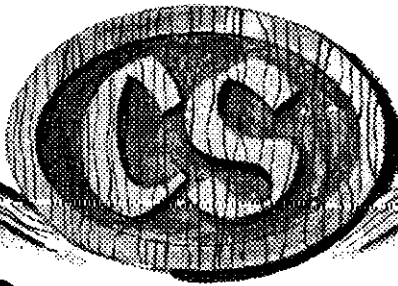
The kiddies will be in for a day of games, rides, and entertainment while the parents are at the auction or visiting the booths.

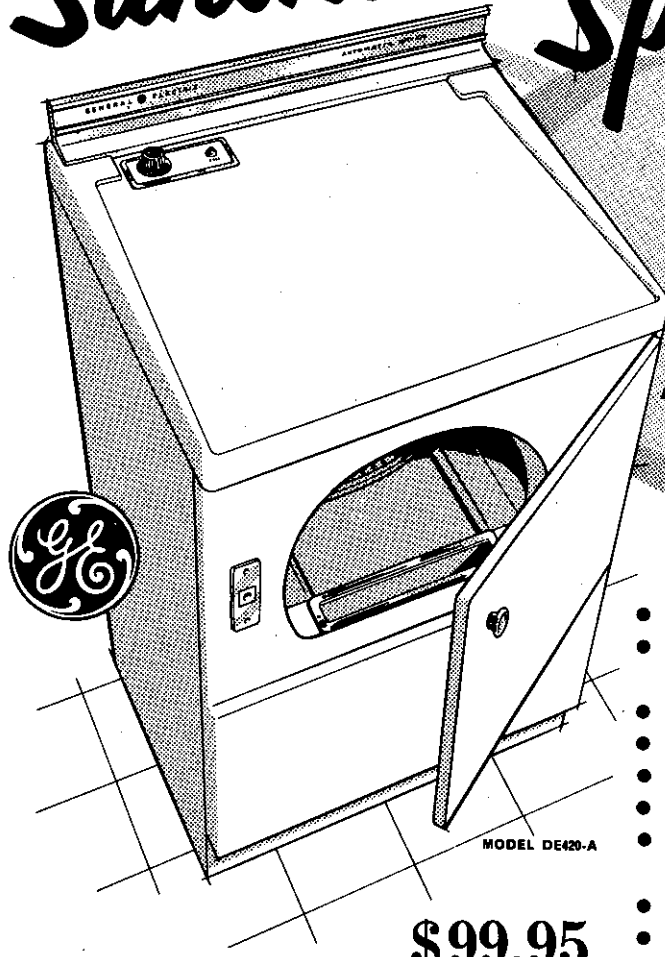
All events will take place regardless of the weather and special provisions will be made in the event of rain.
