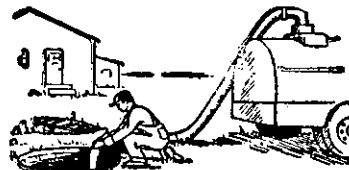
## FONT GROVE IN WINTER
