Warrants become the pattern

Larceny, then warrant, then warrant again

DELMAR - A

19-year-old Albany woman was arrested by Bethlehem police for the second time on Tuesday, June 20 after she was detained by the Albany city police.

According to reports, Desiree Fowler and Myunique McQueen, also of Albany, were arrested in August at the Price Chopper in Slingerlands and charged with petit larceny and conspiracy after they allegedly filled bags with merchandise and left the store.

At that time, Fowler was released on an appearance ticket, but McQueen was detained and transported to Glenville for an open warrant there.

Fowler was in custody for another incident and an open warrant from Bethlehem for not showing up for court for the August incident. She was arraigned by town judge

Andrew Kirby and released under the supervision of probation, then transported to meet New Hartford police for an open warrant.

CVS larceny, then warrant, then warrant again

DELMAR - Bethlehem police responded to the Albany County jail on Friday, June 23 to take custody of William Johnson, 58, of Albany, for an open warrant in relation to a January incident on Delaware Avenue.

On January 22, Johnson and another man allegedly stole merchandise from CVS and were arrested by Bethlehem police on River Road later that night. At the time, they were charged with petit larceny and criminal impersonation. Johnson was released on an appearance ticket but used a false name.

A fingerprint check by the Department of Criminal Justice Services identified that it was Johnson and an arrest warrant application was made on January 29. He was arraigned by Bethlehem Town Judge Andrew Kirby and released on his own recognizance. Johnson is due back in court on July 18.

Johnson was then found to have an outstanding warrant from the City of Albany police and was transported to meet officers from that department.

Traffic project public comment phase nears completion

Town residents express a diversity of views on how extensive project should be

DELMAR - The first phase of the Town of Bethlehem's 1.3 mile road diet project lasts through July 7 as the Town continues to solicit public comments on the three preliminary concept plans unveiled by the Town at a June 15 public meeting.

To date, the Town has received 18 public comments through its DelAveCompleteStreets. com web site, 18 public comments by e-mail and an additional 25 public comments submitted on written comment forms that were distributed at the

Of the 18 comments received on the website, three respondents stated their enthusiastic preference for Plan 2A, the most comprehensive of the plans. However, seven of the 18 comments received on the website, indicated dissatisfaction with there being no infrastructure included in any of the plans for bicycle safety. When asked whether those comments would cause the Town to reconsider including bicycle infrastructure in the plan, Bethlehem Director of Planning Rob Leslie said, "we would have to wait until the close of the public comment period to see where the community's sentiment lands and to determine what is and is not feasible."

One thing Leslie was certain of, in response to a handful of other comments at the other

end of the spectrum that recommended keeping the status quo, doing nothing to change Delaware Avenue is not an option.

"I doubt we would contemplate that. Our common goal is to reduce speed and improve safety," he said, noting that right now the Town has the funds available to do that. "If we do nothing, we lose the money," Leslie said.

It is anticipated another public meeting will be held in the Fall after the Town has assessed the public comments it has received. In the meantime, the Town will work with individual local businesses and property owners over the summer concerning the impact to them of specific sidewalk and driveway improvements and driveway consolidations.

GUILDERLAND - On June 26, State Police of Latham arrested Nicole M. Lynch, 36, of Guilderland, for Grand Larceny in the Third Degree and Falsifying Business Records in the First Degree.

On June 22, at approximately 10:00 a.m., Troopers received a complaint from a Colonie business reporting an employee had taken money belonging to the business without permission. Since May Lynch reportedly falsified business records on multiple occasions resulting in the theft of over \$9,000.



BETHLEHEM - Last Monday, Police Chief Gina Cocchiara celebrated with town officials and staff by holding the department's annual award ceremony.

In total, 20 of Bethlehem's police officers, detectives, and telecommunicators were honored. The awards presented included the Exceptional Duty Award, Chief's Achievement Award, Department/ Unit Citation Award, Meritorious Service Award, the Life Saving Award, and two Career Recognition Awards. All of the awards, regardless of their category, highlighted the dedication and work put in by the Bethlehem Police Department.

Officer Luke Mara received the Exceptional Duty Award, highlighting a highly credible accomplishment or duty to service. Mara led the department in 2022 by removing 29 impaired drivers from Bethlehem roadways. Mara also received the Recognition of Excellence Award from the Mothers Against Drunk Driving, Stop DWI of New York State, and the New York State Governor's Traffic Safety Committee in May for this accomplishment.

The officers, Alex Griffin and Daniel Callahan were honored with this award for their lack of hesitation in saving not only the family's lives but the dogs, as

Justice Center operates illegally as 911 bill is blocked again

To the Editor

The New York State Justice Center for the Protection of People with Special Needs (Justice Center) located in Delmar at 161 Delaware Avenue across from the Delaware Plaza is the exact opposite from its name. This entity is a criminal enterprise, it is an Unjust Center for the Protection of Grossly Negligent Provider Agencies, Sexual Predators, Pedophiles, Rapists, Abusers, and those that Cause the Deaths of People with Disabilities and Mental Health Problems throughout New York State.

The top state court, the Court of Appeals ruled in March of 2021, as reported by the Spotlight Newspaper, that the Justice Center's actions of bypassing county elected district attorneys have always been illegal. People need to know the truth, the Unjust Center has an agreement with providers and employees that commit heinous crimes to protect them, as documented in a state document called the Jane Lynch Affidavit. Miss Lynch is the former head of the Unjust Center under its old name, in her own words she explains their "coherent"

oversight scheme" and "carefully cultivated understanding" to conceal documents and evidence of crimes. According to state a federal law these agreements to Obstruct Justice are a Criminal Conspiracy.

As a well-known Civil Rights and Disability Rights Advocate, as well as Whistleblower, that lives in the town of Bethlehem, I have done everything possible for the last ten years to expose and shut down this illegally operating entity and to finally get all witnessed crimes to be reported to 911. The Unjust Center receives close to 8,000 calls to its abuse hotline for the disabled every month, most of which of which are felony criminal offenses per NYS Penal Law 260.25. The Unjust Center also receives between 11-13 deaths every single day on average to its separate death hotline. Almost everything is kept from local police, criminal investigations, county medical examiners and coroners, county elected district attorneys that are constitutionally responsible for prosecuting all crimes within their county, from the courts, judges, juries - purposefully kept from the entire criminal justice system. Think about the sheer magnitude and astronomical scope of these numbers and realize that most crimes occurring within this system will never be witnessed or reported, it is far worse than you can imagine.

The sole purpose of this Criminal Obstruction of Justice is that most crimes committed against people with disabilities cannot be prosecuted. A person with disabilities or mental health problems living outside of their family home cannot have 'equal protection of laws' when they are victims of crimes when the Unjust Center continues to Obstruct Justice and bypass 911 call systems all across New York State. The wide-scale Discrimination in Civil Rights must be stopped now – my 911 Civil Rights Bill is the answer. This is not about simply shining a light on these gross injustices and atrocities occurring here in town, it is about finally reforming an extremely dangerous and deadly mental health care system, ending decades of discrimination and saving countless lives. My precious 13-year-old son Jonathan died because he was denied immediate 911

services.

My 911 Civil Rights Bill will save countless lives and end the decades of horrific Discrimination in Civil Rights in which some of our most vulnerable New Yorkers have been treated as lower class people unworthy of 911 first responder medical and police services, unworthy of protecting their safety and lives, unworthy of their equal rights and equal protection of laws promised them in both the NYS and US Constitutions.

I have asked New York State Attorney General James, Sheriff Craig Apple, and the appropriate federal authorities to swiftly intervene. EMERGENCY actions are critical to stop the state and federal crimes being committed that ongoingly endanger the safety and lives of incompetent and physically disabled New Yorkers.






50th wedding anniversary

Town moves Heath barn project forward

To ensure "effective and productive conversations", the Committee will be limited to ten members, said Bethlehem Town Supervisor David VanLuven. The goal is to appoint Committee members in September, after reviewing applications and conducting interviews, he said.

The Town seeks individuals who, according to a June 28 Town publication, are "knowledgeable about the history of the properties and/or have technical expertise in innovative farming, agri-tourism, veteran services, and recreation." In addition, "all members must be committed to the success of this endeavor." VanLuven "strongly believes" that commitment to the project's success

constitutes the most critical factor for appointment.

When asked during an interview if the Town seeks to appoint individuals from any particular constituency, VanLuven said, "I am going in with an open mind and an interest in pulling together a team of people who can crystallize our community's vision for the project and translate that vision from great ideas into reality."

However, after the vote, Board member Joyce Becker opined that the Board should ask residents who live near the property to apply.

"It's their neighborhood. I hope they will look for



this opportunity to serve," she said.

Jim Grady, a member of the Conservation
Easement Review Board that "green lighted" the Town's purchase of the Heath barn parcel, thinks the Committee members should represent diverse points of view. According to Grady, "the Committee

will be big enough so everyone has a voice."

Bethlehem Chamber of Commerce President Theresa Egan said she had "no strong feeling" regarding Committee membership. She hopes that "whatever recommendations the Committee makes will continue to enhance

the attractiveness of the community and bring people into the Town."

A "StoryMap" and survey currently appears on historicheathfarm.com, a dedicated website, which shows the 307 acre tract broken into six focus areas, each with a different future use. The Committee is to be guided but not bound


by the StoryMap options. "The StoryMap on the website presents a suite of options for each area of the properties. The Committee will work with that input," explained VanLuven. However, he added, "the Committee can raise and explore other opportunities if such opportunities arise."

The Town will accept applications for Committee spots until July 31. Anyone interested in applying to serve on the

Committee should visit the Town's website for more information.

As to the number of expected applications, VanLuven said, "One never knows. Sometimes we get a lot and sometimes a few. We always hope for a lot." He asked the public to "tune in and participate."



Foundation marks its 60th Anniversary

The Schenectady Foundation's diamond anniversary marks a rededication to the community

SCHENECTADY The Schenectady Foundation, a charitable trust dedicated to improving the health and well-being of those living and working in Schenectady County, is commemorating its 60th anniversary with a full year of new activities.

"We're celebrating the 60th anniversary, but really we're using the celebration as a way of rededicating ourselves to the community that we serve and putting more of ourselves out there to try to make some change," said Robert Carreau, executive director of The Schenectady Foundation.

"I think that the foundation is so unique," noted Michael Saccocio, executive director at the City Mission of Schenectady. "They're major funders, but they're also active in the neighborhoods, in the streets, and at a relationship level

with people."

As a part of their rededication, The Schenectady Foundation is launching major new initiatives, such as the One Schenectady Resident-Led Change Movement, the Grassroots Grant Fund for Equity, and the relaunch of the popular Community Hero Awards.

For their 50th anniversary, the foundation first initiated the Community Hero Awards. "It was very popular because anyone could send in a nomination for someone in the community who showed their leadership, volunteering, and involvement with making changes and having an impact," said Carreau.

A panel judges the submissions, and the ten selected community heroes will be recognized. Each of the heroes will designate an organization for a \$10,000 grant from the foundation.

"It was both a way of recognizing the people who have done so much for their

community, but it's also a way that they can then have more impact by looking at an organization that means something to them and giving them the power to make that investment," continued Carreau. "It fits nicely with our Resident-Led Change Initiative."

Over the last 10 years, the foundation has become increasingly residentoriented and increased its community presence. "We believe that the people who are closest to the problem are the closest to solutions," said

"We all need help achieving our dreams," said Saccocio. "Nobody does that on our own. It's a community-centered approach, but one where individuals, families, and neighborhoods decide what they want their future to

look like."

"The Schenectady Foundation has only continued to grow, expand, and become aware of listening to the needs of the community," said Kim Siciliano, CEÓ of YWCA NorthEastern NY.

"The foundation has invested in that and is doing it in so many creative ways as they're hitting their 60th anniversary," he added. "They have momentum and concrete successes to build on."

The Schenectady Foundation has worked with the City Mission of Schenectady and the YWCA for the past several decades, over time creating what Saccocio called 'trust'. Siciliano emphasized the combined efforts' ability to 'bring it

"We can't sit in our offices and say that we know what the community needs," she said. "We have to go to the community, listen, and help them implement and do the work, whether it's dollars, knowledge, skills, or tools."

"The best way to address these is to get residents more engaged, so it's not just organizations talking about what needs to shift," said Carreau.

The Schenectady Foundation also plans to announce details of a new scholarship and grant program. This new program will give each high school in the county an opportunity for its students to receive a scholarship for college. One scholarship per school will be awarded, allowing for more equity among Schenectady County high school students.

Donations that are matched by the foundation are encouraged, as is community attendance at events. A forthcoming neighborhood assembly will bring local residents together to identify common needs, concerns, and solutions to those issues.

"I value the partnership and collaborative climate that the foundation brings, whether it's about homelessness, domestic violence, education, or food insecurity," said Siciliano. "That includes everyone not just having a seat at the table but also having a voice and having an impact."

FHA loan

A Federal Housing Administration loan is issued by an FHA-approved lender. These loans are designed for low-to-moderate-income borrowers, according to the financial guide Investopedia. FHA loans require lower minimum down payments and lower credit scores than many conventional loans. FHA loans also

loans. FHA loans also require mortage insurance up front, plus annually for

11 years or the life of the loan depending on the length of the loan.

HELOC

A Home Equity
Line of Credit, commonly called a HELOC
loan, borrows against the
available equity in your
home to create a line of

credit, much like a credit card. These funds can be used for large expenses or to consolidate higher-interest rate debt on other loans, according to Bank of America. It may be possible to use a HELOC to secure funding to make improvements to a home for those who want to flip it as an investment property.

Private money lenders

Individuals investing in real estate who do not intend to use a property as a primary residence may turn to private money lenders. These investors can tap into capital from personal connections and lend at specified interest rates and payback periods, according to Fortune Builders, a real estate investing resource. Keep in mind the interest rate will likely be higher with a private lender than through a conventional lender. The repayment term also will be shorter.

VA-backed loan

The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs has a program for acquiring loans through conventional lenders that will be partially guaranteed against loss through the VA. This enables a lender to give better loan terms, such as the option to pay no down payment. Interested parties need to qualify for a Certificate of Eligibility and then work with qualified lenders.

People have several options to finance the purchase of a home. These loans can help make the dream of home ownership a reality. Potential buyers are urged to speak with mortgage professionals or financial planners to consider their options.



Quick and easy Greek-inspired sandwiches

I ummer vacations from school will have children clamoring for tasty lunches to help them refuel for another round of backyard swimming or frolicking with neighborhood friends. The same foods served time and again can get boring pretty quickly. Offering up new options doesn't have to be complicated, and parents may discover an array of foods and flavors that their kids will enjoy and ask for in the future.

Such can be the case with Greek-inspired gyros. The fillings can vary depending on the ingredients available in the house. For "Turkey Meatball Gyros" from the "Taste of Home: Healthy Cooking Cookbook" (RDA Enthusiast Brands) by the editors of Taste of Home, the meatballs can be made the night before or in big batches and frozen to be used as needed. The yogurt sauce in this recipe is remini-scent of traditional Greek tzatziki, which is fresh and flavorful.

Turkey Meatball Gyros

Makes 4 servings

cup seasoned bread crumbs

teaspoon garlic powder

teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon pepper

pound lean ground turkey

cup (6 ounces) reduced-fat plain yogurt

1/2 cup finely chopped peeled cucumber

tablespoons finely chopped onion

11/2 teaspoons lemon juice

8

whole wheat pita pocket halves

cups shredded lettuce

cup chopped tomatoes



In a large bowl, combine the bread crumbs, egg and seasonings. Crumble turkey over mixture and mix well. Shape into 16 balls. Place meatballs on a rack coated with cooking spray in a shallow baking pan. Bake uncovered at 400 F for 15 to 20 minutes,

or until no longer pink.


Meanwhile, in a small bowl, combine the yogurt, cucumber, onions, and lemon juice. Line pitas with lettuce and tomatoes; add the meatballs and drizzle with the vogurt sauce.
