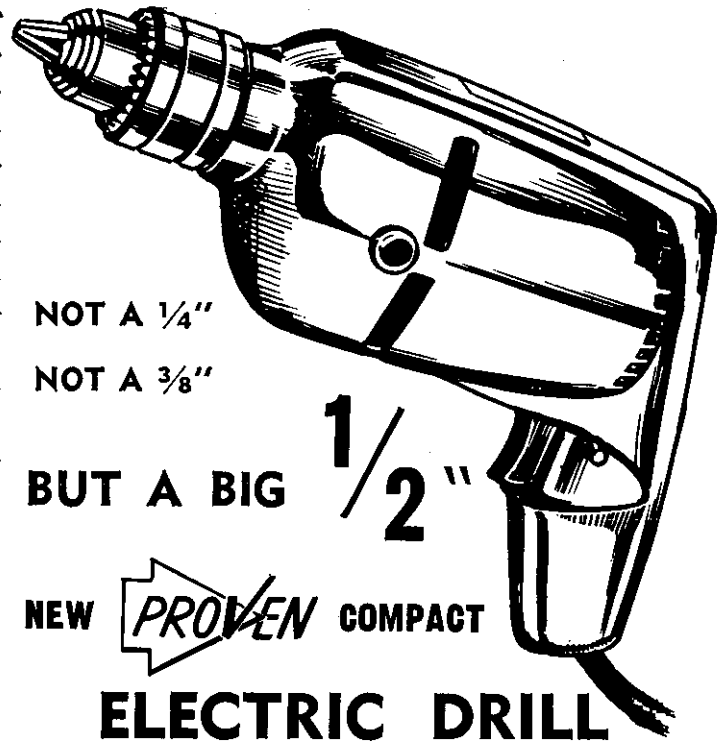

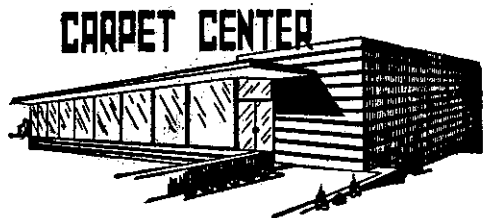
Concerts at City & County
