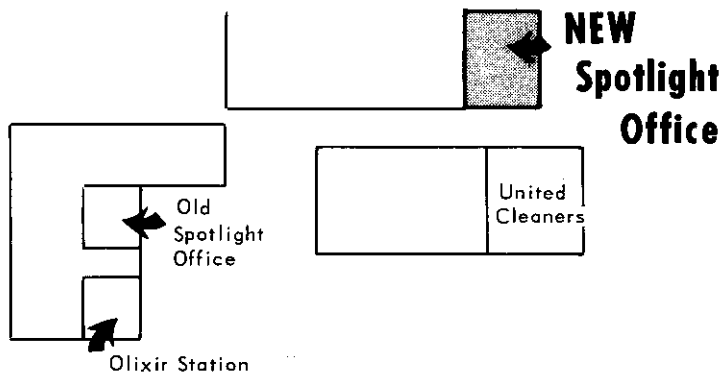

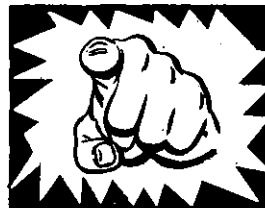

Residents of Elsmere are cordially invited to an Open House on May 20 between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. at the Elsmere Elementary School, sponsored by the Parent-Teacher Association.

The purpose of the Open House is to present the opportunity to tour the new wing of the school and to see the renovations that have been made to the existing building.

In the thirty-seven years of operation this is the second addition made to the original

building, which was constructed in 1928. The first addition to the school was made in 1947 and the current one being completed in 1965.

Contained in the new wing are three much needed classrooms, a new kitchen and cafeteria where approximately three hundred lunches are prepared and served daily, and the new locker-rooms and showers. Renovations to the existing building consisted of resurfacing of blackboards, painting of all rooms, new bath-

All three girls are 1963 graduates of Bethlehem Central High School. "It was like a little reunion when we found ourselves among the finalists," one of them told me.

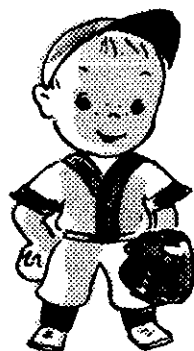

Perky said she has a steady date, but plans for marriage are far in her future. "I'm too busy right now," she said.

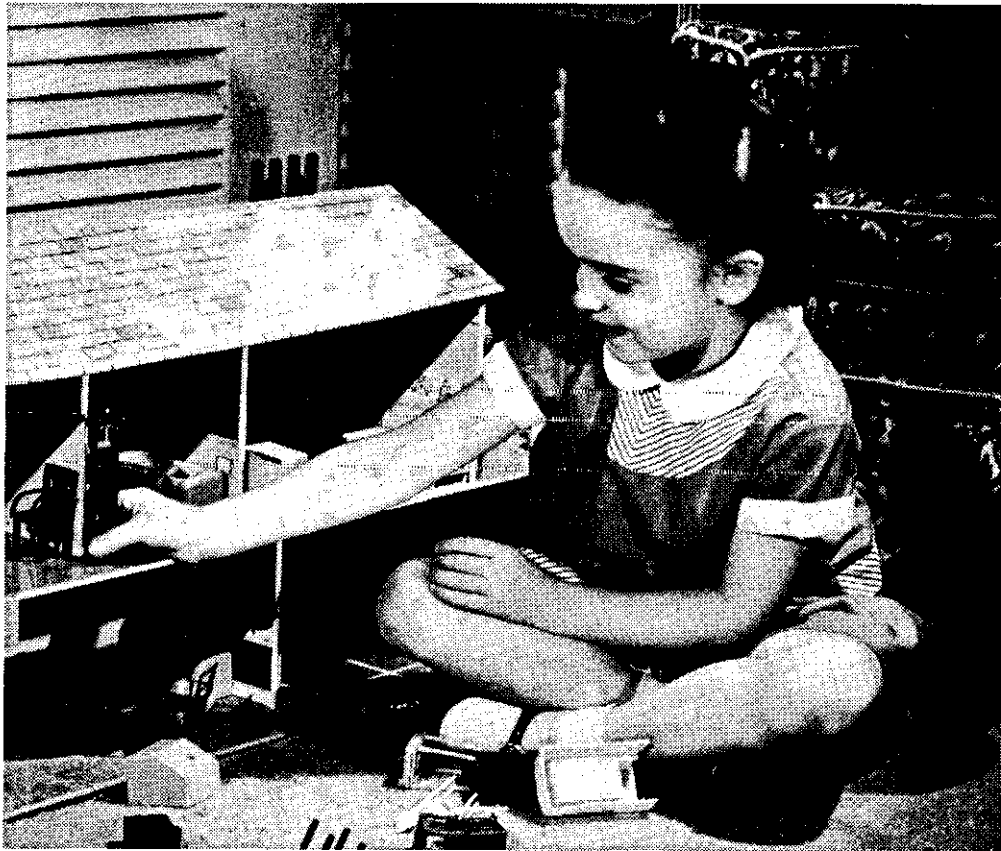
