit, I think this is an opportunity for rebirth in terms of how we offer instruction to kids," Bailey concluded.

Spreading neighborly kindness

DELMAR — A local mother and daughter are designing inspirational messages on people's driveways across town for free to uplift neighbors amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

Since Saturday, March 21, Meika Loe and her 12-year-old daughter Levi Loe-Alinger designed 11 driveways, chalking short and sweet messages like "You Are Loved," "Keep Your Chin Up" and "Life is Beautiful." The messages are also often accompanied by bright drawings of flowers, the sun and smiley faces. Meika and Levi said they always practice social distancing by staying six feet apart as a precaution while decorating the driveways too.

The two acknowledged that as people are encouraged to stay indoors during the pandemic, their project is an opportunity to spread neighborly acts of kindness without compromising anyone's health.

"It's been sort of therapeutic and it's helpful to people stuck at home in the neighborhoods," Meika said. "It's important to help ground ourselves during this difficult time."

When asked what

inspired them, Levi said, "One day, it was warm and we went outside and we drew a positive message on our driveway. Some people walked by and really liked it and that's when we thought of making messages on other people's driveways too."

This led them to post on a Capital District-oriented NextDoor group, an online hub where neighbors, local businesses and communities connect, on Sunday, March 15 to "see if anyone is interested in having a chalk-drawn message that's inspirational on their driveway," said Meika. "We said we're a mother-daughter team and we'd be happy to do that. We then got at least 10 responses."

An interested resident would give them their house address. If the address is near the Loes' home, Levi would go design the driveway with her friend and neighbor, Kara Leonard. They would still practice social distancing like walking on opposite sides of a street and staying 6 feet apart while designing the driveway, Meika said. If the address is not near, Meika would drive there with her daughter and they would design the driveway.

They look to design interested people's driveways on any sunny weekend "and we'll do it as long as there are requests," Meika said. The chalk would wash away if it rains

or snows though.

The two said they enjoy getting to brighten neighbors' days with art. "Each request comes with a story," Meika said. "One was immunocompromised in Selkirk who couldn't go out but said she'd like to see something nice from out the window. Someone else lived near the Normanside Country Club who said she was housebound, an artist and a musician looking to support other artists and be inspired."

She continued, "I'm guessing word got out over time and we still get requests today, mostly from people we don't even know. We try to make different messages for each location too."

They have noticed that impressed neighbors want to tip or give them something in return, which they appreciate but decline. "It's already a gift to be able to do this for them," Meika said. "We want to keep people feeling positive and inspired during this challenging time. It's good to have a project to work on that gives us a bit of a routine and it's something we look forward to."

Levi said it's "giving the gift of drawing to the house's owner who then gives that gift to people walking by."

miSci mourns Robb

Former GE exec had ties to several endeavors

SCHENECTADY — miSci mourns the loss of one of the museum's former trustees, the first known death associated with the novel coronavirus in the Capital District.

Walter Robb, a retired General Electric executive, who had a hand in several endeavors across the region that included philanthropy, sports and education, died Monday, March 23, due to complications associated with COVID-19. The 92-year-old was reported as the first local resident to die from the virus.

Gina C. Gould, miSci president, expressed a "profound sadness" in a statement released by the museum the following day.

"Walt touched countless lives with his generosity and loyalty to his

mission, which was to be innovative," she stated. "At miSci, his genuine kindness and zeal for education touched all of us personally. The joy he exuded while exploring a new exhibition was palpable to everyone in the room. He would sit and watch how people interacted with the exhibits and share how he would do it better."

Robb was an engineer at GE before earning the role of director of its research and development center. He is credited for improving advanced imaging

equipment, including work with computed tomography and magnetic resonance imaging. He received the National Medal of Technology and Innovation in 1993.

Robb was also known as a sportsman. He owned both the Albany River Rats of the American Hockey League and the Albany Conquest of the Arenafootball2 League. His accomplishment of climbing Kilimanjaro at age 69 was noted in an obituary published by the Wall Street Journal. But his visibility in the community was most recently observed through his work at miSci.

Robb served the museum as a trustee for six years after joining the board in 2000. He remained on its finance committee for several years and helped the museum curate some of its most successful exhibits, including one closely associated with his work on MRI technology.

A virtual visit to Cooperstown

With the baseball season on hold, there's one place still open to visitors

The MLB had originally set Thursday, March 26, as its Opening Day, when each of the league's 30 teams were to play the first of their respective 162 games. Those games, however, have been postponed in light of the country's effort to "flatten the curve" of the present novel coronavirus pandemic.

Steve Rayburn canceled plans to travel west to watch the Mariners host the Red Sox on April break with his two kids. He's now locked down conducting business from his Loudonville home.

On any given Opening Day, Rayburn sets aside the day to watch games from noon until late at night. He always represents his beloved New York Mets with the choice of two jerseys. Today, he's wearing his home whites, a Dwight Gooden throwback from 1986. The Mets were to match up against the Washington Nationals in Flushing today.

"It's kind of the official "you've made it through winter" sign and promise that better days are coming," he said. "Unless, of course, you are a Mets fan."

Today's current events are a scary reminder of the 1918 flu pandemic, which is estimated to have killed between 50 and 100 million people globally while infected

approximately one-third of the world's population. The shadows of that pandemic continue to stretch across the landscape, as people attempt their best to practice social distancing — a concept credited to the St. Louis community's response to the flu a century ago.

Fans of the national pastime have limited options with the current stoppage, but there's a possible respite from their malaise in Cooperstown.

The Hall of Fame features several of its amenities in the effort to spark interest to visit Cooperstown. Today, however, it serves as a baseball fan's virtual tour. From beyond the site's home page, there are several choices to choose from to start your day's journey. Depending on the depth of your curiosity, it is possible to lose a day here:

Our Stories highlights features that include in-depth articles on the people who helped shape the game. In "Going Deep," there are several articles reporting events on stars from the past, and individuals who were less visible to the public eye.

#CardCorner takes the baseball card collecting hobby and flips it into a revealing biography that transcends the stats. This should prove to be a favorite for many. Not only does it celebrate players of varying success, it also highlights the art and colorful design that's likely to bring fans back to their childhood.

Gene Mack provided newspaper readers cartoon caricatures of the sporting world's headline grabbers. His collection of art, which spans a time of more than 35 years, is found on the website's digital

collection. It's where you can also find audio recordings, including an interview of Negro League great "Cool Papa" Bell sharing how he played the game. There's also a section set aside for scouting reports: of which, one of the best finds is that of a pitcher at a Pennsylvania high school named Dan Marino.

Baseball is not on the television today, but you have the chance to see new things from the game, if you don't mind going on a tour.

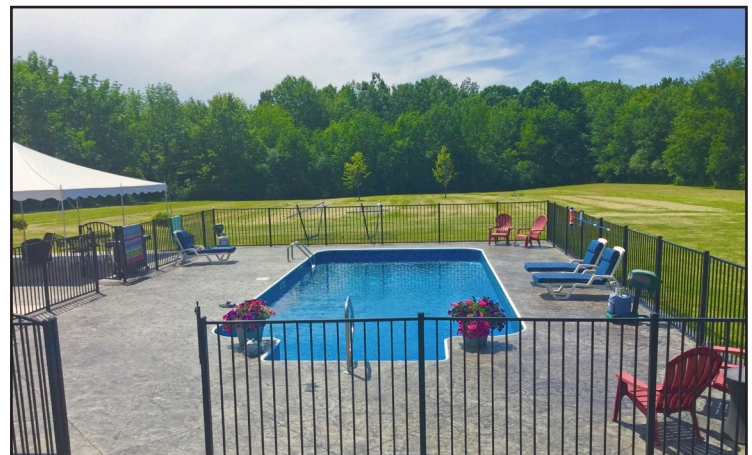

How to clean when faced with a shortage of supplies

In light of concerns about COVID-19, various health organizations have issued specific instructions on how to maintain personal safety and cleanliness. The Environmental Protection Agency states that coronaviruses are some of the easiest types of viruses to kill because they have an envelope around them that enables them to merge with other cells and infect them. If that protective coating can

be disrupted, the virus can't do its job. For those having trouble finding well-known cleaning agents, these alternatives may suffice.

Hot water and soap

The reason hand-washing is at the top of the list of sanitizing methods is because it is so effective at washing away viruses and bacteria. Friction from scrubbing with soap and water can help break the protective envelope, states the EPA. Soap and water can clean all surfaces in a home, especially when applying a little extra elbow grease.

Hydrogen peroxide

As people clear isopropyl (rubbing alcohol) off the shelves, do not discount hydrogen peroxide. The CDC says household hydrogen peroxide at 3 percent concentration can deactivate rhinovirus, the virus that causes the common cold, within six to eight minutes of contact. Coronavirus is easier to destroy than rhinovirus, so hydrogen peroxide may be effective at combatting that virus as well.

Natural items can be used for general cleaning, but have not been endorsed for use on COVID-19 disinfection. In lieu of shortages, white vinegar, baking soda pastes and citrus oils and juices could fill the void of chemically-based cleansers for other home tasks.

Kristyn Dayter launched the 518 Rainbow Hunt news group on Facebook last week. The Scotia mom of a 7-month-old claims rainbows as just one of the many things she identifies herself with, and that this idea is a means of keeping people connected in a time of social distancing.

"Rainbows, unicorns and glitter have always been my thing," said Dayter. "They're a perfect expression of my personality."

Since starting the project six days ago, Dayter's private group has amassed more than 55,000 members. Outside of starting a massive social experiment, Dayter is a dental assistant and a photographer.

"I'm so overly happy that this little project has touched so many families and has been a good distraction for everyone in this uncertain time," she said. "I can't wait to see how far we can reach."

Allison Armstrong, of Normanskill, adapted Dayter's idea and took to Nextdoor.com to recruit local families on a similar

endeavor.

"Basically, make a rainbow and hang [it] up in your windows or around the outside," she said. "Kids and adults are driving and walking around to hunt for them."

In four days, the idea spread across 26 neighborhoods in the Capital District.

The rainbow hunt is reminiscent of geocaching, where participants partake in search that involves finding clues online and

embarking on a real world expedition. However, unlike geocaching, there is no established list. People are encouraged to create and share, while others can passively discover.

"We went out walking this afternoon... searching for rainbows," said Albany Aronow of Delmar. "My kids were so excited when they found one."

The list of participants quickly grows with each passing day. Some have

also taken the opportunity to thank others in the community.

"I just put one up with a special thank you message," said Mary Ellen Hoffman of Albany. That message of gratitude is shared with her paper carrier, postal carrier, parcel deliverers, healthcare and first responders. "Plus, all the essential workers who are keeping our city, state and country going. God bless."

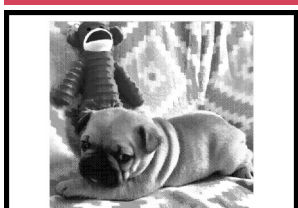
