### The Most Precious Sense

The more a mother knows about her baby's eyes and vision, the more fascinating it will be to watch baby grow and develop.

Baby specialists over the years have pointed out many times that vision can actually be the key to a fuller understanding of the needs of the individual child.

A mother looks into her baby's eyes to see whether he is happy, whether he is angry, whether he is puzzled or whether he is willing to cooperate. It is also true that if a child is not feeling well, it will first become evident in his eyes.

It is important to understand that vision is baby's most precious sense. Through his eyes he will gather more information about things around him than through any other part of his body. It is a truism that baby depends more on his vision than on his hearing, taste, smell and touch combined.

Consequently, how well your baby sees may also determine how he will grow and how he will develop as he grows. Science has shown that vision may affect a child's body posture as

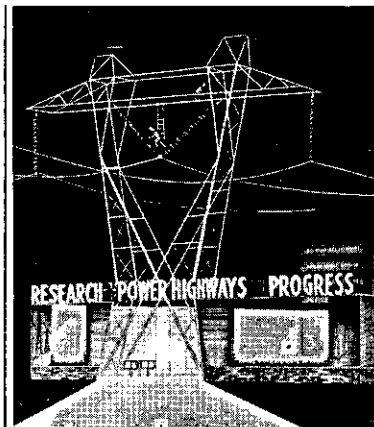

well as his personality.

For example, when a child does not see properly with both eyes working together as one, he may soon begin tilting his head or he will squirm into an unnatural posture as he avoids using one eye while looking at a toy or a picture book. The

danger in such a situation is that he may develop a head tilt, or a shoulder slump or even a curved spine, in addition to having poor vision.

If a child is too nearsighted, he may have no interest in playing games with other children. If he is too farsighted, he may avoid such close activity as reading and writing. If he's cross-eyed he may have difficulty in focusing his eyes properly, an eye that has been turned too long may even lose some of its vision. These are some of the eye problems parents should be alert for as they watch their child grow. They can affect a child in many different ways.

Proper vision is a very important element in your child's growth and development. No eye problem should go neglected. Professional eye care should be sought to help correct these various errors of nature.

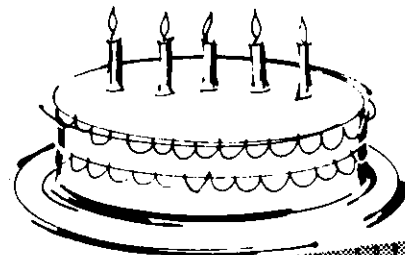

## CITY AND COUNTY SHOWS CIVIL WAR PHOTOGRAPHS

The City and County Savings Bank in conjunction with the nation-wide commemoration of the 100th anniversary of the Civil War will hold an exhibit of the PHOTOGRAPHS OF MATHEW B. BRADY, master photographer of Warren County, N. Y., at the bank's Community Exhibit Room at 100 State Street August 14 through Sep-

Brought to this area through the courtesy of AnSCO Incorporated of Binghamton, the exhibit is sponsored by the New York State Society of Newspaper Editors and the Eastern New York Press Photographers.

William G. Livingston, bank president, said the exhibit will be open to the public Monday through Friday from 9 a. m. to 3 p. m. and on Thursday until 8 p. m.

Representing the most complete pictorial story of the saga of the Civil War, the collection of photographs includes - besides epic scenes of the War - rare assemblage of Brady portraits discovered quite by chance in the attic of an old carriage house in Owego, New York. The plates, numbering 44, were protected by issues of newspapers - those of the Washington Evening Star and the Daily National, Washington, D. C., with headlines and date-lines of 1866 and 1874.

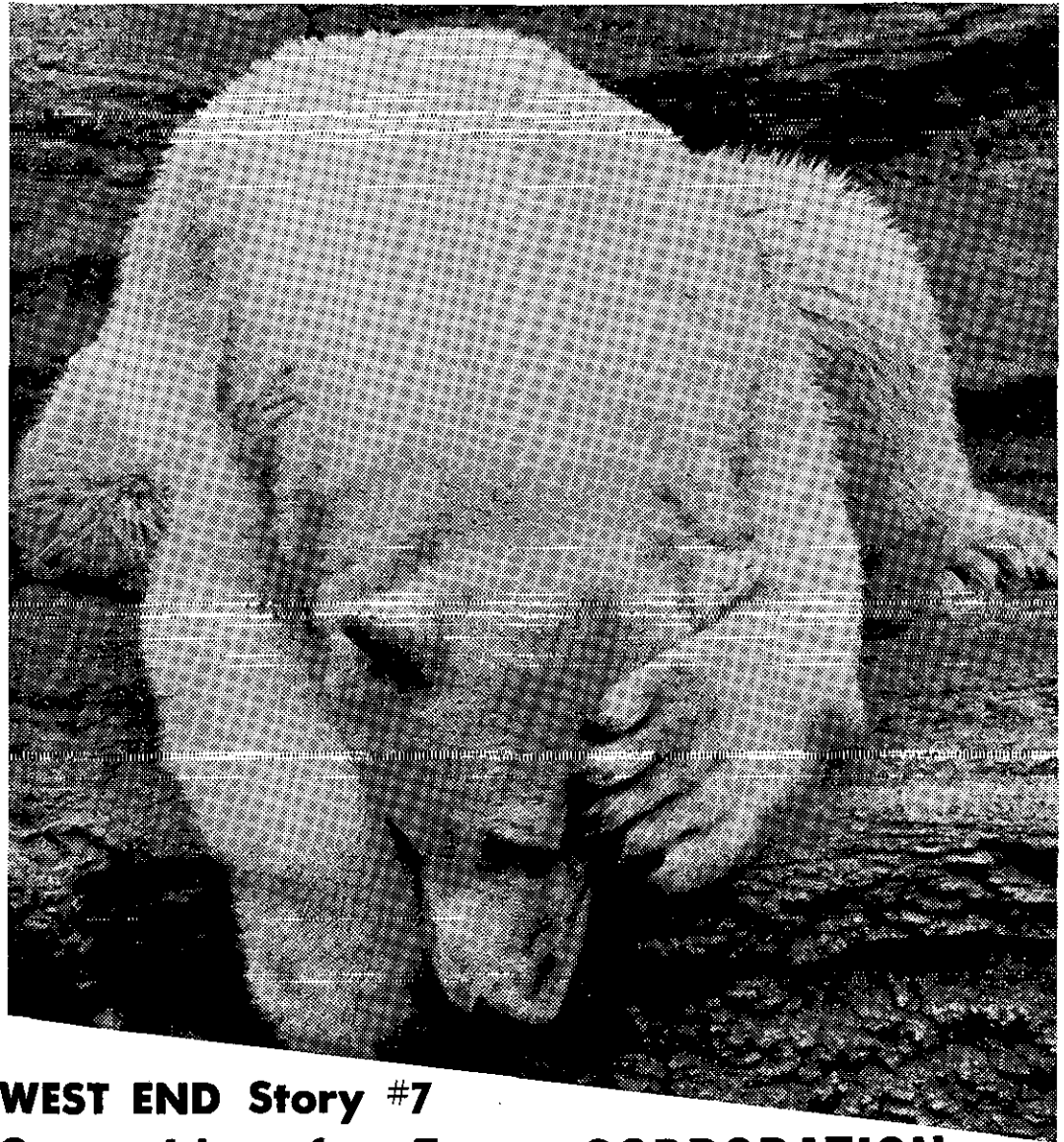

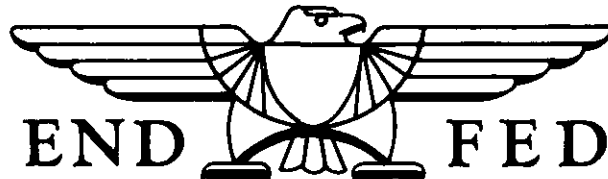

**NEW EGG CARTON**

A new type of egg carton is being tried out in Syracuse, N. Y. markets in a cooperative project with the New York State College of Agriculture at Cornell. Designed to keep eggs from absorbing odors or evaporating moisture, the carton is packed and sealed the same day eggs leave the farm. Eggs are sealed in the carton in pairs so that two may be removed at a time leaving the rest still in the original airtight seal. Each egg rests in its own separate multi-cushioned cell and the carton is transparent for easy home inventory.
