Photocopying Machine Added At Delmar Public Library

Now it can be told: the Delmar Public Library admits that it "copies." The newly installed photocopying machine makes full-size copies of all sorts of material, tuming out a facsimile in seconds.

Mrs. Barbara R. Rau, Librarian, expects the vicomatic copying machine will be especially useful to students and businessmen. "Students can now make copies of noncirculating reference works and periodicals without the help of the library staff," Mrs. Rau explained.

The Vico-Matic delivers copies up to 8½x14 inches, but even the larger reference book pages can be copied in sections. The material being copied cannot be dam-

aged by the machine. The original is placed face down on the machine and never passes through it. A 25-cent piece is droppedinto the slot, a button is pressed and the machine makes a ready-to-use, legible copy in seconds. No copy or negative is left in the machine and the operation is completely private. Only the operator knows what is being copied.

The public is invited to use the machine to copy such non-library items as birth certificates, deeds, wills and similar documents. Copies can be made at any time during regular library hours.







Little wonder that the newborn baby appears disturbed and so mad at the world that he could yell and does. But greatwonder is the skill with which engineered his little body to prepare it for birth. For example, the skull is made up of separate sections which do not meet. Thus, during the birth, they can be pressed together, even overlap to ease its passage through the birth canal. It is for the same reason that the buttocks are small and the shoulders narrow.

In time the head resumes its normal shape. The sections of the skull fuse and the easily seen spot, where they didn't meet, closes. The skin-becomes smooth and pink and the little arms and legs that were flexed and bent by baby's prenatal position straighten. Soon everyone notices that baby really is beautiful but never as beautiful as during the moment when mother looked on baby with love for the first time.


