

THE STORY OF THE FIRST 35 YEARS

Delmar Lumber was conceived on a December evening in 1928. A. C. Rowe, Jr., a general contractor, casually called at the office of D. A. Bennett, who always installed his heating and plumbing.

During the evening's visit they discovered that each had future plans entirely unknown to the other.

Mr. Bennett, who already owned land adjoining the railroad, was about to add a line of building supplies to his plumbing business which, in those times, included a masonry septic tank and the drainage field.

Mr. Rowe could see advantage in buying lumber in car lots for his building operations. Then too, each hoped to add volume to the new ventures by selling to the public.

As the evening advanced, this little visit turned to serious business. If they had lumber and builders' supplies, why not hardware and paint and complete the line?

As always with younger people the matter of finance loomed big.

Having been friendly since childhood, it was suggested that they pool resources on a 50-50 basis; a condition still existing between the two families.

The early hours of the next morning found a new, unnamed business determined to find its place in the Delmar area.

A young lawyer, William J. Comstock, prepared the legal matters, a name was decided upon, the corporation formed, and the Delmar Lumber & Builders' Supply, Inc. opened for business on April 1, 1929 in a space 12 ft. by 36 ft. in the present D. A. Bennett, Inc. store with one employee, Kenneth Smith. A lumber shed was built and the Hardware store soon expanded.

By 1935 the bookkeeping was a mess and John W. Warner came to the rescue and still keeps them in order.

By 1937 this small store could no longer hold the merchandise and on April 1, 1938, the present location was acquired at 340 Delaware Ave.

In 1946, when the Marines

no longer needed 'Bob' Jackson, a son-in-law of Mr. Bennett, he became a member of the firm, and still manages the office, hardware, and paint departments.

In 1949, directly after Army service, 'Scotty' Rowe, son of Mr. Rowe, also became a member of the firm and manages the lumber and builders' supply department.

Now, after 35 years of healthy business, due in no small part to the 16 faithful and cooperative employees, they find that nearly every year they have expanded and added to buildings, equipment, and merchandise. The lumber yard is mechanized and fully stocked and the retail store and office are now 14 times the size of the original.

The officers of the corporation look backward with pride and forward with anticipation and determination.
