


Al and Nina Studler

the excellence of the service he gave soon was the talk of the village. There, he began his dream of the Service Shop he hoped one day to own

hoped one day to own.

Six years later, he took the first step toward fulfilling this dream and joined forces with Buck Smith to purchase the building at 243 Delaware Avenue, where he set up his service shop and they took on the Hudson Agency. There was many a headache during the war years due to shortages of material and lack of skilled workmen — and although the partnership broke up, Al concentrated on keeping as many Tri-Village cars on the road as possible and thereby won a host of friends.

It was in 1950 that he took his next step to make his dream come true. At that time he purchased the property across the street from his garage and began to visit every dealer's service shop he could find. He prolited from their experience and trom their mistakes . . . and slowly modelled he new garage until, today, it is one of the finest Service Shops in the country.

In '53, he took over the Nash Agency and has built it up to one of the top agen-

cies in the area.

Studler's Sales and Service is a typical Tri-Village business inasmuch as it is a family business. Nina (Mrs. Studler) has worked side by side with Al, doing the bookkeeping since the Elm Avenue Garage days and raising the children. Al, Jr., home from the Coast Guard since April, stepped into the new Service building with all the Studler mechanical know-how. 




