This is submitted to express our repulsion to the 1974 BCHS Commencement.


Vote, July 10

All residents of the Bethlehem Central School District are reminded to VOTE next Wednesday, July 10, anytime between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m., at the Bethlehem Central Middle School gymnasium.

Residents will vote on six separate budget propositions, which can be added to the contingency budget only if approved by the voters. The contingency budget totals \$9,857,979, and if all six propositions receive voter approval, they will restore about \$270,000 to the contingency budget.

The proposition items, and amounts, are as follows: 1) Library and reference books, \$12,965; 2) Plant operation and maintenance, \$32,555; 3) Equipment, \$41,077; 4) Transportation at the same distance levels as during 1973-74, \$57,395;
