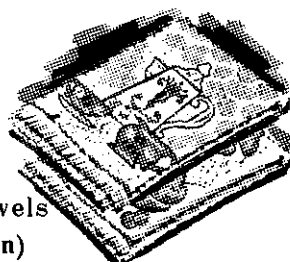

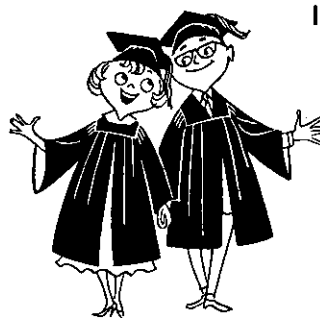


## Graduation Day

were followed by a general birthday party for the children and refreshments for guests.

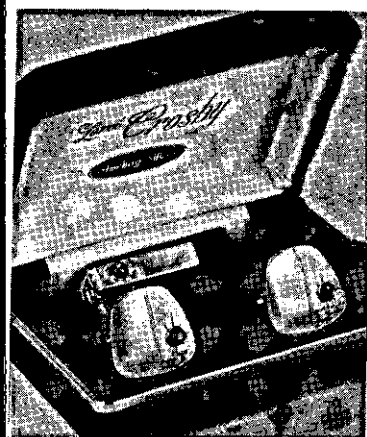
## Grad
