## The Spotlight Goes to School

### Grossman on Dean's List

Glen J. Grossman, son of Mr. & Mrs. Irving Grossman, Wellington Rd., Delmar is visiting in California. Glen went to California for his brother's graduation and intends spend-

ing some time traveling in the State. In January he will return to Geneseo State College as a Junior. Prior to his departure he was advised that he had made the dean's list for his freshman year.

### Special Election

The Bethlehem Central Board of Education has scheduled a special election for another vote on two budget propositions for Wed., August 7.

District residents will be eligible to vote again on the interscholastic athletics proposition, totaling \$68,513, and the pupil instructional supplies proposition, totaling \$58,300.

These are two of the three budget propositions which were defeated at the polls on July 10. The interscholastic athletics proposition lost by a margin of 137 votes, and the pupil supplies proposition by 13 votes.

A total of 3,030 district residents signed petitions asking for a re-vote on the athletics proposition. According to State Education Law, a total of 2,145 signatures is necessary to impel another election on a budget item. (One-third of the number

of children in the school district.)

The Board, at a special meeting last Thursday, also decided to schedule another vote on the pupil supplies proposition. Petitions with 1,232 signatures in support of another vote on this item had been submitted. The Board's expressed rationale for taking this action, even though the number of petition signers fell short of the legal requirement, was twofold: 1) The narrow margin of the defeat of this proposition on July 10, and 2) The financial hardship that would be imposed on many parents if they are required to pay an average of \$13.20 per child for necessary instructional supplies.

The interscholastic athletics proposition, if passed, would add about \$1 to the tax rate in Bethlehem and about \$1.50 to

the tax rate in New Scotland. Addition of the pupil supplies amount to the contingency budget would add about 97 cents to the Bethlehem tax rate and about \$1.43 to the New Scotland tax rate.

#### Lemieux on Dean's List

The State University of New York at Cortland has announced that Susan Lemieux, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Dorian J. Lemieux of 127 Marlboro Road, Delmar, has been named to the Dean's List for outstanding academic achievement during the past semester.

She attended Bethlehem schools and graduated from Shenendehowa in 1972. She has been appointed an RA (residential aide) at Cortland for the coming year and will start training August 19th prior to the start of her Junior year.

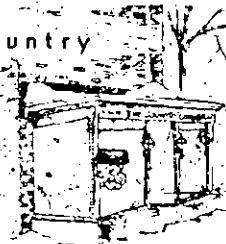

# LIBRARY NOTES

## Lunch with Judy Blume

I was so excited a few weeks ago, to receive an invitation to meet Judy Blume, one of the most popular of today's children's authors. I hoped that it would be an intimate luncheon for two, but knew in reality it would probably be about five

hundred of her admirers. I was pleasantly surprised to be one of about 14 people, among whom were her translator into Japanese, a reviewer of her books and her editor at Bradbury Press.

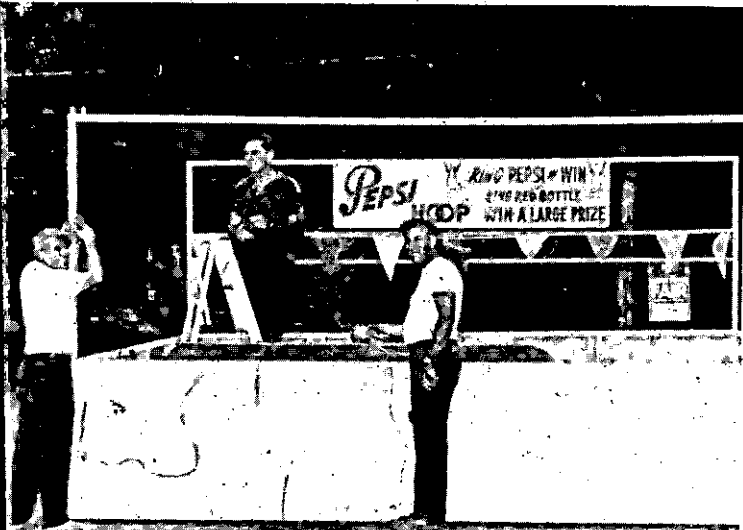
