September is TOPS - with us!

Balmy September is a good month to be alive.

And, according to the Institute of Life Insurance, your chances of staying alive in September are better than in any other month. Death doesn't take a holiday, but no other month has so low a mortality rate.

The Institute pointed out that the nation's deaths run about 10% lower in September than the average for the rest of the year.

In 1962 (the latest year for which monthly figures are available) there were 715 deaths in September for every million Americans, compared with an average monthly rate of 787 for the year as a whole. June's rate, 735, was next lowest. The worst month was January, with 883 deaths per million Americans.

One reason seems to be September's mild weather in many parts of the country. Deaths due to pneumonia, tuberculosis and several other respiratory or infectious diseases run significantly lower in September.
