

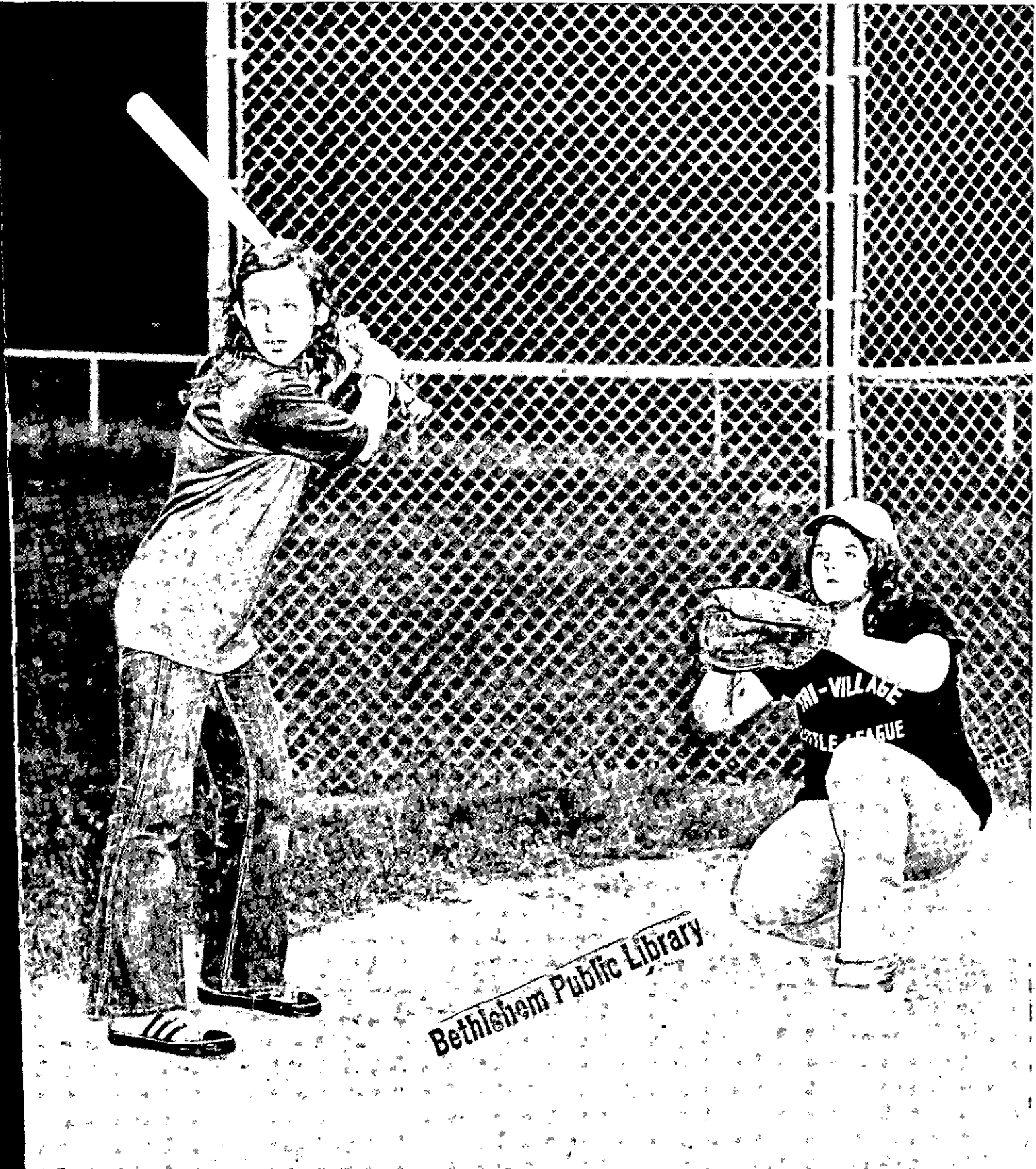

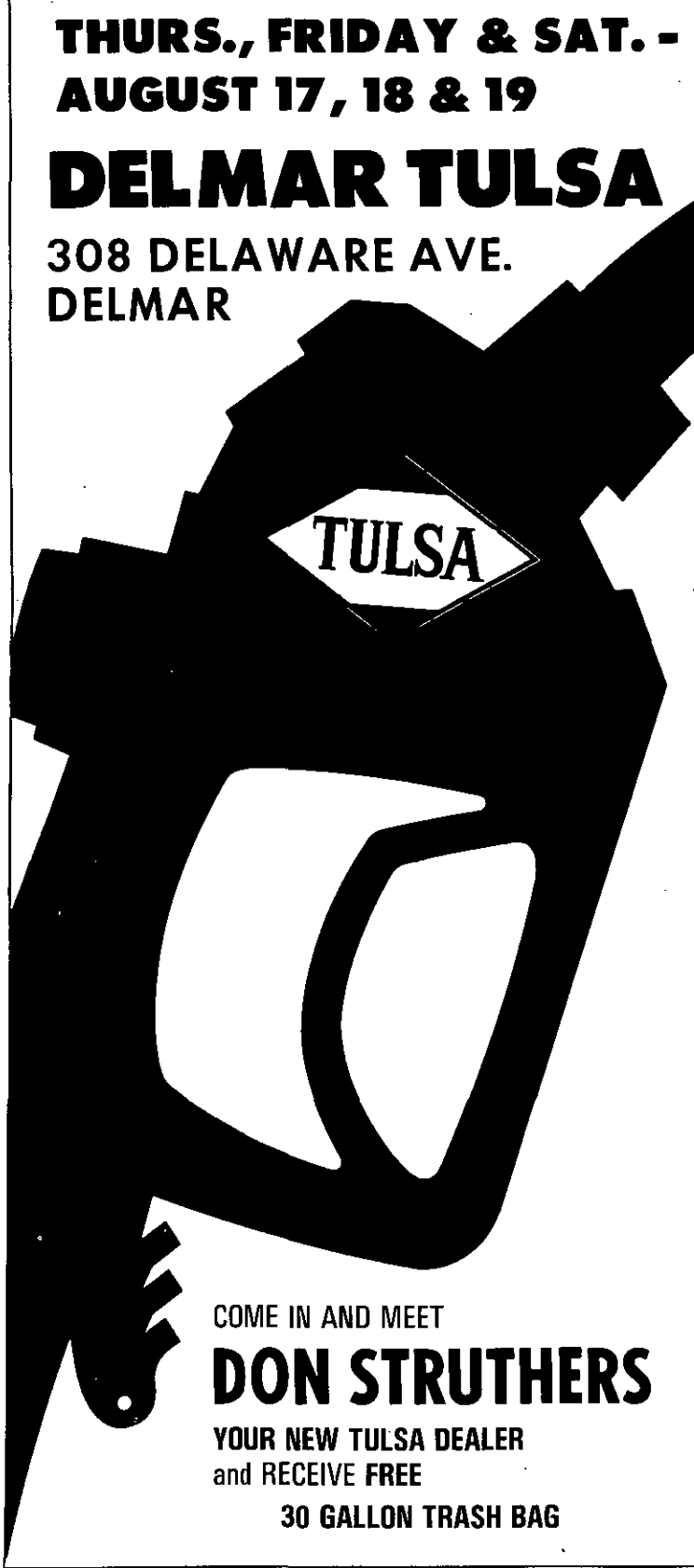

Louis' other shots included one of pitcher Sue Collins and a perfect catch by Patty Collins.

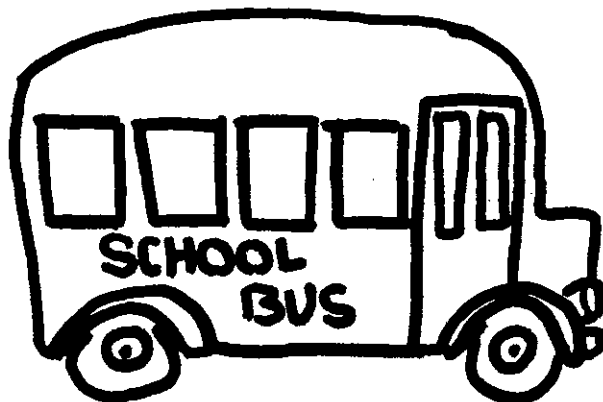

A draft of a policy statement regarding the appointment of another professional employee to assume responsibility in the event of emergencies occurring during the absence of principals from their buildings was approved by the Board, subject to certain clarifications which will be discussed with the principals.

**THAT EPIDEMIC** of leaving things on the car roof still goes on. We don't dare keep on telling the stories: nobody would believe us!

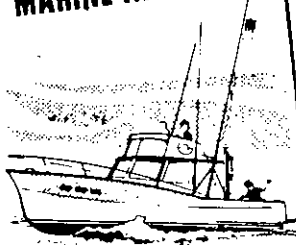
