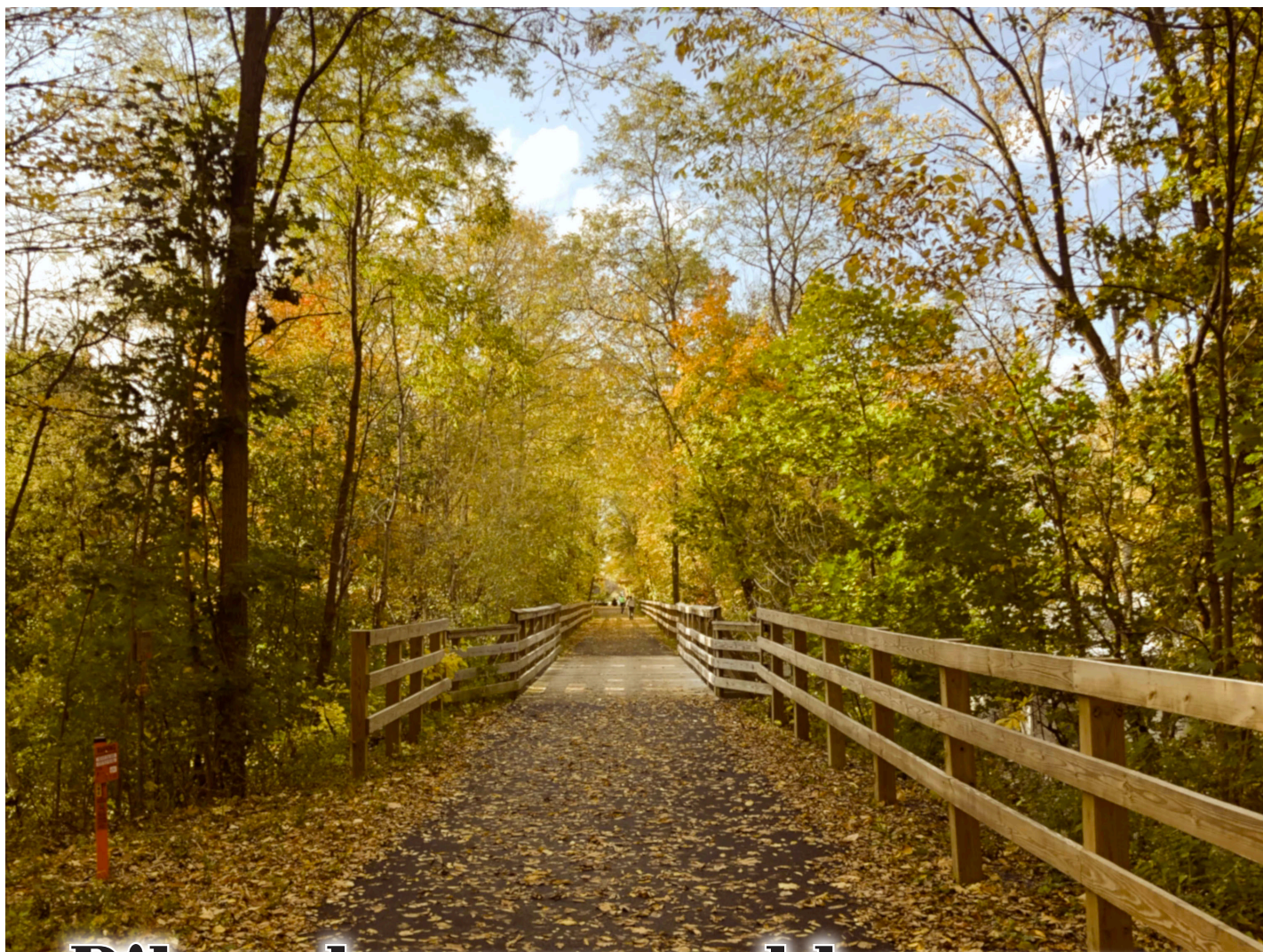

# Guilderland builder charged

**GUILDERLAND**  
- On June 13, State Police arrested Aaron R. Godlewski, 31, of Altamont, for grand larceny, three counts of scheme to defraud in the first degree- issuing a bad check and scheme to defraud in the second degree, all felonies, and two counts of theft of services and petit larceny, all misdemeanors.

On May 1, Troopers received a complaint from a contractor reporting they were issued a bad check by an Albany County Builder.

The investigation determined Godlewski was acting as a home builder and general contractor under the company name of Godlewski Builders LLC. In the course of the investigation, additional victims were discovered.

Godlewski allegedly was hired by multiple individuals and paid for contracted work. He allegedly hired numerous subcontractors who

completed parts of the project but then failed to reimburse them and in one incident, issued a payment from an account known to have insufficient funds. These crimes occurred in New Scotland, Altamont, and Bethlehem from 2021 through 2023 and resulted in the theft of services more than \$1,000.

Godlewski surrendered himself to SP New Scotland where he was arrested and processed. He was issued appearance tickets returnable to the multiple courts on later dates.

## Drug charges in New Scotland

**NEW SCOTLAND**  
- On June 16 at approximately 8:23 pm, an Albany County Sheriff's Deputy witnessed an alleged narcotics transaction at a business in New Scotland involving a white colored vehicle.

Deputies executed a

traffic stop on the vehicle and the driver, Tatiana Valderrama, was identified and determined to be operating the vehicle with a suspended license. While interviewing the defendant, Valderrama was found to have in her possession clear plastic baggies containing approximately 1.18 grams of cocaine.

Valderrama was arrested and charged with criminal possession of a controlled substance in the third degree and criminal possession of a controlled substance in the fifth degree, both felonies, and aggravated unlicensed operation, a misdemeanor, and traffic violations.

Valderrama was held at the Albany County Correctional Facility pending arraignment in New Scotland Town Court.

# Officers establish a positive presence

Local police departments deploy resources early to keep children safe

CAPITAL DISTRICT - Police officers in both Colonie and Bethlehem say they have one major goal in mind while seeking to protect children of all ages: To keep them safe in their schools, homes and communities by teaching them how to protect themselves from danger.

School Resource Officers (called SRO's) from both the Colonie and Bethlehem police departments work in nearly all schools in these areas. The goal is to establish fruitful relationships not only with students, but with faculty and staff as well. They are trained to handle all kinds of problems, including emergency situations such as school shootings. Recognizing that establishing trust is a prerequisite to imparting safety knowledge to children, they take every step possible to ensure that students' contacts with police are both positive and frequent.

"We start working with kids early," said Sgt. Anthony Sidoti, training sergeant for the SRO's in Colonie.

Police do the same in Bethlehem, where nursery school students have the opportunity to tour the police station,

as well as learn about the equipment carried in police cars. SRO's often visit kindergartens, chatting with the children, answering their questions, or reading stories to them. By fifth grade, they initiate discussions about the dangers of drugs, which continue in the upper grades. When police in both towns see children wearing bike helmets, they are likely to give them a coupon for free ice cream, courtesy of Stewart's Shops, which nearly always produces giant smiles and enthusiastic thank yous. They say these are just a few of the steps that engender good will among youngsters.

"We currently have two SROs who provide service to our schools in three main areas: education, counseling, and law enforcement," said Bethlehem Central School District's Superintendent Jody Monroe. "They are here to teach our students about crime prevention and safety, including online safety, to talk with students about issues they may be facing, to assist with investigating criminal activity, when needed, and to help protect the school community."

Topics discussed with students include drug use, criminal mischief, underage drinking, peer pressure, and nearly any other issue that students want to explore. Lt. Dan Belles, of the Colonie Police Department, as well as Bethlehem SRO Det. Caitlyn Krage, repeatedly tell

children that they should always feel free to contact the police at school or at police headquarters if they experience violence at home or school or have other difficulties they believe the police could help them to deal with.

"We have really good rapport with the kids, the teachers and the staff," Krage said. "I feel very comfortable and welcomed in the school."

SROs serve other important functions. They provide security at many school affairs, including proms, concerts, sports games, concerts and graduations.

"We will respond immediately if any troubling issue comes up at these events," said Belles.

In addition, in order to keep students safe en route to school in the morning, Bethlehem police organized what they call a "bike train," which also includes other means of transport, including scooters, rollerblades and skateboards. Parents who want their children to participate have their children ride to various central locations not far from the schools they attend.

They are met there by police officers who then escort the "train" of students to their elementary and middle schools. In the process, officers teach children important rules of the road, including riding with, not against, the flow of traffic,

obeying traffic signs, indicating which direction they are going at intersections by using proper hand signals, keeping both hands on the wheel, never texting while biking, and always carefully looking both ways before crossing a street.

Internet safety is a vital component of both districts' prevention efforts to keep students from dangerous situations. Sidoti said that sexual predators tend to prey on lonely or troubled teens, many of whom have low self esteem, possibly a troubled home life, and few friends. These criminals are experts at winning the child's trust, finding out their interests, and becoming a confidant.

"The Internet has taken the place of the playground in the modern era," Sidoti said, stressing the importance of parental monitoring of children's internet usage. Stranger danger is a related topic.

"Children need to know never to interact more than very briefly with or give personal information to a person unless they know them," said Sgt. Michael Whiteley, in the police juvenile department in Bethlehem.

Another ironclad rule frequently mentioned: Never get into a stranger's car no matter what the driver says or does to entice them. Candy or toys are common lures for young children.

### Sen. Howard Charles Nolan Jr.

FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. - Sen. Howard Charles Nolan Jr., 90, was born into eternal life on Saturday, June 17, 2023, with his loving wife, Shannon, by his side. Born in Albany, he was the son of the late Howard C. Nolan Sr. and Helen (Burke) Nolan. Howard was married to his loving wife Shannon for 35 years.

He was the loving father of Anne Davies, Kathy Nolan, Debbie Murray (Jim), Robert Nolan (Suzanne), Donna Nolan, Lynn Hyde and Karen Cummings (Rob); cherished grandfather of Anthony Battaglia, Kara Battaglia and Nicole Battaglia, Joseph Nolan (Xanthi), Kevin Nolan and Kelly Nolan, Paige Hyde and Ashley Hyde, and Nolan Cummings and Lauryn Cummings; great-grandfather of Anna Nolan; brother of Marybeth Collins (Michael); son-in-law of Ruth McAuley Logan; and brother-in-law of Shasta Logan Brander (Tom), Mary Logan, and Marcia Logan Goodgame (Dan). Many nieces and nephews also survive him.

Howard was predeceased by his beloved granddaughter, Christine Davies; and former wife, Geraldine Nolan. As a lifelong resident of Albany, Howard co-founded the law firm Nolan & Heller, LLP more than 50 years ago.

He was elected to the State Senate in 1974 and served the 42nd District in Albany County for 20 years. He had served on various boards, including as president of the New York Thoroughbred Breeders, Inc., on the Board of Trustees for St. Peter's Hospital, and on the Board of Directors for the State of New York Mortgage Agency, the Community Foundation for the Capital Region and WMHT.

He had also served as chairman of the Cerebral Palsy Center for the Disabled Foundation Board, the Knights of Columbus, The Ancient Order of the Hibernians, the Albany Chamber of Commerce, and Breeders' Cup Ltd. Howard graduated from Christian Brothers Academy in 1950, The College of the Holy Cross in 1954 and Albany Law School of Union University in 1957. Howard was a proud member of the U.S. Marine Corps and could often be heard telling stories of his time in Camp Lejeune and Quantico, Va. He was an avid sports fan having had season tickets to the New England Patriots and the New York Jets for years. As a Notre Dame fanatic, he enthusiastically watched all of their football games.

In addition, playing tennis and golf at Schuyler Meadows C.C. and Wolferts Roost C.C. in Albany and Coral Ridge C.C. in Fort Lauderdale gave him great pleasure, as they fueled his competitive nature and his love to socialize with his friends and family.

Thoroughbred horse racing and breeding was another one of his passions as he participated under the name, Blue Sky Farm, through several farms that he operated over the course of his lifetime. He especially loved Saratoga Race

Course where he could be found sitting in his box every day during the meet. His recollection of pedigrees was nothing short of amazing as he could rattle off the stats of champions from fifty years ago. Howard's inspiration, along with the cooperation of the N.Y.S. Department of Corrections prompted the creation of the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation in Wallkill, N.Y. which provides opportunities for incarcerated men and women to help care for retired racehorses giving both a chance to change the course of their lives.

The Nolans were always on the go, traveling to France, Italy and Argentina quite often to collect art, sip wine, and visit museums and flea markets. He was an avid reader who consistently would read seven newspapers a day as well as countless historical novels. It was common knowledge that he considered New York City as the greatest city in the world even though some of his French friends would respectfully disagree, loyal of course, to their beloved Paris. A foodie, he would faithfully read the New York Times on Fridays looking for new restaurants which had only been open a month and took great delight in discovering unknown gems. He was an eternal optimist who always had a smile on his face and a kind word to say.

He loved attending his grandchildren's sporting events and having his family visit him in Florida where he always had a fun event planned like deep sea fishing or taking a water taxi on the Intracoastal Waterway. He loved entertaining his grandkids by taking them on trips to the zoo, aquarium and amusement parks or just playing with them in the pool. He was the best father and grandfather, and we are truly blessed to have him for as long as we did.

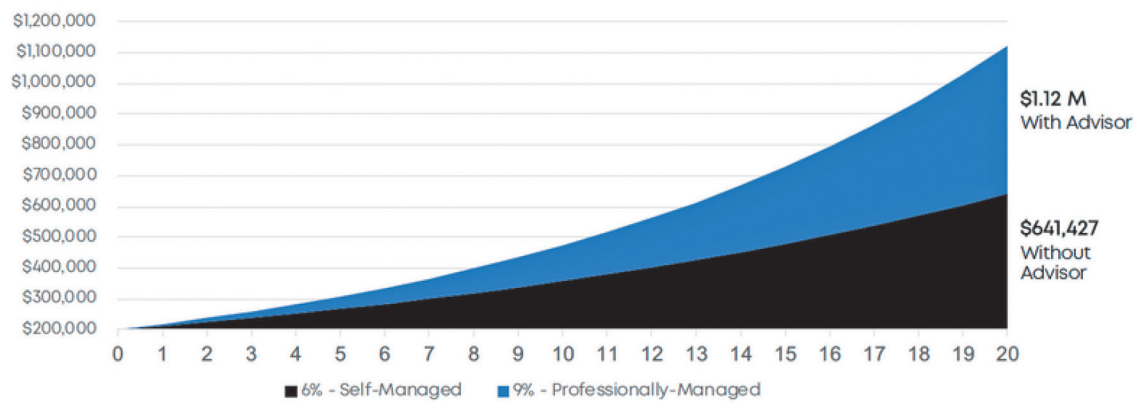

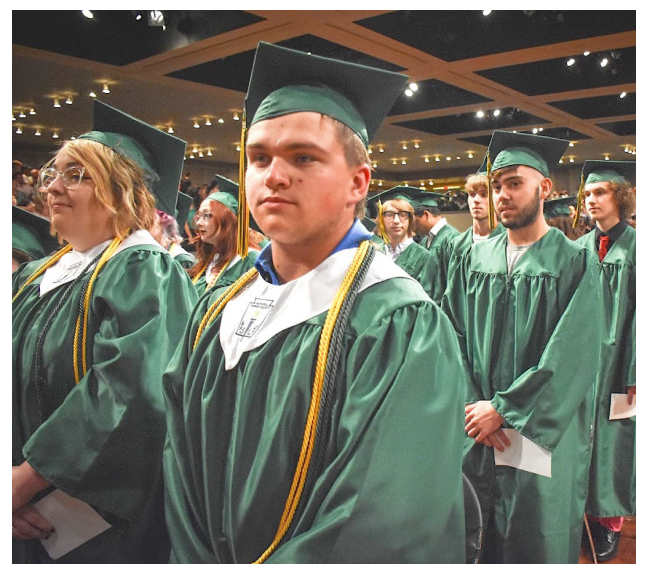
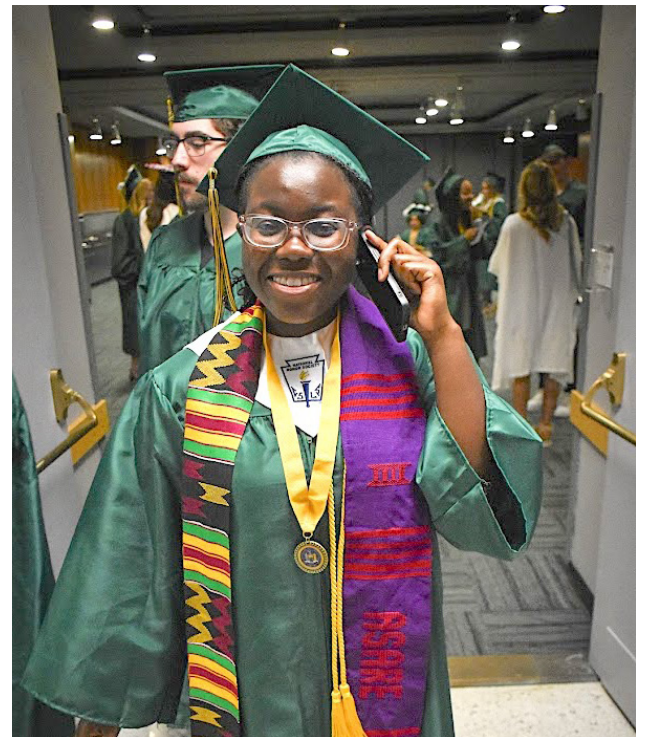

“This is a family-friendly event with fun activities planned for kids of all ages,” said Bethlehem Chamber President Terri Egan.

The event on Wednesday, July 26, will be held from 5-8 p.m. along the stretch of the trail from the Blanchard-Currey American Legion Post 1040 to The Real McCoy Beer Co.

Positive presence

Drug prevention efforts by the police increase as students enter middle and high school. Older students are not always aware of the significant dangers posed by drug and alcohol use and abuse. For example, Sidoti said, marijuana is many times stronger than it used to be years ago, and is now frequently laced with Fentanyl, a potent synthetic opioid.

One of the priorities of police in both areas is the importance of keeping children out of the criminal justice system, if

possible. Both towns have a Youth Court, made up of high school students, which imposes sanctions on students committing relatively minor criminal or delinquent behavior. Participating students take on such roles as judge, prosecutor, defense attorney, defense advocate and juror. Youth Court has been proven to reduce future delinquent behavior and saves students from having a criminal record.

“Some kids have tough lives, Belles said. “We

reason with them and try to get them to understand why their behavior is unacceptable.”

Whiteley agreed.

“We want them to know that our school resource officers are approachable, as are police in general here. We’re not the bad guys. We don’t want them to be afraid of coming to us with their problems. Judging from interviews with students from age 6 to 16, they both learn from and appreciate the presence of police in their schools and in their neighborhoods,” He said.

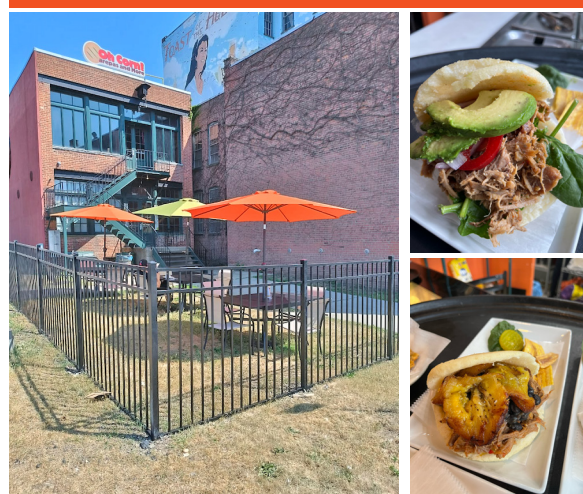

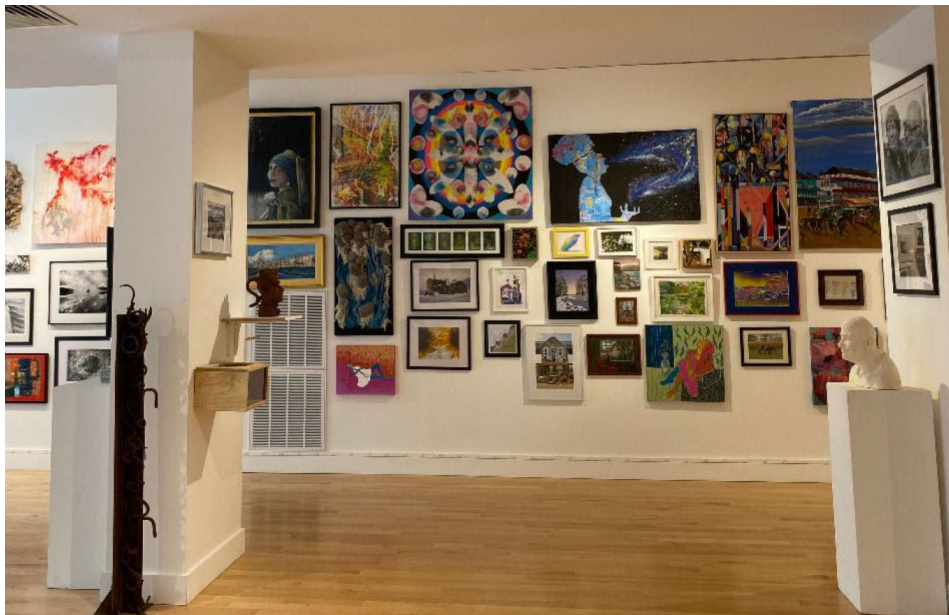

The personal film premiered Thursday, June 22 at the Beacon Theater on North Street in Pittsfield, MA and made its Capital Region debut at the Madison Theater on Sunday, June 25.

Born in Brooklyn, NY, and residing in Lee, MA, McKnight has been a fixture in the music business from as far back as the 1970's. McKnight was involved in New York City's 'New Wave' scene,



playing shows at CBGBs, Max's and Great Gildersleeves.

As songwriter, McKnight produced songs for the movie and television show, Colbert and the 2012 film Petunia starring Thora Birch. He also worked with artists Todd Rundgren, Earl Slick, Graham Maby, and '80's TV legend, John Davidson.

In local theater, McKnight's writing has appeared in the sketch comedy and variety show The Berserkshires, appearing at Dewey Hall, Sharon Playhouse, and Shakespeare & Company.

## About 'Band Boy'

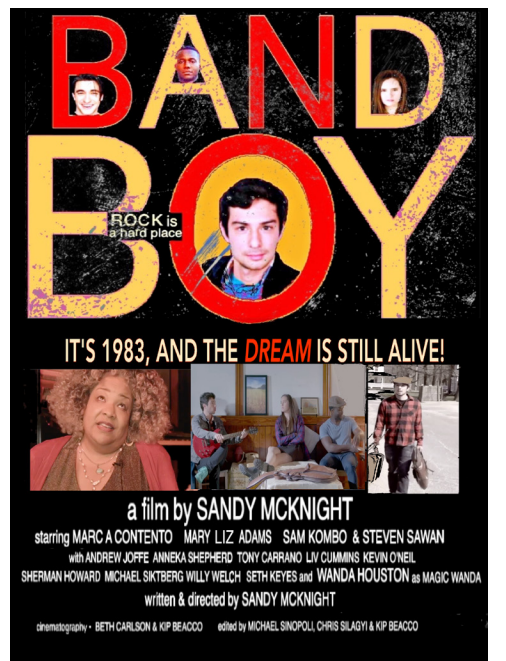
'Band Boy' is a story about a young musician and songwriter who in 1983, decides to leave his life in Michigan and heads south where he meets a like-minded group of musicians. The musicians take a beat-up van and hit the road playing at dive bars.

One night, a manager hears them and suggests they come to New York where the band can be recorded. Skeptical at first, the musicians go for it and the adventure begins. And soon, the musicians get tangled up into the corrupt, washed-up music business.

The film features a Berkshires-area cast and crew, including Wanda Houston; character actor Andrew Joffe, Sherman Howard (best known for his appearances on 'Seinfeld', 'Day of the Dead', and 'Lethal Weapon 2'), and singer-songwriter Liv Cummins. Also starring are Albany-based actors Mark A. Contento and Mary Liz-Adams, and Boston, MA actors Steven Sawan and Sam Kombo portraying the band members.

'Band Boy' was originally written as a stage musical during the pandemic and McKnight adapted the script into a film. McKnight's mission for the filmmaking was to maintain the intimacy and naturalistic feel of a live performance, he said.

The movie, filmed by Stockbridge, MA's Silo Media and Dalton, MA editor Michael Sinopoli, was filmed in five days at the Sheffield, MA Dewey Hall. Although McKnight received a grant from Berkshire Film and Media Collaborative, area performing arts nonprofit Columbia Arts Team, and a crowd-sourcing campaign, the film and the movie's 10



songs took almost two years to complete.

"I didn't want to tell the rags-to-riches story you see in most show-biz movies. Truth is, most of us don't do it for the money or fame, but the dream of overnight success in the early '80s kept us going through the rough times." McKnight said. "The story has a lot of laughs, but also a good dose of pathos."

McKnight said viewers can find themselves rooting for the young idealists in the film.

'Band Boy' was produced by Columbia Arts Team (Lee, MA), a 501c3 non-for-profit and proceeds from the screening will go towards the mission of showcasing local performers and writers' original work. 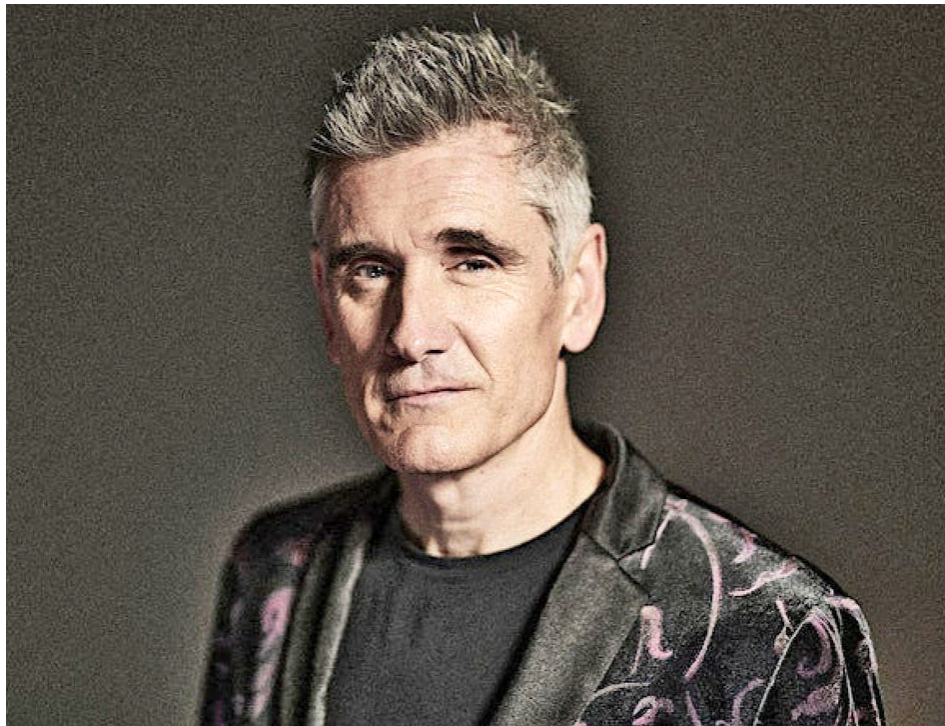

Fronted by poet Karen Schoemer, Albany NY's Sky Furrows combine influences from krautrock, NZ bands the Clean and the Verlaines, the Minutemen, Sylvia Plath and early Sonic Youth. Schoemer collaborates with bassist Mike Watt in Jaded Azurites, and with Wreckless Eric & Amy Rigby. Eric Hardiman, Mike Griffin and Phil Donnelly are members of psych rock unit Burnt Hills. **Tedeschi Trucks Band**

Tedeschi Trucks Band is a 12-piece blues-rock ensemble led by guitarists Susan Tedeschi and Derek Trucks. They are road warriors, often playing more than 200 dates a year. 2011's Revelator, their Grammy-winning Sony Masterworks debut, showcased a sound deeply grounded in roots music that cuts across and entwines blues, rock, jazz, soul, gospel, funk, country, various African musics, and Indian raga. 2012's Live: Everybody's Talkin' revealed a penchant for inventive covers, and a preference for improvisation. 2013's Made Up Mind included collaborations with songwriters including Eric Krasno and Sonya Kitchell. 2017's Let Me Get By, was co-written by the entire band. 2018's Live from the Fox Oakland also won a Grammy. 2019's Signs was composed of all-original material. It was the last to include keyboardist Kofi Burbridge, who died of a heart attack on its release date. In

2021, TTB released Layla Revisited [Live at LOCKN'] with special guest Trey Anastasio. During the summer of 2022, they released their most ambitious project, the four-LP set I Am the Moon. Each release -- I Am the Moon I: Crescent; II: Ascension; III: The Fall; IV: Farewell -- was accompanied by a corresponding film. **Tears For Fears**

Tears for Fears were always more ambitious than the average synth pop group. From the beginning, the duo of Roland Orzabal and Curt Smith were tackling big subjects -- their very name derived from Arthur Janov's primal scream therapy, and his theories were evident throughout their debut, The Hurting. Driven by catchy, infectious synth pop, The Hurting became a big hit in their native England, setting the stage for international stardom with their second album, 1985's Songs from the Big Chair. On the strength of the singles "Everybody Wants to Rule the World" and "Shout," the record became a major hit, establishing the duo as one of the leading acts of the second generation of MTV stars. Instead of quickly recording a follow-up, Tears for Fears labored over their third album, the psychedelic and jazz-rock-tinged The Seeds of Love. Smith left the group in the early '90s while Orzabal continued with Tears for Fears as a solo project for several years, issuing a pair of albums. They reunited briefly for 2004's Everybody Loves a Happy Ending and permanently to tour and record 2022's The Tipping Point. According to Director Michael LoPorto, the brothers invent a new musical as a way to best Shakespeare at his own game. Hilarity inevitably ensues.

The musical pokes fun at many shows Playhouse Stage Company has put on in the past, according to Producing Artistic Director Owen Smith.

**'Something Rotten' in the park**

"It's basically me, but exaggerated," he said.

When it came to coaching his cast members, LoPorto said that he initially challenged each to look at their character's relationship to honesty.

"That's a plot point in this show — the discovery of how important it is to be honest and to be truthful," he said, explaining that the cast has identified honesty as a controlling theme behind the play.

According to Smith, "Something Rotten" is the biggest show Playhouse Stage Company has put on in at least five years. The cast includes 24 members, with a 13-person band and a crew of about 15. There

are also lots of scenes and set changes within the show itself, which means that the design team has a lot on their hands.

"Every year, we start with an empty parking lot in Albany and we create a whole theater space there," Smith said. "The old phrase 'it takes a village' applies readily to working on these shows in Washington Park."

Although building an entire theater from scratch may take some effort, doing so allows Playhouse

Stage Company to keep their shows in Washington Park accessible.

"For 35 years, we've kept the lawn seating on the hill completely free," Smith said. "And that is a challenge to maintain that, but it's worth it because

it really makes sure that everyone can access the show."

Smith, LoPorto and Christopher are all eager to see how audiences respond to the show's many jokes and theatrical references.

"The jokes are just so

well-written. They land just by reading them," Christopher said.

"When the audience is really tuned into the show and it's quiet and then you hit a punchline and the whole place erupts in laughter, that's a really great feeling," Smith said. "It's a feeling that reminds us that we all have way more in common with each other than what divides us."

LoPorto added that he is particularly excited to return for the production's closing weekend.

"It's just a joy to watch where it's gone, how it's grown since I've been gone," he said. "I get to see the show in its

new form."

"Something Rotten" will run from June 29 to July 22, Tuesdays through Saturdays at 8pm. While free lawn seating is available on a first-come, first served basis, reserved seats may be purchased online, or by calling the box office at (518) 434-0776.

To round out their 35th season, Playhouse Stage Company will be presenting "The Secret Garden" from Aug. 3-19 at Park Playhouse, followed by "Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat" from Aug. 23-26 at Cohoes Music Hall. The company will announce its 36th season in September.

"It's a jam-packed summer for us always," Smith said. "This year's no exception."

# This flaky dessert is all about the blueberries

Blueberries should be a delicious part of people's daily diets because this flavorful fruit packs a nutritious punch. Blueberries are a great source of antioxidants, which can help the body fend off various illnesses.

Native to North America, blueberries are available fresh, frozen and canned and are used in a variety of recipes. Plus, they're right at home whether one is serving breakfast, dinner or dessert. However, many people feel that blueberries are best eaten as pie filling.

Various pastries showcase blueberries, including the French galette. A galette is not a pie, but more of a freeform crusty cake. However, it is similar to pie, making it a welcome alternative to that popular pastry. This recipe for "Blueberry Galette," courtesy of the U.S. Highbush Blueberry Council, is a delicious treat that's perfect for entertaining.

## Blueberry Galette

8 portions

### Crust

- 3 cups unbleached all-purpose flour
- 1 1/2 teaspoons salt
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 4 ounces lard or shortening, cut into 1/2-inch pieces
- and frozen
- 1 cup unsalted butter, cut into 1/2-inch pieces and refrigerated
- 1/2 cup ice water
- 1 teaspoon vodka

### Filling

- 8 cups fresh or frozen blueberries
- 3/4 cup sugar, plus 2 tablespoons, separated
- 3 1/2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 lemon, zested
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 egg
- 1 tablespoon water

### Crust

1. Combine the flour, salt and sugar in a food processor. Add the butter and lard.
2. Use the food processor to work the butter and lard into the flour by pulsing it until the butter is in pea-sized pieces.
3. Whisk the water and vodka together and add it to the flour/butter mixture a few tablespoons at a time. It will start to look shaggy, but not dry. It should hold together when you squeeze it in your hand.
4. Gently press the dough into a ball using a pastry scraper or your hands. Divide the dough into two pieces and create round disks. Wrap the dough in plastic and refrigerate for at least an hour, or overnight.

### Filling

1. In a small bowl, combine 3/4 cup sugar, cornstarch, salt, and lemon zest. Massage the zest into the sugar.
2. In a large bowl, toss together the blueberries and lemon juice. Add the sugar/lemon zest

3. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. On a floured surface, roll out the chilled pie dough into a 1/8-inch-thick-circle. Dust off any extra flour and lay crust onto the prepared pan.
4. Mound the blueberry filling in the middle of crust. Fold and crimp the dough up so that it covers at least 2 inches of the filling. Freeze the shaped galette for at least 15 minutes to chill the dough.
5. Preheat the oven to 425 F and set rack in middle of the oven.
6. Just before baking, beat the egg and water together and brush the edges with egg wash. Sprinkle crust with the remaining 2 tablespoons of sugar.
7. Bake for 30 minutes, then turn the oven down to 350 F and bake for an additional 30 minutes. This recipe yields two 12-inch galette crusts. Extra dough can be stored in an airtight container for up to one month.

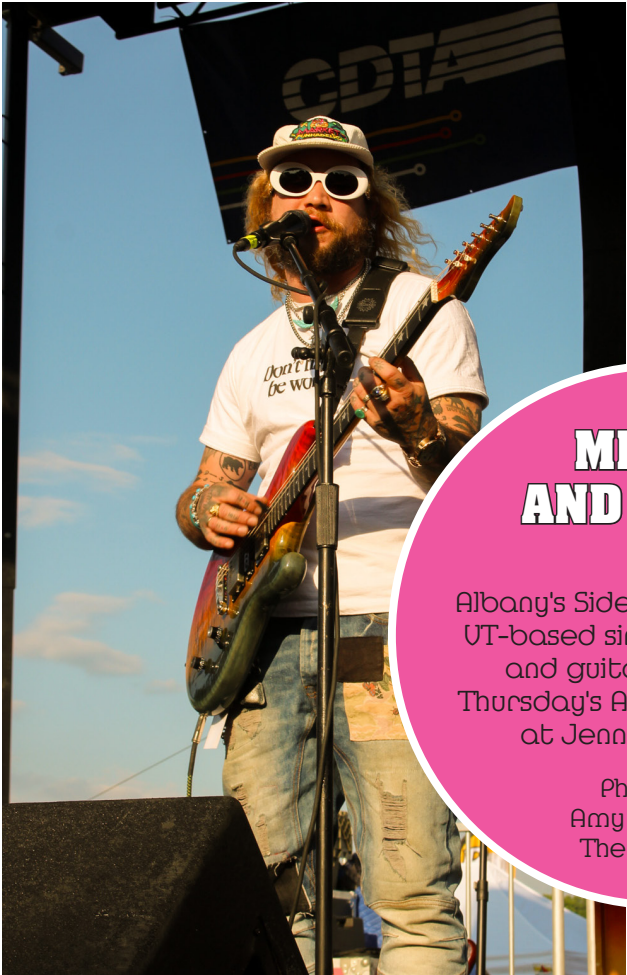

# How pet parents can approach excess weight gain

Maintaining a healthy weight is no small task.

Shifting metabolisms as human beings age require routine tweaking of diets so adults can avoid putting on extra weight. Though that's a concept many adults recognize, few may realize that dogs are vulnerable to weight gain as well. And just like their human companions, dogs who carry excess weight could be vulnerable to a host of dangerous ailments.

A veterinarian can help dog owners determine if it's time to tweak an animal's diet. In the meantime, if man's best friend seems to

be putting on a few extra pounds, dog owners can look to a host of variables to determine if they're contributing to weight gain.

## Treats

It's hard to resist a dog's wagging tail, and few things excite dogs more than treats. However, excessive amounts of treats can do more harm than good. In an interview with PetMD.com, Dr. Judy Morgan, DVM, noted that pets need approximately 20 to 30 calories per pound of body weight per day. So a 20-pound dog will only require between 400 and 600 calories per day. The majority of those

calories should come from healthy dog foods, not treats. Dog owners should read dog treat packaging to determine how many calories each treat contains. The results may be shocking. If dog treats are a daily component of a dog's diet, limit their consumption and look for low-calorie treats to help dogs shed excess pounds.

## Exercise

A sedentary lifestyle is as detrimental to dogs as it is to their human companions. The American Kennel Club notes that the amount of exercise dogs need is breed-specific. For example, a high-energy breed like a

border collie will require more exercise than a low-energy breed like an English bulldog. Preexisting health conditions also must be considered when determining how much exercise a dog needs. Dog owners can develop an exercise regimen with their veterinarians, but it's important to note that the AKC says even senior dogs need daily exercise.

## Food quality

The quality of food also must be examined if dogs are putting on excess weight. Even if dogs' calorie intake is adequate and not excessive and the animals exercise regularly,

they could still be gaining weight if the quality of their food is subpar. It can be



their size. But if excessive treats and lack of exercise are not the culprits behind weight gain, low-quality dog food could be to blame. A veterinarian can help dog owners pick a healthy food, and during that discussion the vet will likely examine the pet to determine if the weight gain is linked to an undiagnosed medical condition.
