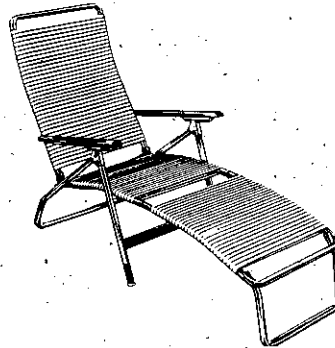
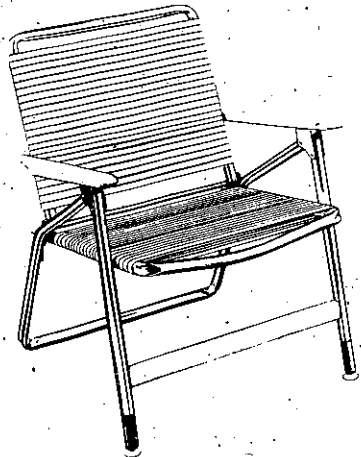

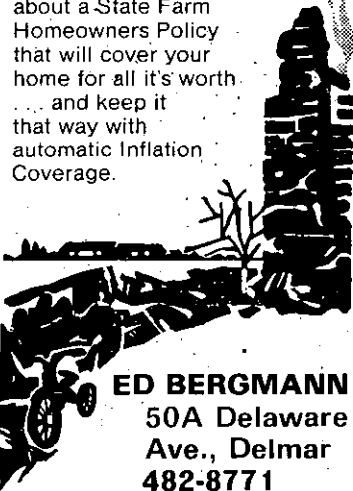

A frenetic attempt to cash in on the popularity of MASH and

Logic is tossed overboard in this desperate effort, and whatever is left is played for laughs. And the laughs, when they do come, are about as satisfying as getting your toes tickled with a feather — you do laugh, but you wish you were someplace else.

Uptown, Saturday Night

Sidney Poitier, star and director of **Uptown**, has produced an amusing but uneven movie. The high spots are delightful: Belafonte as a gang leader has the jowls and the rasping voice of Brando in the Godfather, Flip Wilson, as a minister, delivers a wild rambling sermon. Unfortunately, the dull spots are dull.

However, the stars, including Bill Cosby, are attractive enough to rise above any material — they make **Uptown Friday Night** fun.

Chinatown

Believe it or not: a nostalgic detective story. The time is 1932. Jack Nicholson who plays the private dick, starts off in his breeziest style, wades through graft, murder, adultery, incest, mutilation and winds up finally unsure and defeated. It isn't always clear who is up to what, but if you suspend judgment, you'll find it absorbing and even funny (!) Director Polansky is not the tidiest film maker around — there are loose ends all over the place — but he gets a lot of voltage out of his material. He has a bit part in this. Watch for him wielding a knife. WHEW.
