Enveloped in a yellow apron, can be a boy washing a tabletop, dipping his cloth in a basin of water which he carried without spilling a drop from a child-high sink in the corner. This is a "practical life" exercise in order and cleanliness. Children learn alphabet sounds by using sandpaper letters which they can trace with their fingers while they say the phonetic sounds of the letters to themselves.

No one interferes with his neighbors. The children are content and relaxed as if at play. But it is not play — it is

a program of work and enjoyment.

The directress — teacher introduces new material to the children and they choose to follow it through. 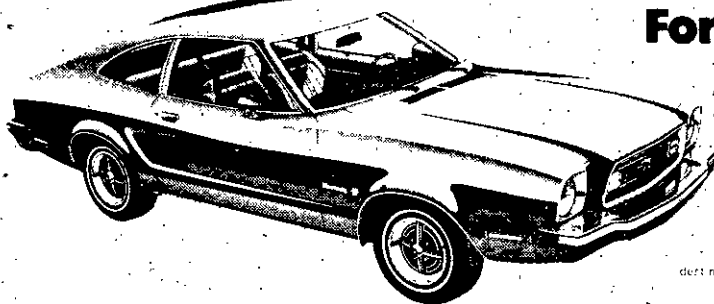

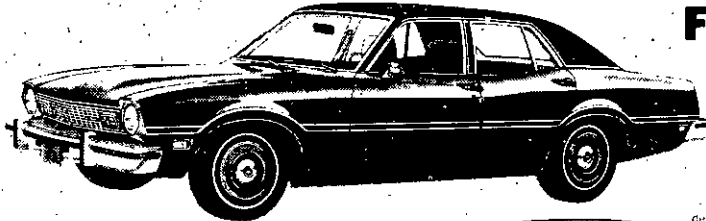

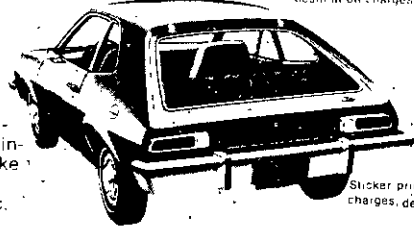
