GLENMONT PTA MINSTREL SHOW TO AID SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The PTA of the Glenmont Grade School of the Bethlehem Central School District will stage its third annual minstrel show May 9 and 10 at 8:15 P.M. in the school gym, Carl Kundel, General Chairman, announced.

Theme of the show is the "Roaring Twenties," with a cast

of 50 parents and teachers under the direction of Richard Schoch. Musical director is Mrs. George Fabe.

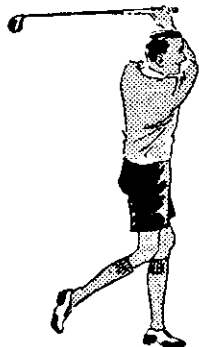



**YOUTH FITNESS WEEK
MAY 1 THROUGH MAY 7**

The week of May 1, 1960 has been proclaimed "Youth Fitness Week" by President Dwight D. Eisenhower and Governor Nelson A. Rockefeller.

Both expressed deep concern for the physical fitness of our youth who today are confronted with a critical choice. Either they include valid health information and vigorous activity in their everyday lives or both

they and society suffer inevitable losses.

A broad program of physical education is offered in the Bethlehem Central Schools. Physical education demonstrations have been held in the neighborhood elementary schools and in the junior and senior high schools before large crowds of interested parents. The next demonstration is scheduled at the Delmar elementary school on May 17. These programs include such activities as tumbling and apparatus work, rhythms and dances, gymnastics, games and swimming.

Currently, all children in

grades 4 through 12 are being given physical fitness tests. Cumulative records of test results are on file, showing the child's progress on each grade level as he goes through school.
