



# POLICE, FIRE and EMERGENCY CALLS Two nabbed in CVS larceny

One was arrested at least seven times in six months in Colonie and Bethlehem

DELMAR - We normally do not report on petit larceny charges, but Shawnte Pringle, 49, of Albany keeps showing up in our reporting.

Bethlehem police responded to CVS on Delaware Avenue on Thursday, May 11 at approximately 4:15 a.m. for a report of two shoplifters inside the store.

According to reports, a male and a female were inside the store filling bags with merchandise then leaving the store. The pair were observed by employees entering a black SUV and leaving.

Upon arrival, officers observed the SUV pull on to Elsmere Avenue and performed a traffic stop.

While interviewing the driver, he said that

he picked up the two passengers and brought them to CVS to pick up medicine.

The two people in the back seats were later identified as a 29-year-old Albany man and Pringle.

The officer observed the bags with the stolen merchandise hanging out in the rear of the vehicle.

Pringle gave a false name and resisted arrest, but was taken into custody and charged with those and petit larceny.

She was arrested in October, with another man for stealing two generators from Tractor Supply in Glenmont with another man. The pair had tried to take items from that store three times in a week. Pringle gave a false name to police in October and Bethlehem Town Court issued a warrant for her arrest on that charge on December 2. She was arrested on that warrant in January to face the additional charge. She was

released under supervision of probation in that case.

Pringle was also arrested in Colonie on December 3, day after Bethlehem issued its warrant, at the Buy Buy Baby store on Central Avenue. She had an outstanding warrant from Colonie at that point and also gave police a false name, and had a quantity of drugs. Pringle was charged with false personation and criminal possession of a controlled substance. She was processed on the warrant and given an appearance ticket.

Colonie police arrested Pringle again after she was released from the Albany County jail for another arrest on Monday, March 13 on a warrant for not showing up for her court date.

She was given an appearance ticket and sent back to the jail until she was scheduled back in

## First historic landmark of 2023 to be unveiled on Elsmere Ave.

Site is home of Revolutionary War veteran and German settler

DELMAR — May 23 marks the unveiling of the first historic marker placement of 2023 in the Town of Bethlehem. It recognizes 116 Elsmere Avenue as the site of the farmhouse of Revolutionary War lieutenant and German settler John Leonard and his wife, Cornelia Richter.

"It is exciting and long overdue to have such recognition in this part of town," said Karen Beck, President of the Bethlehem Historical Association. "Hopefully, this marker will inspire others to take an

interest in Elsmere's rich history. We are indebted to Bill Ketzer. It is his passion and

determination that made this happen."

When Town Historian William Ketzer and Heather Cohen purchased the property, Ketzer was intrigued by the items that he found while gardening. What they found 'inspired him' to look into the property's history and the story it had to tell.

"We began to dig up artifacts," he said. "Such

as feet from a claw-foot club, horse shoes, architectural things like nails, coal, glass, brick, and ceramics."

The process of recognizing the historical location began in April 2021, when Beverwyck Archaeology,



LLC., conducted an archaeological survey on the property. Their findings uncovered and documented a rich history

Johannes Leanart (anglicized in America to 'John Leonard') was born in 1739. His exact arrival in North America as a German immigrant is uncertain. However, evidence suggests his presence in the area as early as 1767, with his marriage to Cornelia Richter.

Throughout the war, Leonard served alongside well-known Bethlehem names

such as 'Slingerland' and 'Becker'. By March 1780, he had been promoted to First Lieutenant. His service included playing a vital role in the Continental Army's pivotal victory at Saratoga. He played a role in warding

A survey map gave Beverwyck Archaeology "a strong sense of where the original house stood," noted Ketzer. Beverwyck Archaeology took measurements based on the survey and calculated the location of the home.

The original house on the property was razed just after World War II in preparation for the construction of the current home. There are no documented

photographs of the original house, but it is estimated that the home was large enough to accommodate Leonard and Richter's family of ten children.

The historic site is the first to be built on Elsmere Avenue. The road has historical significance because it was formerly a dirt carriage road to Leonard's farm from Feura Bush Road. Leonard was laid to rest in an unmarked grave on the grounds of Hamagrael Elementary School, which provides an indication of how large his farm was.

"I'm excited because it's been a couple years in the making," said Ketzer regarding the unveiling. "And it achieves my goals as a historian."

This landmark is part of a broader initiative to maintain the existing markers by repairing and refurbishing them, cataloging them, and replacing the markers that have disappeared.

"I look at this as a larger part of what the town is looking to do in regard to protecting and celebrating our significant historical resources," said Ketzer.






## Eagles fall in Sectionals

## **From page 1 ...** Memorial Day: A Day to Remember

Each year the VFW and American Legion switch the responsibility of nominating and voting for the Bethlehem Memorial Day Parade's grand marshal. The VFW and its members nominated and voted for Leslie Gene St. Lawrence to be the Grand Marshal for 2023.

The organizations named the same grand marshal for the last two years due to the COVID pandemic. So this is special for St. Lawrence.

St. Lawrence joined the Air Force in August 1952 and served in the Arctic for four years. While stationed in the Arctic, St. Lawrence worked in communications and encryption. After serving with the Air Force, St. Lawrence joined the Army and qualified for Special Forces and became a Green Beret. He will tell you he served for 22 years, nine months, and 18 days.

"He really is a dedicated guy, but you wouldn't know from talking to him," VFW member Larry Pitman said.

Although most of St. Lawrence's life was in the military, the one thing that remains a source of pride for him is being a New York boy through and through. Of his many achievements, one he never forgets to mention is that he is a graduate of Schenectady High School.

During his 22 years in the military, St. Lawrence received the Vietnam Cross of Gallantry with palm, Vietnam Special Forces Jump Wings, the Combat Medical Badge, a Purple Heart, a Bronze Star, a Silver Star, and many other awards for his service. He was stationed in Vietnam and endured the

Tet Offensive in January 1968. While in Vietnam, he recalls one of his Special Forces missions required disease collection to send back to Walter Reed

Hospital in Washington, D.C. He also served in Okinawa for a year and a half following World War II and the attack on Pearl Harbor.

"I was very proud to [serve]," St. Lawrence said. "I was glad to do it; it made me a better person."

Memorial Day is a busy day for both the VFW and the American Legion, but honoring the fallen soldiers of the past and present is important to both.

The Saturday before Memorial Day, May 27, the VFW visits four different cemeteries to lay flags at the graves of fallen soldiers. The American Legion also lays

flags at Bethlehem Cemetery and Mt. Pleasant Cemetery with the help of the local Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts troops. On the morning of Memorial Day, the VFW and American Legion have their own respective services for those who have fallen, starting at 9 a.m., including the American Legion's service for Francis Currey.

The parade starts at the American Legion and ends at Bethlehem Veteran's Memorial Park. The American Flag will be lowered and then raised at the end of a service led by Legion Commander Lyle Maddock.

This will be Maddock's last year as Legion Commander, who, after six years in his post, will have the longest tenure in the 92 years of Post 1040's existence. Due to this being Maddock's last year as Commander, it is a really special and emotional Memorial Day for him.



"Hopefully, I can keep it together, but I probably won't," Maddock said. "My father's banner is the last banner before leaving town. This year, it will be humbling to see his banner when we walk that way."

So far, the VFW has placed 104 banners on utility poles around town that honor local veterans. These banners will remain until Veteran's Day in November; however, the request for a banner is ongoing and will continue throughout the year. Following the

parade and the service

at Bethlehem Veteran's Memorial Park, the VFW, and American Legion invite the community to their respective posts for an Open House. The community can come to tour the buildings, see new renovations and speak with the veterans, including St. Lawrence, who will be at the VFW.

As we get closer to Memorial Day, Maddock and Pitman want the community to remember the true meaning behind Memorial Day, honoring those who have fallen in the line of service. The thankyou's are, of course, appreciated, but they shouldn't be going to those who have served or are serving on Monday.

"This is for the people who were killed in service," Pitman said. "Where Veteran's Day is for all those who served, and Armed Forces Day are for all those who are serving."

Maddock also asks that the community learn as much as they

can about fallen soldiers on Memorial Day. He recommends an app, WWI Memorial Virtual Explorer, that gives a virtual tour of the new WWI memorial in Washington, D.C. The app also gives users personal histories of fallen soldiers that are highlighted throughout the memorial.

Memorial Day is about honoring those who have fallen, but it is also a time to learn about their stories. That sentiment is among the most important come Monday to the members of the American Legion and VFW.



## Lesser known benefits of exercise

Most people know that routine exercise does a body good. While it may not require a degree from medical school to know that exercise can be a great way to lose weight and reduce risk for various illnesses, there's even more beneficial side effects of regular exercise that might surprise even the most ardent fitness enthusiasts.

• Exercise produces positive psychological benefits. WebMD notes that there are several psychological benefits of routine exercise. Those benefits occur because exercise triggers the release of endorphins, which are hormones that interact with receptors in the brain that reduce a person's perception of pain. • Exercise can benefit long-term cognitive health. Though the reasons remain unclear, there seems to be a link between regular physical activity and longterm cognitive health. A 2017 study published in the Journal of Alzheimer's Disease found that regular exercise can positively influence cognitive ability, reduce the rate of cognitive aging and lower the risk for certain dementias, including Alzheimer's disease.

Many people feel a significant sense of accomplishment by the end of a vigorous workout. Such feelings could grow even more profound when individuals recognize the many lesser known benefits of breaking a sweat.

"It's called 'Wake Up Wednesdays' but you'll also be able to wake up the next day because you don't have to stay out too late." The lineup of regional favorites kicked off with Irish folk/rock band Hair of the Dog and concludes with a "supergroup" of Troy rockers assembled from long-time favorite bands. Other shows feature '80s music, "Yacht Rock" and Country styles.

Back Where It All Began: Original Rockin' on the River Site

Troy's summer concert series, "Rockin' on the River," first kicked off behind Ryan's Wake in June 2008 with a Blues Night featuring Albert Cummings. The concert series was an initiative of Ryan's Wake, Brown's Brewing Co., DeCrescente Distributing Co., and the Troy Downtown Collaborative, an organization of retailers and developers that would evolve into the Downtown Troy Business Improvement District (BID).

During its first five years, Rockin' on the River attracted a growing audience to Ryan's Wake riverfront location until some of the shows had outgrown the spot. In August 2013, the Downtown Troy BID moved the series to Troy's Riverfront Park, where it continued until the pandemic. In the last three years, the concert series has moved to different locations.

"Ryan's Wake is where Rockin' on the River started and people kept asking, 'When are you gonna bring it back here?'," Kingsley said. "There's something special about this spot and how it feels to catch live music here."

Kingsley said "Wake Up Wednesdays" is scaled to bring the right-sized crowd for the space.

Chris Ryan, proprietor of Ryan's Wake Public House, credits Kingsley's talent for picking music acts for much of the success of the original Rockin' on the River concert series.

"We have finally reached the point in our careers where we have nostalgia for our beginnings," Ryan said. "Part of that nostalgia is to redo this event in its original location. We're putting the band(s) back together!"





## Dazzle overnight guests at the breakfast table



elcoming guests for overnight stays is a great way to make loved ones feel welcome. Overnight guests also get time to reconnect with their hosts, making such situations a winwin for all involved.

When hosting overnight guests, hosts can start their mornings off on the right foot by whipping up a special breakfast. Relaxing at the breakfast table over a homecooked meal can be a welcome departure from the sometimes hectic nature of

weekday mornings, when families have to hurry off to school and work. The following recipe for "Poached Eggs, Asparagus and Chorizo" from Betty Rosbottom's "Sunday Brunch" (Chronicle Books) is a simple yet impressive morning entrée that's sure to please hosts and their overnight guests.

## Poached Eggs, Asparagus and Chorizo Serves 4

tablespoons olive oil

- cup coarse fresh bread crumbs (see cooking tip) ounces Spanish chorizo, cut into 1/2-inch cubes (use the Spanish-style chorizo in casing, not loose Mexican-style chorizo) pound medium asparagus
  - Kosher salt
  - tablespoon unsalted butter, diced
  - teaspoons fresh lemon juice
  - to 3 tablespoons white or cider vinegar eggs
  - Freshly ground black pepper

1. Heat 1 tablespoon of the olive oil until hot in a medium, heavy frying pan set over medium heat. Add the bread crumbs and cook, tossing constantly, until golden and crisp, 3 to 4 minutes. Remove the crumbs to a plate. (Crumbs can be prepared 1 hour ahead; cover and leave at room temperature.)

2. Heat the remaining 12 tablespoon oil in the same frying pan set over medium heat. When hot, add the chorizo and stir until lightly browned, 3 minutes. Remove and set aside. (Chorizo can be prepared 1 hour ahead; leave at room temperature.)

3. Trim and discard 2 to 3 inches of the tough bases of the asparagus spears. Add the asparagus and 1 teaspoon salt to a large frying pan filled halfway with simmering water. Cook until the spears are just tender, 4 minutes. Drain and toss the asparagus in a large bowl with the butter and lemon juice. Season with salt and cover with foil. 4. Bring a large frying pan filled halfway with water to a boil. Add the vinegar and gently break each egg into a saucer and slide it into the water. Swirl the water with a wooden spoon while the eggs are cooking. Cook until the eggs are just set but the yolks are still soft, 3 minutes. Remove with a slotted spoon and drain well. (If you have an egg poacher, cook according to the manufacturer's directions until the eggs are set.)

5. Mound some asparagus spears on each of four dinner plates. Top each serving with a poached egg and sprinkle with the chorizo and bread crumbs. Season the eggs with several grinds of pepper and a pinch of salt and serve.

Cooking tip: To make bread crumbs, use a 1- to 2-day-old, good-quality peasant or country bread with crusts removed. Process large chunks of it in a food processor to make coarse crumbs. Sourdough bread works particularly well.
