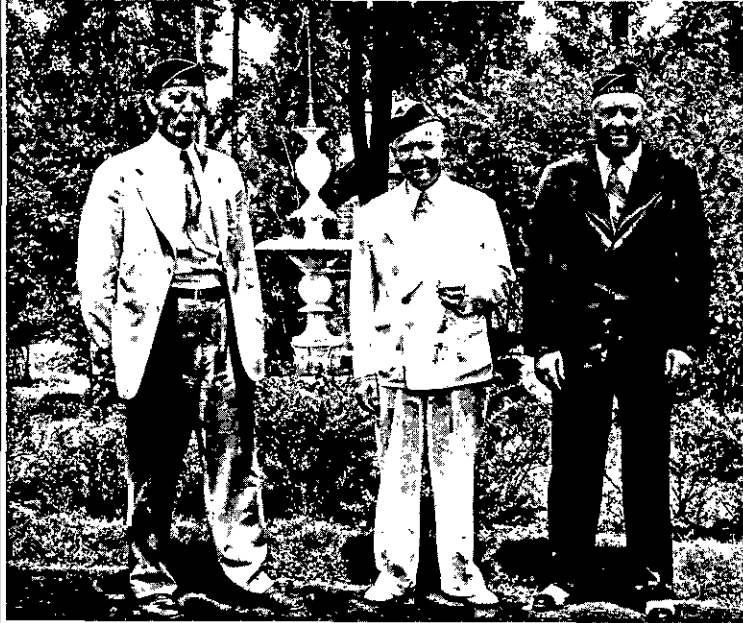

OVERWHELMING ROCKEFELLER VOTE WHAT deHEUS PREDICTED

Re-Dedication Ceremonies Set for Sunday

The program for the rededication of Veterans Memorial Park has been announced by Otto deHeus, sole survivor of the original committee which founded this landmark at the junction of Delmar and Elsmere on Delaware Avenue. Dr. Thomas Holmes and John M. Oliver, both World War I veterans, are deceased. The Park, originally dedicated November 22, 1942, has been used for a parade termination point and for Memorial Day services by the American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars. The land on which the park is situated is owned by Arthur M. Main, prominent Delmar oil dealer, who said, "If it were not for the veterans, both living and those who made the supreme sacrifice, we might at this very moment be the slaves of an intolerable government. I feel humble and happy that the perpetuity of this park is

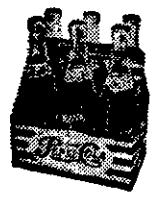

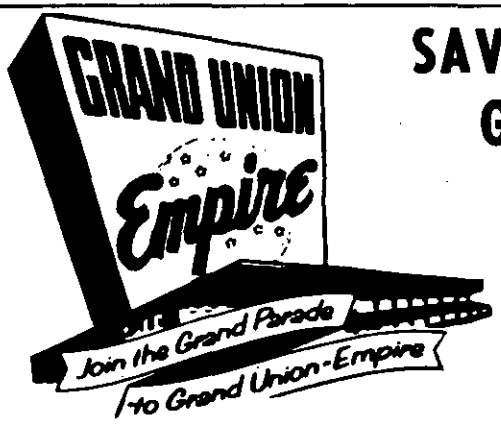

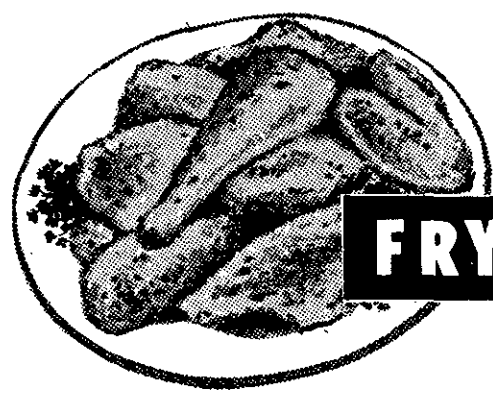

New Addition at L'Auberge

A new addition with an old look at L'Auberge des Fougères is the men's bar in a dining area (separate from the public dining room) reserved exclusively for men during the luncheon hours. Both areas are open to the general public during dinner hours.

This mellowed oak attraction saw many years of good service in the old Wolferts Roost Country Club. It is probably the only bar Mr. McCabe ever "collected." Other evidences of his hobby as a collector of old pewter, silver, prints, oils and documents are a part of the Auberge decor.

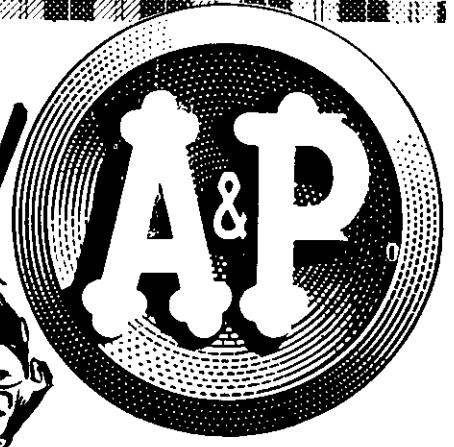

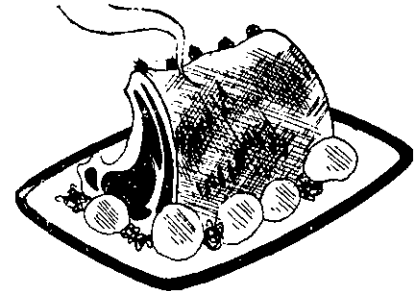



Country Club Opens Season

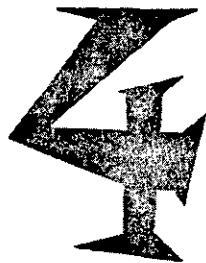
