

## ALAN HILCHIE ENTERS BOARD RACE

Alan Hilchie, 39 Alden Court, Elsmere, ten years a member of the Bethlehem business community, has filed for the vacancy on the Bethlehem Central High School Board of Education, presently held by Whitman Daniels, who recently announced his retirement.

Mr. Hilchie attended public Schools in northern New York State, graduating in 1940. After serving three years in the U.S. Navy in the South Pacific theatre, he returned to St. Lawrence University and was graduated in 1948 with the degree of Bachelor of Arts. He and his wife, Ann, have two children, ages 7 and 12.

Mr. Hilchie served two terms as President of the Bethlehem Chamber of Commerce, dur-

ing which he directed and helped organize Bethlehem Chamber of Commerce "Opportunity for Growth, Inc." an organization which requested local government officials to rezone, for industrial purposes, the southern part of the Town of Bethlehem to encourage industrial growth there.

He is also affiliated with the Bethlehem Lodge #1096 Free & Accepted Masons. Mr. Hilchie has served on the Official Board of the 1st Methodist Church of Delmar, where he is a member. He also was an active member of the Lincolns. He sponsors a Little League Ball Club, under the name of Hilchie's Hardware.

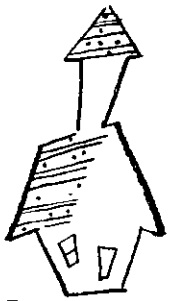
