

BETHLEHEM CENTRAL RELEASES REGULATIONS ON OUT-OF-DISTRICT AND PAROCHIAL SCHOOLS

Under the law, Bethlehem Central School District is required to furnish transportation for pupils to attend private and available parochial schools located not more than ten miles from their homes, if their parents or guardians make timely legal requests therefor.

Bus Tokens for High School Pupils

In order to comply with this law our district will continue to furnish eligible pupils in grades 7 through 12 with bus tokens usable on the United Traction Company buses. Those who live over a mile from the bus line will be transported to the line by district-owned buses. Those who live within a mile of the bus line will walk between their homes and the buses.

Buses for Elementary Pupils

Elementary pupils in grades K through 6 will be transported to private and parochial schools outside the district by district-owned buses, private carriers, or public service buses. These pupils will be carried under the same general regulations and conditions which govern the transportation of pupils to Bethlehem Central elementary schools. Pupils may be required to walk up to one-half mile from their homes to board buses or to return home after alighting from them.

Deadlines

Resident parents or guardians who wish transportation for their children to attend non-public schools located outside of the school district must make written request to the Board of Education prior to April 1. Those who become residents after April 1 must make their request not later than August 1. Parents who do not apply for this transportation by that date are by law not entitled to it during the following school year.

For the convenience of parents, an application form is included with this release. Please detach it and return it to us with the requested information.




