New Pistol Club Formed

Among the newest clubs in the Tri-Village area is the Albany County Pistol Club. As the name signifies the Club is devoted exclusively to pistol marksmanship. The clubhouse was built by the members themselves and is located at the end of Winne Place in Elsmere near the Little League Ballpark. It contains a regulation 50 foot range with eight firing positions for all calibers of pistols, as well as a meeting room and kitchen.

In addition to participating in official National Rifle Association pistol matches, on December 2, 1964 the Club had a "shoot-out" with the Mayfair Archery Club - pistols versus bows and arrows. The amazing thing is that the Club won by only 100 points. A re-match has been scheduled for January 14, 1965 at the Pistol Clubhouse.

The range and all facilities of the Club are open to all licensed pistol owners at a small charge. The regular shooting night is Tuesday starting at 8 p.m. Anyone interested in improving his aim, just shooting up some ammunition or joining the Club should contact either of the two Secretaries or the Executive Officer.
