Bethlehem feels the heat

Town aquatic complex opens on schedule but faces a summer with fewer lifeguards

DELMAR - Swimming against the tide of a nationwide lifeguard shortage, the Town of Bethlehem said it has hired a sufficient force of lifeguards to open the Elm Avenue Park pool complex on June 9 for the 2023 season that runs through Aug. 27 and to keep the pool complex operating throughout.

However, Bethlehem Town Parks and Recreation Administrator Jason Gallo said that although he is proud of having sufficient

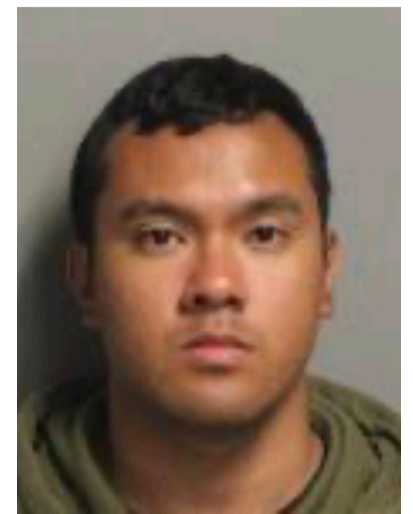

Newburgh officer arrested for rape

Accused of abusing a 12 year old in Bethlehem

BETHLEHEM - A former SUNY Albany and current City of Newburgh police officer was arrested on Friday, June 9 and charged with raping and sexually assaulting a minor less than 13 in the Town of Bethlehem.

On June 1, State Police received information that an adult man had sexual contact with a child. The investigation determined that John Kyle B. Dizon, 23, of Cornwall, reportedly had sexual contact with a child less than thirteen years old in April 2022 while in the town.

At that time, Dizon was employed as a Law Enforcement Officer for the State of New York University Police at SUNY Albany, and is no longer employed by the agency. At the time of arrest, he was actively employed as a law

enforcement officer by the City of Newburgh Police Department in Orange County.

Dizon was arrested at State Police Middletown, Troop F and transported to Latham for processing. He was charged with predatory sexual assault against a child, criminal sexual act in the first degree, rape in the first degree and sexual abuse in the first degree, all felonies.

He was arraigned on June 10 at the Westerlo Town Court, because there wasn't a Bethlehem Town Judge available, where

he was remanded to the Albany County jail without bail.

The City of Newburgh Police Department has been advised and has been entirely cooperative with the investigation.

BCHS will keep phones in lockdown

Starting next year, students will be required to secure devices in a sealed Yondr pouch

DELMAR – BCCHS has proposed locking away cell phones for the school day to curb phone use and encourage student social interaction.

Starting the 2023-2024 school year, BCCHS will partner with Yondr to implement this measure. Yondr, established in 2014, has created pouches that magnetically lock and unlock to hold phones and other personal items. These pouches have been implemented in other schools and at comedy and music events. “For the last three years, district administrators and building leaders have been working to find the most effective way to reduce student cell phone use at the high school,” according to the district website. “In 2021-22, the high school introduced classroom sleeves for students to store their cell phones. In spring 2022, the district began to look at Yondr as a better solution to meet

the needs of students.”

The use of Yondr for the upcoming school year will cost the district an annual fee of \$26,773. According to the district website, the costs include 1,400 pouches, one for every high school student, accessories including unlocking bases, replacement pouches, any product upgrades, a year of customer service, and other costs associated with implementation. Yondr staff will be at the high school the first week of September to assist with the start of use.

At the start of the school day, students will be required to lock their phones in their assigned Yondr pouches. The pouches will remain in the student’s possession at all times. The end of the school day for BCCHS students is 2:07 p.m. At that time, all students are allowed to unlock their phones from the pouches using the unlocking bases stationed around the school.

If a student stays after school for any sport, club, or extracurricular activity, their phones will still be able to be unlocked at 2:07 p.m. In the same way, if a student has an approved early dismissal, they are allowed to unlock their phones

prior to the end of the school day. However, if the student returns back to campus, they must relock their phones into their pouches.

There are no plans to integrate Yondr usage through elementary and middle school levels. This is due to the K-8 policy that all cell phones or personal devices be kept at home, in a locker or bookbag at all times.

Administrators said the main motivation for the use of the pouches is to cut down on distractions, limit online bullying, and increase social interaction among students during down times. The access to social media allows for anonymous and large amounts of bullying. Students also fall back on social media in their down times rather than interacting with their peers. By locking the phones away this upcoming school year, the district hopes to increase the peer interaction and decrease the bullying for BCCHS students.

If parents have more questions, the district will update the Yondr FAQ as the implementation begins at the start of the 2023-24 school year on the district website. Parents can also email districtoffice@bethelehmschools.org.

Lifeguard pool dwindles

lifeguards for opening day, the town faces a shortage compared to prior years.

Last summer, 40,000 people visited the pool complex over the season, and the complex is down four lifeguards from 2022 and six lifeguards from 2021. To date, 27 lifeguards have been hired, and Gallo is still looking to hire at least 10 more.

With the current 27 lifeguards, the pool complex's lifeguard chairs can be fully staffed, but it leaves less flexibility for schedule changes.

The general public swim hours are currently scheduled for noon-8 p.m. daily through Aug. 5, but it changes after that until closing day to noon-7 p.m.

With a smaller pool of guards, the flexibility must come from closing sections of the pool during times of limited staffing. A written protocol exists for determining the order in which areas are shut down due to shortages.

According to the American Lifeguard Association, last year 33 percent of America's public pools remained shuttered or opened only sporadically due to the lifeguard shortage, and the trend is continuing into 2023.

"We never considered that the pool wouldn't be open, but we do consider ourselves fortunate, and we believe it also speaks to the quality of training and experience our lifeguards are having here," Gallo said.

He reported that 13 of the 31 lifeguards returned from last summer.

The past several years, Gallo said he has seen a decreasing number of lifeguard applications. He cited several factors, including the pandemic, the process and increasing cost of becoming a lifeguard, the increased minimum wage that provides higher pay for non-lifeguard positions, and the demands on people's time for activities other than lifeguarding.

"There used to be a great appeal to being a lifeguard," Gallo said, "but with the minimum wage climbing for other jobs and the cost of obtaining a certification, it has made people think twice whether it is worth it to become a lifeguard."

He also thinks that potential social media exposure that did not exist in years past may have also led to quashing enthusiasm for becoming a lifeguard.

Now, explained Gallo, if a patron is upset with a lifeguard, it could be filmed and put on social media or, for example, a parent blogs about some experience at the pool and maybe it is out of context, but it nonetheless becomes a discussion point.

"The lifeguards are kids, but these things are in perpetuity on people's phones," he said.



the town has increased the lifeguard hourly pay to \$15, which exceeds the state's minimum hourly rate of \$14.20 for upstate New York.

minimum wage rate, but market factors require at least meeting that rate to remain competitive at all. In order to keep attracting lifeguard applicants in the future, the town will consider bigger bumps in the hourly wage, sign on or retention bonuses and reimbursement of certification costs if the individual commits to working at the pool for a

To counteract these factors and make lifeguard work appealing, Gallo said

He noted that as a municipality, the lifeguards are exempt from the state's

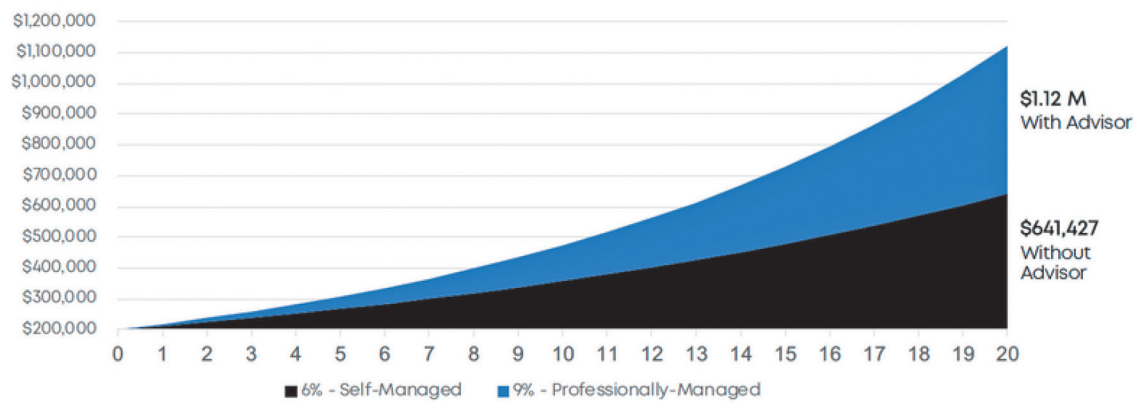

certification costs if the individual commits to working at the pool for a specified period of time or number of hours.

Gallo stated that the town has not increased the pool complex's user fees in four years, and, with that in mind, has to closely balance pool access to residents with the costs associated with providing that service. He noted that luckily the cost attributable to the lifeguards is only a small part of the overall cost of operating the pool complex.

About five years ago, Bethlehem proactively began offering a lifeguard certification course during the winter as a way to increase the pipeline for hiring its own lifeguards. This year, the town reduced the cost of the course to \$250, which pays for pool time, course materials, and the instructor. It takes about 29 hours to obtain a lifeguard certification.

The course attracted five students this year for a class that can accept up to 10, which Gallo considered to be a great success.

However, only one of those individuals applied for a lifeguard position this summer.

It takes over 6,700 lifeguard hours to fully staff the Elm Avenue Park pool complex from June-August. Lifeguards occupy the seven lifeguard chairs that surround the complex's three pools – four at the Olympic size pool, two at the intermediate pool and one at the diving pool.

Three additional lifeguards must be on duty while the diving pool is open in case there is a need to assist with a rescue.

Due to a lifeguard's need to be focused and on high alert at all times, no lifeguard sits for more than one hour at a time and with a rotation into a different chair after 30 minutes.

"Our goal is to keep them fresh," Gallo said.

The town begins its lifeguard recruitment in February each year by advertising on the town's social media and website and by word of mouth.

This year's recruitment season brought about 40 certified applicants, of whom 27 have been hired. Except for one retiree, they are all high school and college students. Gallo said he would welcome

recruiting more post graduates for lifeguard positions, and is open to identifying a strategy for doing so.

"Essentially, if you have the certification, we will hire you," he said bluntly.

He added that all applicants over the age of 18 must pass a background check, and applicants under the age of 18 must provide references. Once hired, all lifeguards will receive pay for about 20 hours of additional training. The specific training involves learning town policies and procedures, pool rules and regulations, back boarding, and in-water scenario training before being permitted to sit in a chair.

Nicholas Atteck, 18 and a graduating senior at Bethlehem Central High School, said that as a lifeguard and not just a pool visitor, "I did not realize how much went into making sure everyone stays safe and follows the rules."

Gallo credited the town's ability to attract as many lifeguards as it has amid the continuing shortage to paying more than the minimum wage and other benefits of working at the complex that are not offered by other local municipal or privately operated pools.

"Our lifeguards are responsible for pool, water supervision and safety and no cleaning or chemical checks," Gallo said.

Sofia Genovese, 16 and a Bethlehem student said, "I like making sure other people are safe in the water." After growing up coming to the pool, she noted that it is interesting to be in the lifeguard chair. "Now I notice the lifeguards, I didn't when I was younger."

When lifeguards are not in a chair, they are given community facing tasks, like providing first aid for minor cuts or bee stings, walking the perimeter or checking on the splash islands in the play area. Sometimes, they get a few extra perks like an occasional Gatorade, ice pop or bottled water.

"We work on retention from the day they are hired," Gallo said. "We want them to understand how important their job is. They are providing a service for the community that on a day in and day out basis makes the community feel comfortable leaving their children at the pool and under their supervision, and that's something to take pride in."

“From my perspective as a percussionist, my connection to dance has always stemmed from the fact that it is simply a symbiotic relationship,” said Brian Melick, percussionist and educator. He described the “continual flow of energy” that will move through the program.

The music will be an essential aspect of the program. Melick will accompany Gifford with



live music for one of the days in the week. Gifford called it a luxury to have live music in the classroom.

“I will also have the participants learn and play as many different rhythms as time will allow so that we can get them to integrate playing the instruments while they dance with them,” said Melick. “Because Robin wants to have her students experience what it is like to be in the moment in a live musical environment, I feel incredibly blessed to become a tool in the process for Robin to teach her students with.”

“We’re giving students

certain tools in their toolbox that they can take to pretty much any dance class and be able to progress in the style that they want,” said Gifford.

Building on the theme of teaching the foundations of music and dance, Gifford had the idea to build this year’s program for adults on the foundations of strength, balance and flexibility.

“Rhythm and dance exist all over the world,” said Melick. “Wherever there is a pulse and drumming, there is dance. The idea of a pulse and the hypnotic cadence of that pulse is the



foundation of everything.”

Melick praised the beautiful way that dance and music connect people. Last year’s pilot program had a positive response.

“Our adult program was very popular,” noted Gifford. “We hope that it will be a continuous program.”

Gifford said she was inspired to organize the

Summer Dance Adventure program because “there were not a lot of options for students and parents in the area to find dance education, especially in the area surrounding Rensselaerville.”

The program has expanded this year with funding from the Dance Alliance and Stewart’s and includes a collaboration

with the Saratoga Performing Arts Center (SPAC).

“One of the exciting aspects of this program is that SPAC is donating lawn tickets to the participants for the New York City Ballet this summer,” said Gifford. “It’s key because when you see other dancers, professional dancers, it gives you all kinds of ideas, and it’s a great experience for the young ones.”

The event will be held at Conkling Hall, an accessible, community-oriented venue. For information on how to register for the Summer Dance Adventure, visit www.conklinghall.org/sda.

Architecture Residency Program Director Julia van den Hout.

"I like being able to showcase architecture through a variety of means and scales," she said. "What I look for with works is that they really represent architecture from as many different points of view as possible."

On Saturday, June 24, Art Omi will celebrate the opening of two new architectural installations in the Sculpture & Architecture Park. "Groundwork," designed by AD—WO, and "Bivouac for Models" by Jon Lott of Para Project were both selectively placed within the park.

According to Founding Partner of AD—WO Jen Wood, "Groundwork" was always meant to be on a slope of some kind.

"We wanted it to feel like it was sort of embedded in the ground and perhaps unstable and kind of slipping," she said. "We noticed this dark patch of flowers on the hill in the

distance, and we thought it'd be interesting to engage with that existing kind of blip in the landscape."

Founding principal of Para Project Jon Lott chose to install "Bivouac for Models" on a wooded path that connects the two main architectural fields of the park. Previously, no other work had occupied this location.

"I think it is a good marker of kind of activating this path and encouraging people to stop and look around," van den Hout said.

Van den Hout personally reached out to both AD—WO and Lott when considering what new works she wanted Art Omi to commission for the year. Typically, the park installs two to three architectural pieces every summer and exchanges old works for new ones every couple of years.

"It's hard to let go of these pieces — they become such a part of the park," van den Hout said. "But we do really always like to be able to bring in new pieces."

The construction of "Groundwork" was completed on-site in mid-May, according to Wood. The work is composed of local stone — the same stone used by the Stockbridge-Munsee Community Band of Mohicans — and a patch of alfalfa, which forms a shadow.

"We've intentionally left the space between each stone open, so things will be growing, and all of that becomes a part of the piece," AD—WO Founding Partner Emanuel Admassu explained. Both he and Wood are interested in seeing how the work will

change with the seasons.

"We're thinking of the project as very much still being in construction," Wood said. "We've designed it, the stonemason has laid it, but it's still kind of being handed over to the ground now to continue the process."

Both Wood and Admassu also discussed the project's engagement with the history of the site it resides on.

"We're interested in playing with the limits of legibility, and how certain aspects of this project will be illegible for a lot of the audience, and certain aspects of it will be super legible for some people who really know the history of the indigenous community here," Admassu said.

"There's this nuanced translation that happens between indigenous relations to land, which is

really about stewardship and caring for the land and sharing the land, versus the superimposition of the settler-Colonial attitude, which is saying this land needs to be productive,"

he explained. AD—WO is trying to understand that nuance between these two approaches in their use of local stone.

Lott and Para Project arrived on site in June and completed construction of "Bivouac for Models" within the span of about one week. Lott described the work as a scalar study, originating out of what he sees as a central difference between sculpture and architecture.

"One of the things that separates those two is a scalar aspect," he said. "In general, I like to think architecture is a scalar practice."

"Bivouac for Models" is actually a half-size version of another work that Lott and Para Project are currently building at a separate location in Amenia, N.Y., meaning

that it is essentially a model of another work.

Lott said that he intends for the full-size work to be an artist's archive. The half-size version located at Art Omi will instead contain smaller models of itself.

"In that sense they're kind of similar — they house objects," he said.

In addition to installing new architectural works this summer, van den Hout added that Art Omi will welcome new sculptures to the park, as well as an exhibition by Pippa Garner that will be featured in the Newmark gallery, which is located in the park's visitors center. More architects, artists, musicians, and dancers also continue to arrive as Art Omi holds its annual residencies over the next couple of months.

"One of the things that has been really important to us is to bring in works that are more experimental, and that also allow Art Omi to be a space for architects and artists to try new things," van den Hout said. "We want to make it a little bit more of a laboratory here."

Apple turnovers at summer gatherings

Celebrations are common in July. American Independence Day is celebrated each July 4th, and that momentous occasion lays the foundation for a month-long celebration of Americana.

Since the United States first gained its independence from Great Britain, many things have been described as representing the best of American culture. Rock-n-roll music and baseball have long been deemed “as American as apple pie,” but how did apple pie come to be synonymous with America?

Few fruits have been associated more with America than the apple, due in large part to John Chapman, affectionately known as Johnny Appleseed. Chapman was born in Massachusetts during the Revolutionary War. Chapman’s father fought in the war, then survived to return home to farm and teach his son the family business.

The younger Chapman is said to have spent 40 years clearing land and planting apple seeds in Midwestern states. Apples thrived and became important foods for early settlers.

Apples were easy to grow and store for use throughout the year, plus they were—and still are—versatile fruits that can be used in many different recipes.

Apple pie is a popular dish made from apples, but a close cousin to pie—turnovers—can be just as delicious. Turnovers are handheld desserts made with many of the same ingredients as pie. They are small pastries made by covering one half of a piece of dough

with filling, folding the other half over ontop, and then sealing the edges. Apple turnovers can be a sweet treat for July 4th barbecues or other events this summer. Enjoy this recipe, courtesy of PillsburyTM.



Easy Apple Turnovers

Serves 4

- 1 1/2 cups thinly sliced, peeled apples (roughly 1 1/2 medium-sized apple)
- 1/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons water
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour
- 1 tablespoon granulated sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 tablespoon butter or margarine
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 box Pillsbury™ refrigerated pie crusts
- 1 egg

1. In a 2-quart saucepan, mix apples, brown sugar, 1 tablespoon of the water and lemon juice. Cook over medium heat, stirring occasionally, until bubbly. Reduce heat to low; cover and cook 6 to 8 minutes, stirring occasionally, until apples are tender.

2. In a small bowl, mix flour, granulated sugar and salt. Gradually stir into apple

mixture, cooking and stirring until mixture thickens. Remove from heat; stir in butter and vanilla. Cool 15 minutes.

3. Meanwhile, heat oven to 350 F. Let pie crust pouch stand at room temperature for 15 minutes.

4. Remove pie crust from pouch; unroll crust on ungreased cookie sheet. Spoon cooled fruit mixture evenly onto half of crust to within 1/2 inch of edge.

5. In a small bowl, beat egg and 1 tablespoon water; brush over edge of crust. Fold untopped half of crust over apple mixture; firmly press edge to seal. Flute edge; cut small slits in several places in top crust. Brush top with remaining egg mixture.

6. Bake 25 to 35 minutes or until crust is golden brown. Serve warm or cool. Drizzle with icing, if desired.

Expert tips: Tart apples, such as Granny Smith or McIntosh, make flavorful pies. Braeburn or Gala apples provide good texture and a slightly sweeter flavor.
