BRIG. GEN. MCLAUGHLIN RETIRES AFTER 37 YEARS

Brigadier General Frank McLaughlin of 61 Salisbury Road, Delmar, N.Y., is retiring as Chief of Staff of the New York Army National Guard and Executive Officer in the State Division of Military and Naval Affairs, it was announced by Major General A. C. O'Hara, Chief of Staff to the Governor

and Commanding General of the New York Army National Guard. A successor will be named at a later date.

General McLaughlin's retirement was effective July 15. He is a veteran with 37 years of Federal and State service.

He began his military career when he enlisted as a private in the 107th Infantry of the New York National Guard (old 7th Regiment) in New York City in August 1925. He advanced to the grade of first lieutenant when the 107th was redesignated as the 207th Coast Artillery Antiaircraft in 1940 and inducted into Federal service in 1941. He was promoted to captain in January, 1942, and then to major and Commanding Officer to the newly-activated 3rd Battalion in August, 1942.

On the reorganization of the Antiaircraft in 1943, he was promoted to lieutenant colonel and assigned as Commanding Officer of the 247th Antiair-

AMBULANCE SERVICE ASKS YOUR HELP FOR EXPENSES

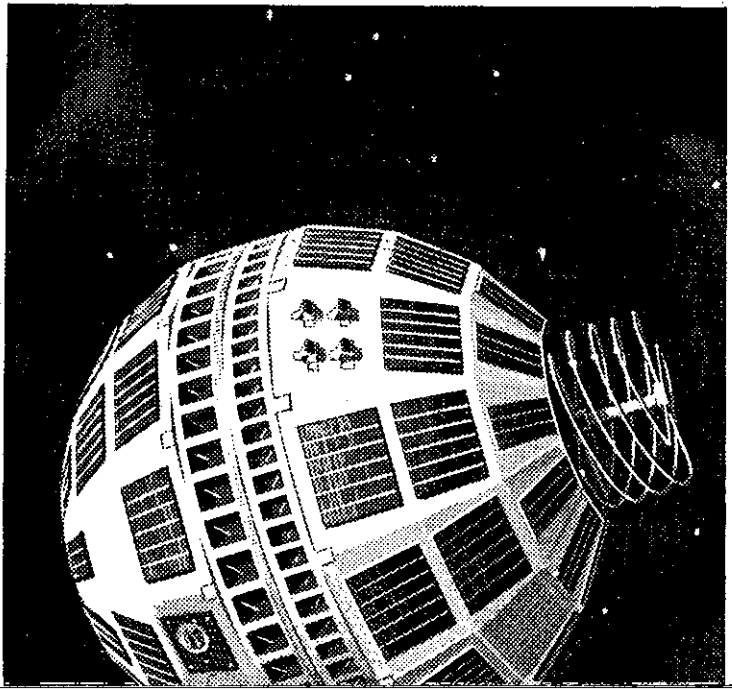

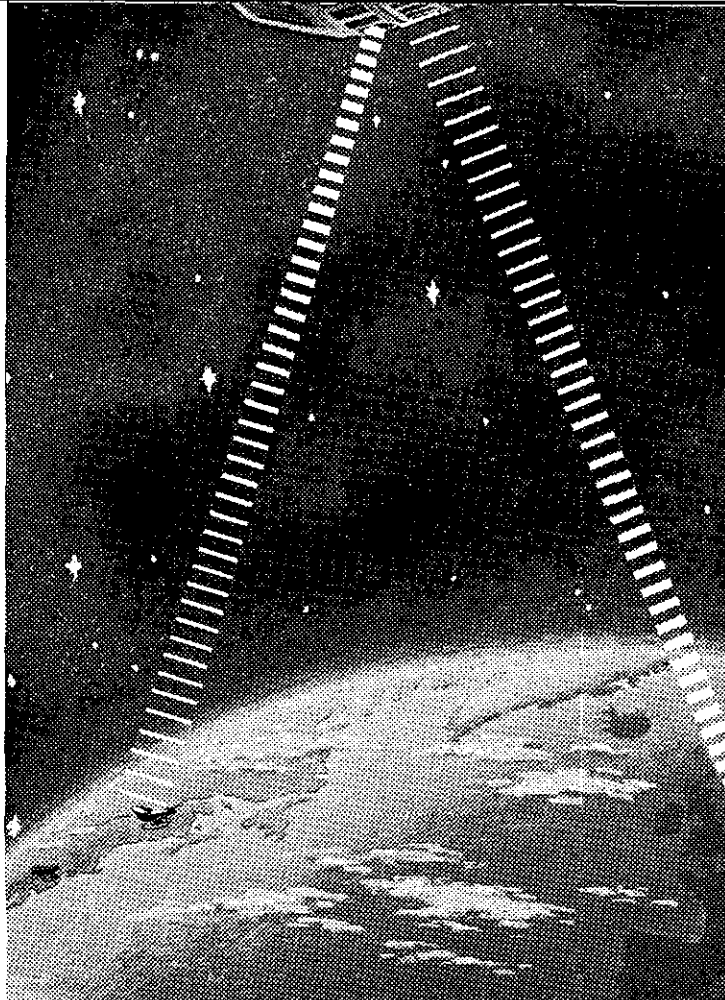

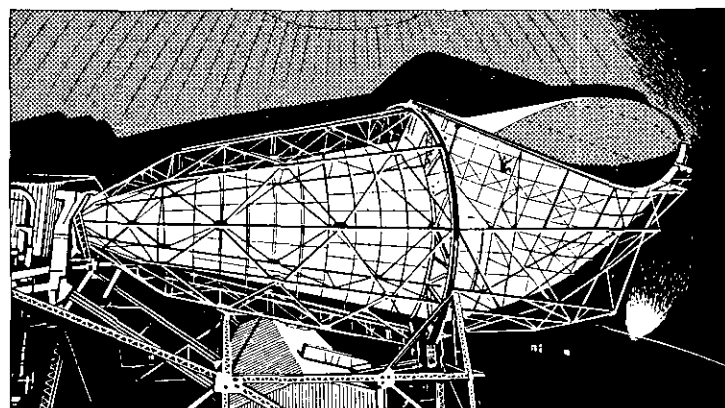

America arising from telephone research

The world's first private enterprise communications satellite is now being used for dramatic experiments in relaying telephone calls and television internationally.

Its name: Telstar. It was launched from Cape Canaveral at Bell System expense by the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.

Telstar receives signals beamed to it from a ground station, amplifies them and transmits them to another station on the ground below—perhaps an ocean away from the first one. The new satellite thus acts as a microwave relay station in the sky, enabling voices, TV pictures and data messages to leap thousands of miles in a new and exciting way.

The ground stations in the U.S. now being used for Telstar were built by the Bell System at Andover, Maine, and Holmdel, New Jersey. Organizations abroad have built stations in England and France. The latter, a near replica of the station in Maine, is being assembled with Bell System cooperation. A receiving station in Italy will be ready by this year, and another in West Germany next.

Telstar is a first major experimental step in a world-wide satellite communications system that was first proposed as a practical venture by the Telephone Laboratories. Progress toward the system would not have reached its present stage without continuing research and development by the private communications industry, including fundamental Bell System contributions—the maser, the solar battery, the traveling wave tube, the ruby masers, the waveguide, and new antenna designs for the ground stations with innovations in circuitry.
