AN OPEN LETTER TO ALL PARENTS

IS YOUR CHILD GUILTY OF VANDALISM?

Hamilton H. Bookhout, Supervising Principal of the Bethlehem Central School District, called a meeting last week of more than 100 school, business, civic and church leaders to discuss the problem of vandalism which has swept this area in the past few months.

This conference brought to light mischievous damage, not only to private businesses and property but to public buildings. An example was given by George Lauer, superintendent of buildings and grounds. "Eighty-six windows were broken in the Delmar Elementary School during the past year. That hits your taxes hard," he pointed out.

Mr. Bookhout said in calling the session that schools are taking the lead in this fight because "education will play an important part in its ultimate solution." However, the Spotlight feels that each parent has a moral responsibility to know what his son is doing if he is out of doors after dark. Parental authority is an old-fashioned term that should be brought into fashion today. It isn't always "the boy down the block" who is the troublemaker. Any one of "our"

boys, given freedom, darkness, and a gang, can get into trouble. The age group seems to be from 11 to 18. So, for the sake of HIS future, let's lay down the law and keep our child off the streets at night.

That peppy tune "When the Saints Come Marching In" should be the theme song of Jim McCarroll and his McCarroll's Super Market on Second

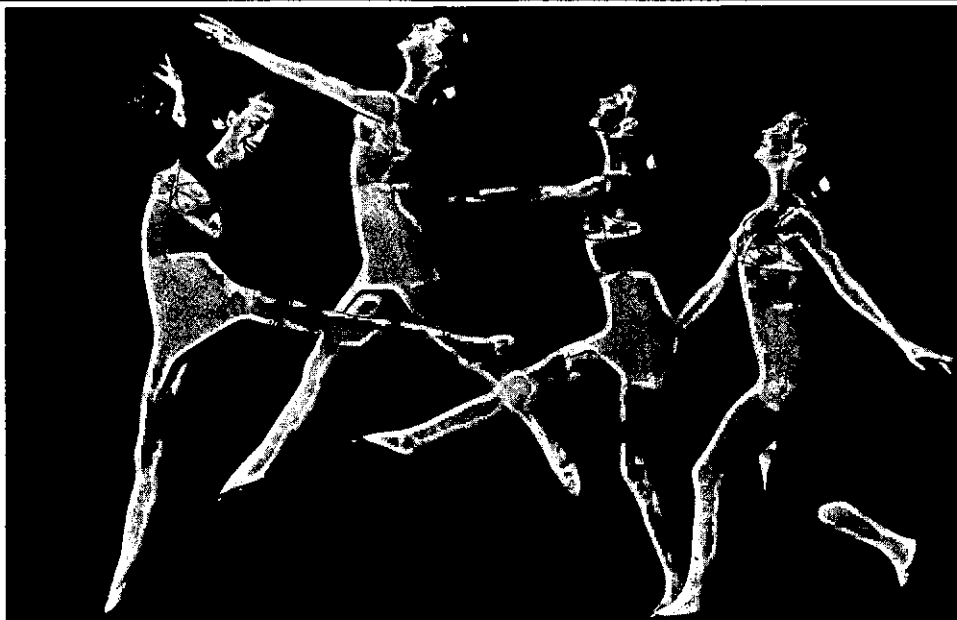
Avenue in Albany.

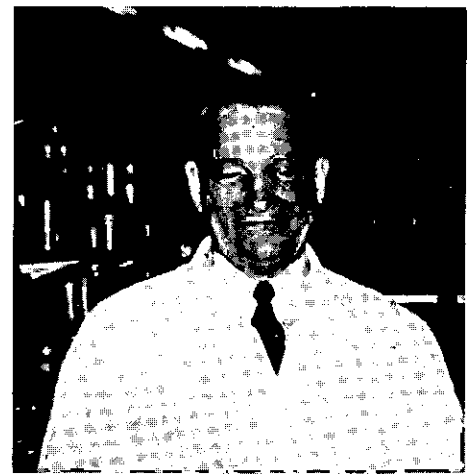

have continued to the present time. They also make their own sausage and sausage meats. For years, the McCarrolls have served fine, old Albany



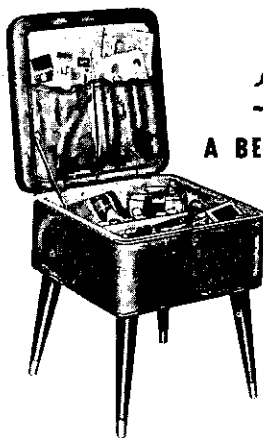
