

SALE OF POPPIES TO AID DISABLED VETERANS OF 3 WARS

"Wear a poppy! Please wear a poppy in memory of America's war dead!" This will be the appeal repeated over and over throughout the Tri-Village Area by the many volunteer workers of the Nathaniel Adams Blanchard American Legion Auxiliary Unit 1040 during the annual poppy sale May 18-20. Regardless of weather, these dedicated volunteers will be on the streets to place the memorial poppies over the hearts of all who pass by and to receive donations for aid to disabled veterans and needy children.

The inspiration for these little red flowers stemmed from Flanders Field of World War I, but they are now made by the disabled hospitalized veterans of three wars. We are never critical of any imperfection because some are made by crippled hands and others are fashioned and assembled entirely by the sense of touch because the unseeing eyes were unable to guide the fingers. Making the poppies during the winter months offers a means for these unfortunate men to earn a little spending money through beneficial employment, as well as being of therapeutic value and
