EDGAR HISTED: HISTED'S
LAUNDRY & DELMAR CLEANERS

It was a happy day in Carbondale, Pa., on October 13, 1923 . . . for that was the day memorable for the Histed family because they celebrated the birth of their son, Edgar. Ed's father worked in the D&H offices, which when they were moved to Albany, brought the family to Altamont.

Ed was graduated from Altamont High in 1941 and went immediately to the GE on the apprentice course. He stayed at GE until Uncle Sam called in 1943. His Uncle may have kept him busy in the Navy . . . but somewhere in those busy days, Ed found time not only for romance but also marriage to Gladys Englemore of Clifton Park.

In 1945 a new sign blossomed at the corner of Delaware and Borthwick announcing Histed and Page, Radio Repairs. Paul Page moved away and Ed's new partner was Wade Taylor from Carbondale. The Pennsylvania hills kept calling the Taylors and Ed lost his second partner.

The years were going by, television was becoming popular, so Ed decided to build an appliance store at 226 Delaware. One of the features when it was completed in 1949, was the automatic washer in which prospective customers could do their laundry free of charge as a demonstration. Before long Ed realized that a laundry was even more in demand in the Tri-Villages than an appliance store. It was a natural that he purchased Delmar Cleaners this year.
