#### New Visiting Hours for . New Fathers

New visiting hours for obstetrical patients of Albany Medical Center Hospital will go into effect on Jan. 1, 1965. The hours will be: 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. (husbands only), 3 p.m. to 4 p.m., and 7 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Except for the "husbands only" time period, patients may have upto, but not more than, two visitors at any one time. Infants may be seen by visitors at the nursery window throughout these visiting hours.

Hospital regulations require that all visitors be free of known symptoms of respiratory, gastrointestinal and skin infections.
