Live Nativity Scene

A live nativity scene will be presented by the Commission on Education of the Delmar Methodist Church on the evenings of December 21, 22, 23 and 24 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. The living tableau will be shown under lights out of doors in front of the Kenwood Avenue face of the church's new education building.

The presentation will be a church family undertaking involving a total of about 250 people, although only ten per-

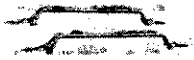

their time and abilities to be of service to us; yet, many times we prevent this service. While waiting for the ambulance or fire trucks a few minutes may seem like hours, but sometimes it takes the men more than the necessary few minutes to reach their destination because of inconsiderate citizens.

The cars belonging to the volunteers are equipped with blue lights. When an emergency arises, these blue lights plus the car horns are used to warn the citizens of the existing situation. This means: Get Out of the Way; it does not mean; stop where you are OR yell at the driver because of his excessive speed.

Be aware of the blue lights and honking. Keep reminding yourself and your family what they mean. Be considerate of the men who are helping you at any time of the day or night.
