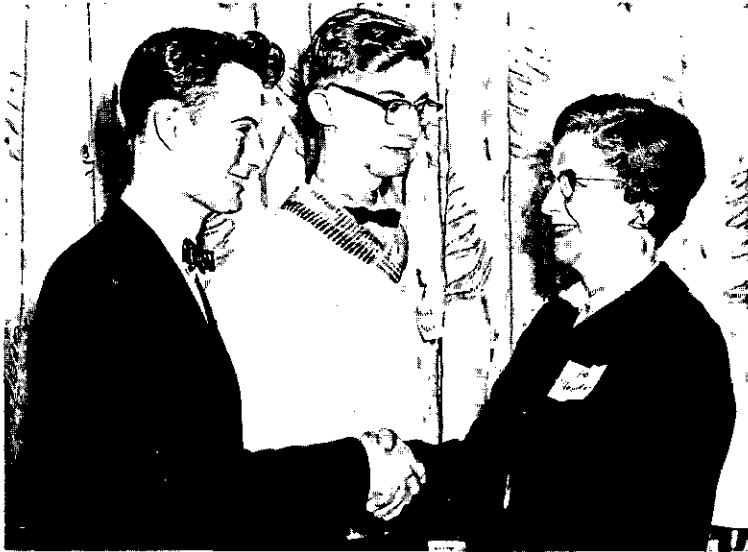

Slingerlands Players Schedule "The Great Sebastians" with Blue Stamps

"The play's the thing," says Shakespeare. But then, they didn't have trading stamps in Shakespeare's time.

The Slingerlands Community Players has never been at odds with the Bard's point of view, but, with their forthcoming production, the play isn't quite all of "the thing." As an added bonus, free trading stamps will be given for tickets bought before the next production.

Through an arrangement with the Grand Union-Empire Stores, 100 free Triple-S Blue stamps will be given for each ticket purchased before the next play, "The Great Sebastians," to be produced at Bethlehem Central Senior High School, on May 25 and 26.

Robert A. Cook, President of The Players, announced today that each advance-sale ticket will have a coupon attached which will entitle the holder to receive 100 free blue stamps at any Grand Union or Empire Store in the Albany area.

Mr. Cook said that the special offer is made only with ticket sales before the play

opens. The trading stamps will not be given for tickets sold at the door the nights of the play.

However, he noted, the plan will extend to season ticket holders. Well before the play, flyers announcing the production will be mailed to season ticket holders. With them will be sent coupons to exchange for the blue stamps.

"We believe that this is the first time that trading stamps have been given with play ticket purchases in this area," Mr. Cook said, "but we feel that this added bonus will be an extra inducement to playgoers. The main inducement still will be the play itself. And our ticket prices for this play will remain the same as they have been in the past."

The Players' production of "The Great Sebastians" will be directed by Martin Kelly, who directed the group's production of "Hotel Paradiso" last spring. Mr. Kelly soon will announce the complete cast and production staff for the upcoming play.

Local plans for the 1962 Bell Ringer Campaign for Mental Health were announced by Dr. Egon Plager, President, Albany County Mental Health Association.

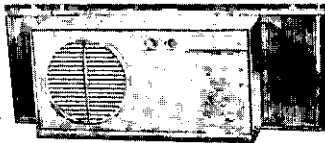

"Mental Illness is the nation's #1 Health Problem," explained Justice Bergan.

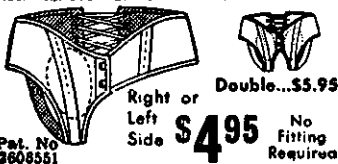

TOILET TRAINING

Child Study Association of America

Doctors advise against starting bowel training before the baby's muscular and nervous system is able to meet this demand from adults.

If you begin training too early, your child is more likely to go back to soiling later on. Also, if you start too early, you are likely to become tense and angry with your child. He may become confused and resist you. You may find out also, that you waste more time putting him on the pot than it takes to wash the extra diapers. Wait until he can show you that he is ready to have a movement and can get himself there under his own steam. Probably this will be somewhere between a year and a year and a half.

If you are patient, you will probably find that he has his own regular time and rhythm. Put him on the pot or toilet at his time and not when you think he ought to go. Don't make it all too important, but be pleased when he performs. Then he will be pleased too, and more ready to do what you want.

Don't be surprised, though, if he lapses occasionally. Take it casually, change his pants without any scolding, and remind him to tell you the next time.

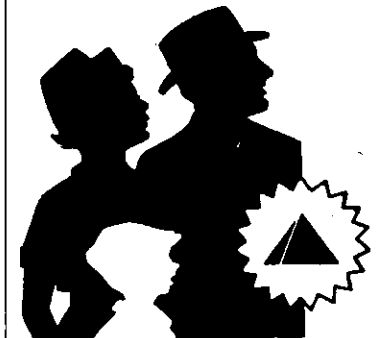
The time to begin to train a baby to be dry is difficult to set at a fixed age that would apply to all children. They vary considerably in the point at which they seem to be ready to take this step.
