# STIMMEL ATTACKS DPW FOR BYPASS LOCATION

The Bethlehem-New Scotland Roads Association last night called for early construction of the southside arterial highway to speed suburban traffic to the State Campus area and downtown Albany.

Association president Frederick C. Stimmel told a communitywide meeting in Bethlehem Central Senior High School that 80 percent of Delmar-Elsmere residents would be better served by the planned southside artery than by the Delmar-Slingerlands bypass link proposed by the Department of Public Works.

At the same time, Stimmel asked the DPW to conduct an informational meeting of its own, and pledged cooperation of his organization in developing a road location of "most benefit to us, not only for the present, but for the future."

d by the association to help resolve the dispute between residents and the DPW over the route of the Slingerlands and Delmar bypasses and their connecting link, which presently is designed to cut through the hamlet of Slingerlands.

Stimmel pointed out that fewer than 50 residents of Delmar, those working now or slated to be transferred to the State Campus site, would be benefited by the bypass connector under its present alignment.

"We therefore raise the question," he declared, "whether the connector is even needed, when you compare the needs of fewer than 50 people to construction costs of some \$1 million a mile."

If the bypasses were built along the route originally proposed by the Department in 1958, and the southside arterial highway were speedily constructed, Stimmel said all of Slingerlands and 80 percent of Delmar and Elsmere residents would be able to reach Albany locations more swiftly than by using the presently proposed bypass connector.

He added that the extension of the bypasses to connect in New Scotland would be of great benefit to the expansion of New

Scotland and Guilderland Villages.

"The DPW's original westerly route would provide quick access to outlying areas and help stimulate industrial and commercial growth of New Scotland in those areas zoned for such expansion," Stimmel asserted.

"At a public hearing in 1959, the DPW had this to say about its 1958 route:" he said. "'The red line (showing bypasses meeting at routes 85 and 85-A) will serve as a bypass of Delmar and Slingerlands while taking into account the growth trend of areas toward the west and south, and serve as a central artery to the greater Delmar area and stimulate growth in this section of the Capital district.' We agree with them!"

The department has a moral obligation to build the bypasses to skirt Slingerlands, Stimmel declared. 'In 1961, residents and the Town Board of Bethlehem withdrew opposition to the DPW plans on their publicly declared assurances that the two bypasses would be connected in an undeveloped area; that the bypass would not cut our residential section, nor our town, in half; that every consideration would be given to the preservation of the residential character of our community, and that a new proposed alignment would be presented to the Town Board for approval."

Stimmel said if the bypasses were joined west of Slingerlands, two road crossings and one railroad crossing would be unnecessary, and right-of-way acquisition costs-would be less for open land than the residential property now in the design.

"And the cost of a new location could be saved," he said, "since the 1958 route has been completely engineered already."

The association president said DPW Superintendent J. Burch McMorran and DPW District Engineer Frank J. Fuller had both been invited to participate in the meeting, both declined.

It. Governor Malcolm Wilson was represented at the meeting by his counsel, John Forner.

# CAR WASH REALITY FADES IN LATEST COURT RULING

The Appellate Division of the Supreme Court has ruled (on May 6, 1964) in a unanimous decision that The Town of Bethlehem Board of Zoning Appeals exceeded its jurisdiction when it granted Fleahman-Rice a special exception to build an Automatic Car Wash at the intersection of Euclid Avenue and Delaware Avenue in Elsmere. The appeal's court ordered the Bethlehem Zoning Board of Appeals' decision annulled. The effect of the decision is that as of now there is no authorization to build the Car Wash.

The Bethlehem Board of Appeals granted a special exception to Fleahman-Rice (back on December 13, 1963) to build the car wash after a heated hearing which was held on November 21, 1962. Several residents of Elsmere then instituted a court action to overrule the Board of Appeals. The Appellate Division ruling of May 6, 1964, reverses a ruling in favor of Fleahman-Rice and the board which was made by a Special Term of the Supreme Court on August 27, 1963.

The residents who brought the action to court are: William J. Hartnett and Blanche S. Hartnett, Lyle K. Oliver and Dorothy W. Oliver, Douglas D. Reynolds and Margaret Reynolds, Arthur E. Robinson and Lillian Y. Robinson, Christine Pauly, Harry T. O'Brien and Alma T. O'Brien, Martin L. Barr and Leonore Y. Barr.

The long legal battle started in April of 1962, when Arthur Zautner, the Town of Bethlehem Building Inspector, issued a building permit to Fleahman-Rice to build the automatic car wash. In another case (actually the first one) the Elsmere residents appealed from the Building Inspector's action. The Building Inspector was overruled by the board and after a
