**New Bond Announced**

A reminder that the new \$75 Series E United States Savings Bond, bearing the portrait of the late President Kennedy, will go on sale May 1, came today from Mr. Frederick W. Stolz, County Savings Bonds Chairman.

"The reproduction of this memorable statement on the face of the bond," said Mr. Stolz, "is a fresh reminder that our citizens help strengthen their own security and, consequently, the security of their community and their country when they invest a portion of their savings in Savings Bonds."
