#### Mother-of-Pearl Silverware Is Featured in Library Exhibit

Twinkling underholiday lights is the exhibit of mother-ofpearl silverware belonging to Mrs. Sherman Murphy, which is now on display at the Delmar Public Library. Mrs. Murphy began collecting the pearl handled knives, forks and spoons after her grandmother left her 12 dinner knives. She began noticing the occasional and rare piece in antique shows and shops, finding the gravy ladle here at the local St. Andrew's Fair, and also the fish forks and knives at their second Antique Show.

In her collection, tiny spoons made completely of mother-of-pearl are one mystery as they are too large for use as salt spoons yet smaller than a teaspoon. These came from Montenego Bay, Jamaica. One piece was dug from the ground when a barn was repaired in San Diego, California, when the Murphys were there. Ingeniously, someone joined a spoon to a mother-of-pearl button hook handle and this makes an entertaining piece.

Her luncheon forks, Mrs. Murphy relates, are a gift from her husband, while her jauntiest piece is a mother-of-pearl tooth pick.
