# 97.7 PERCENT VOTE OPPOSITION TO BY-PASS LOCATION

Opposition to a proposed bypass connector through Slingerlands is nearly unanimous among Bethlehem residents polled by the Bethlehem-New Scotland Roads Association during its May 13 information meeting.

Frederick C. Stimmel, president of the association, today released figures showing some 97.7 percent of the voters objected to the Department of Public Works plan to link the Delmar and Slingerlands bypasses with a four-lane divided highway through the heart of Slingerlands.

Predictably, the bulk of the opposition came from Slinger-lands residents. But, Stimmel pointed out, about 17 percent of the tallies opposing the DPW plan came from residents of Delmar, Elsmere, Glenmont, New Scotland, Voorheesville, Feura Bush, and Albany.

A total of 477 votes were cast, Stimmel said. Of the 466 who opposed the route, 341 were Slingerlands residents, 82 were outside Slingerlands. And 43 votes were unidentified geographically. Eleven voters favored the DPW proposal.

A majority of the voters making comments wanted a return to the 1958 DPW route, which called for the two bypasses to join west of Slingerlands at routes 85 and 85A, Stimmel said.

In polling attendees of the meeting, the Association had invited comments. Examples cited by Stimmel included these:

"Although residents of western Delmar, we consider the beauty and grace of Slingerlands an asset to the entire Albany area."

"The 1958 proposal still seems adequate. Why was it not carried out?" - Delmar resident.

"It seems unlikely, in view of tonight's presentation that the DPW will be able to justify the present proposed link even on engineering or traffic-flow grounds. But even if it can, the desire of the citizens to preserve the character of their community must govern."

The building is located at the corner of Rt. 32 and 9W. During the past summer it was completely renovated and during this year has housed 108 kindergarteners from Glenmont and Delmar. The Bethlehem Center School was built in 1925 and has the air of a country day school with spacious play area, fine play facilities, and lovely old trees. The building has housed many boys and girls from the area ranging from kindergarten age to eighth grade at one time during its years of use.

During 1956-57, it was used to accommodate first and second graders of the Glenmont School prior to the completion and opening of that building in May of 1957. From then until the fall of 1963, it has been the home of the Tri-Village Nursery School.

Increased enrollment in the Bethlehem District, and particularly in Delmar, Hamagrael and Glenmont necessitated the move to use the building as a kindergarten school in order to free classrooms for other groups in the larger buildings.

On hand to greet guests on June 3 will be the school's staff, including the three classroom teachers: Mrs. Carol Forrest, Mrs. Mary Freeman, and Miss Dorothy Weiss.





After the Department secures bids for the Slingerlands bypass section to Maher Road, he said, it will advertise for bids for a second contract covering the remainder of the bypass to the Town of New Scotland and the connection with the Delmar bypass at Elm Avenue. This second segment will include an interchange in the vicinity of Font Grove Road, Slingerlands, to enable ready access to and from the bypass for Slingerlands area residents.

When the Slingerlands bypass is completed, traffic now using New Scotland Road (Route 85) will have a modern, easy-to travel facility between Albany, the Tri-Village area and John Boyd Thacher State Park.

### Typewriting and Developmental Reading Offered by ABC

Typewriting and Developmental Reading will feature the six-week summer session, July 6 to August 14, at the Albany Business College.






