Harro Awarded Scholarship
 Bruce E. Harro, 10 Sylvan Ave., Delmar, has been awarded a Wheaton College Merit Scholarship, it was announced today by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation.

A graduate of Bethlehem Central High School, Mr. Harro plans to major in pre-medicine in college. His scholarship will provide between \$100 and \$1,500 per year (\$400 to \$6,000 over four college years).

Valedictorian for his class, Mr. Harro was also Sergeant of

Christian Service Brigade in high school.

Six Propositions Approved

Three of six budget propositions were approved by district voters, and three were defeated, in a special vote held by the Bethlehem Central School District last Wednesday.

The three items which received voter approval to be added to the contingency budget, and their amounts, are: Library and reference books, \$12,965; Plant Operation and Maintenance, \$32,555; and Transportation, \$57,395.

The three defeated propositions are: Equipment, \$41,077; Pupil Supplies, \$58,300; and Interscholastic Athletics, \$68,513.

A total of 2,592 district residents cast ballots. At the Annual Election on June 12, when the proposed budget was defeated, a total of 4,092 persons voted.

The vote breakdown for each proposition was as follows: Library books, 1,372 yes, 1,205 no; Plant Operation and Maintenance, 1,318 yes, 1,256 no; Equipment, 1,218 yes, 1,352 no; Transportation, 1,504 yes, 1,076 no; Pupil Supplies, 1,281 yes, 1,294 no; Interscholastic Athletics, 1,220 yes, 1,357 no.

Petitions are now being circulated in the community, so that another vote can be held for both the Interscholastic Athletics and Pupil Supplies items. The legal requirement for re-submission of propositions to the voters is that petitions containing the signatures of a number of district residents equalling one-third of the children in the district must be submitted to the Board of Education. The number of signatures required is more than 2,000.

School officials said late last week that, if petitions with the required number of signatures are received by today, Thursday, July 18, a re-vote will be scheduled for August 7.

ment would be affected by various demands. There are many areas of this issue which will directly, and indirectly affect the residents of the city of Albany.

It seems to me that the state should be able to devise a method of handling grievances and demands of large police departments, rather than making law enforcement appear as another addition to inflation.

Gypsies in Bethlehem

Interest in preserving the suburban environment in the Town of Bethlehem has been graphically demonstrated by the response of our request for information on gypsy moths. Last year this tree-defoliating moth was first noted in Bethlehem. This year, as a result of a request by the Town Environmental Council, over forty residents reported suspicious caterpillars. Upon investigation, most proved to be the common tent caterpillars but those of Gypsy moths were found in six locations in Bethlehem, though seldom were many present. Interestingly enough, many of the very small ones seemed not to develop, which may mean that diseases and parasites of this caterpillar may be doing a creditable job of control. Council members are checking the trouble spots periodically. No sign of widespread defoliation has yet developed. Unless it does, the moth is already so widespread in Bethlehem that spot spraying to prevent its spread would be of questionable value. Where it has been found, control by locating and destroying the egg masses, easily seen in the winter would certainly assist in keeping it under control.

The Environmental Council thanks everyone who participated in making this survey productive.
