## PUNKINTOWN FAIR STARTS THIS WEEKEND

The 15th Annual Punkintown Fair operated by the New Salem volunteer firemen, opens Friday evening at the same location on Route 85 next to the firehouse in New Salem. This event will, as always, run on the last Friday and Saturday evenings of July and the first Friday and Saturday evenings of August.

Under the leadership of Fair Chairman Hoynton Leonard, assisted by the Punkintown Fair Board, this year's event promises to provide a barrel of fun for the family. To amuse the children a new ride has been added. This ride, "The Whip," should be a real thriller.

The Punkintown Fair has been operated by the New Salem Volunteer Fire Department since it was organized twelve years ago. Receipts from taxes provided approximately 1/3 of the new revenue needed to operate the department, and the Punkintown Fair has provided the balance.

The New Salem firemen were one of the first companies in this area to carry their own water by supplementing their pumper with a used 1100 gallon tank truck. Because of the high cost of maintaining and repairing old heavy duty equipment, the Department has ordered a new tank-truck.

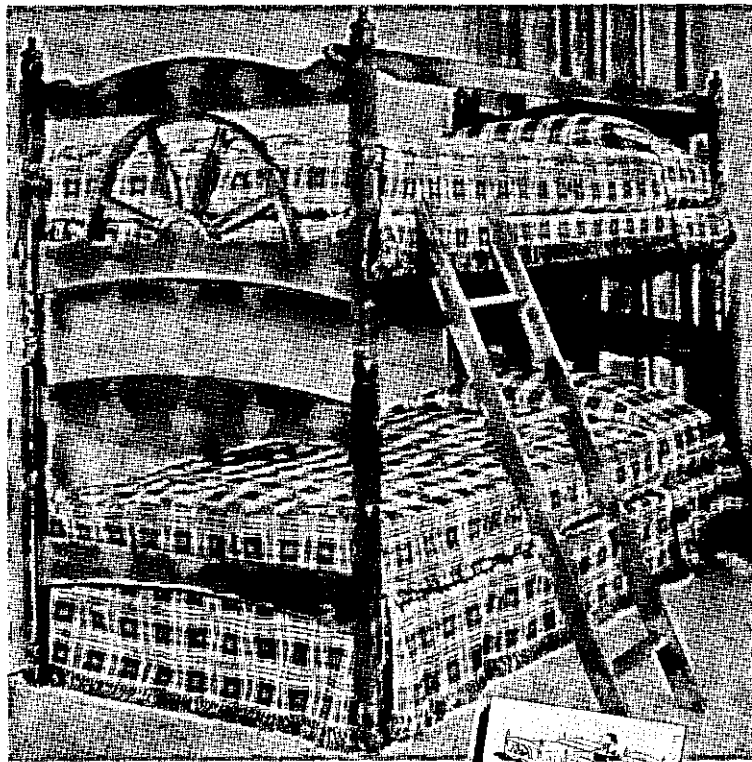

Without suggesting that his ideas are any better, here are some that have been picked up from interested parents this year.

The league should set up a 3-

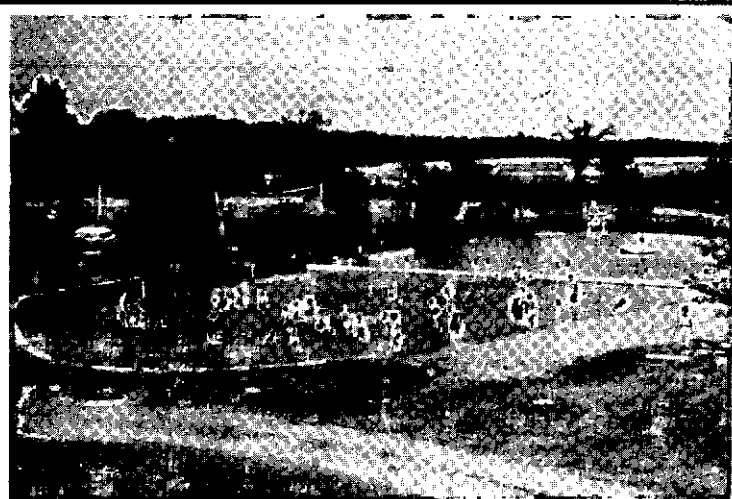
man committee composed of men who do not have sons playing Little League ball at the time they serve on this committee. This committee should have full power to settle any protests that arise during the year. Certainly better decisions could be reached that would be more acceptable if they were not made by the interested parties. It would take the pressure off other men whose son's teams could be helped or adversely affected by the decision.

The league should follow the example set by the Bethlehem Babe Ruth League and stay out of District Tournaments. This writer is not high hat; however, it seems we split our loyalties and divide our strength the last week of the season. With our own league faced with numerous postponed games, outside tilts add to the confusion. Some persons say that it is only one

or two games; however, if perchance we win any games, it holds up our own league.

The Little League handbook suggests that no games be played on Sunday. With 6 days a week devoted to baseball, let's plan to have one normal day for each family. If a few rain dates were planned and a few all-star games left unplanned this could be accomplished. It is true that there are not too many families in the area whose religion would specifically ban Sunday baseball; however, there are many parents who would prefer not to have Sunday games. Pressures brought by their boy and his teammates make it a tough decision for them and one with which they should not be faced.

The local rule that says a boy should play 30 innings in the Intermediate League and 36 in the Major League was made for a good reason. We do want

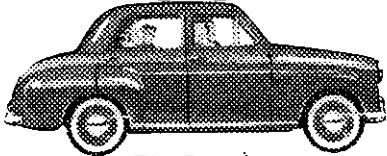

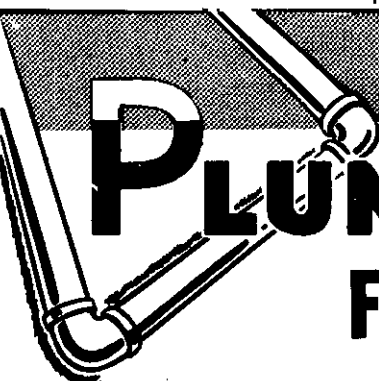

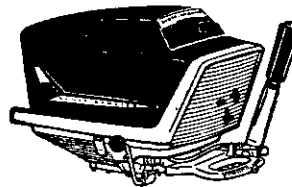
