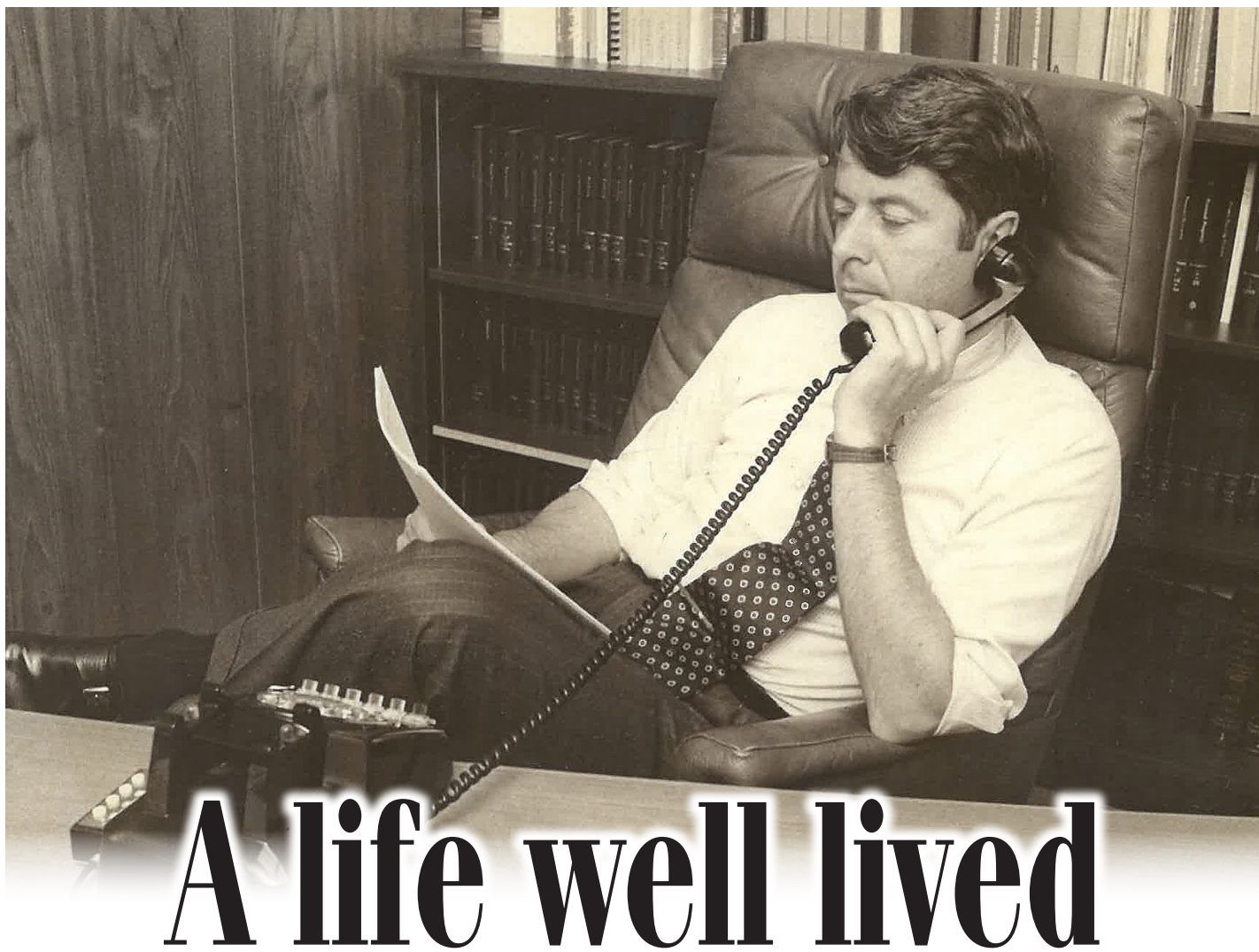

# A life well lived



State Sen. Howard Nolan was more than just a politician and horse lover

DELMAR – When former State Sen. Howard Nolan first published his memoir in 2018, he entitled it “Politics and Ponies,” giving front cover attention to his two well-known passions. 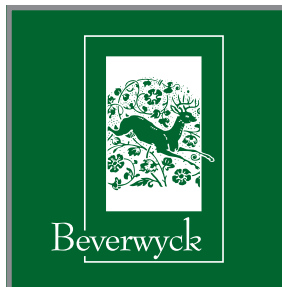

# BOE loses appeal, candidate stays on ballot

5-0 decision finds lower court's decision to restore Rowlands is valid

ALBANY - The Appellate Division of State Supreme Court ruled 5-0 on Thursday, Aug. 17 to uphold a July 7 ruling by Judge Michael Mackey that restored enough petition signatures for a Bethlehem Town Board candidate to appear on the November ballot.

The Albany County Board of Elections filed an appeal of Mackey's ruling on the grounds that candidate Kellin Rowlands' attorney, Matt Clyne, submitted evidence in an improper way by consolidating the challenges to the BOE ruling on 28 individual signatures in one Excel spreadsheet instead of submitting them separately.

"Respondents argue that (the) Supreme Court should have dismissed the preceding due to the validating petition's lack of particularity," the appeal decision stated. "We disagree."

The BOE also said that Mackey erred in allowing affidavits of those who witnessed the signing of the petitions as evidence they were valid. The Appellate decision dismissed that and said that, in

addition, the BOE had the opportunity to bring the actual signers into court to contest the affidavits, but they did not.

The appellate decision also upheld Mackey's decision to review and validate 15 other signatures, which gave Rowlands 20 more than he needed.

"Thus, even if the affidavits had not been admitted into evidence, petitioner would have established that the nominating petition is valid," the justices wrote.

Rowlands will join Democrats Joyce Becker and Tom Schnurr and Republican Theresa O'Neil on the ballot on Nov. 7.

"The Board (of Elections) is disappointed by the decision, but we will continue to abide by the order of the court," attorney Adam Fusco, who represented the BOE said.

Both Clyne and Fusco said that any further appeal is unlikely.

## The history of the case

Mackey's July 7 decision and order restored Rowlands to the ballot as a candidate for the Uniting Bethlehem party after he was removed by the Board of Elections on June 14.

The removal was initiated based on objections filed on June 5 by Bethlehem resident Jeff Baker for 256 of the 1,078 petition signatures submitted by Rowlands on May 26. Baker is a member of the Bethlehem Democratic Committee and serves as its 2nd Vice Chair.

According to the decision, "Baker alleged that certain line-by-line signatures were ... illegible, did not contain the first name of the individual who allegedly signed the petition, were printed, or otherwise could not be matched to voter registration."

In its review of Baker's objections,

the board of elections agreed with Baker, but did reduce the number of invalid signatures to 156 and conceded the board miscalculated the number of signatures by one, leaving Rowlands six signatures short of the required number of 928 needed to be on the ballot.

Rowlands hired Clyne to review the objections and represent him in the proceedings. Clyne is a former Albany County Board of Elections Commissioner and the current Bethlehem Conservative Party Chairman who is very familiar with objections to petition signatures.

After the BOE made its final determination, Clyne filed with the court to review the case and provided evidence the signatures were valid.

"It is really hard to compare signatures [on petitions] to those on file," Clyne said. "Lots of the signatures on file are coming from DMV or other sources and are not of good quality."

Clyne explained that the use of digital recording is not the same as a "wet ink" signature and that people's signature may also change over time or because the method by which they are recorded is different.

At the Supreme Court's evidentiary hearing on June 27, Clyne provided,

Nolan: A life well lived

State horse breeders. Yet, the real legacy of this man, who also once cited Ayn Rand to explain the virtues of capitalism, were the many lives he changed as a result of his extensive philanthropic work.

And work is the operable word here. Over decades, Nolan elevated the notion of pro bono publico – for the public good – well beyond his passion for politics. Of course, Nolan sat on Boards of charitable organizations – St. Peter’s Hospital, WMHT, the Community Foundation for the Capital Region, the Center for Disability Services’ governing board and its foundation board, and the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation Second Chance Program, to name a few, but for Nolan, however, a board seat was far more than a chair in which to rest comfortably.

“Everything he did he gave 110 percent,” said Debbie Nolan Murray, the third of Nolan’s seven children and who now runs the family real estate business. “He jumped right in, pulled up his sleeves and would ask what do you need me to do, and then he would do it.”

In 1983, Monique Koehler incorporated the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation as a not for profit foundation to create a home for racehorses who had run their last race and who otherwise may have faced slaughter. Koehler considered Nolan, a state senator and owner of Blue Sky Horse Farm, a 200-horse breeding farm, a natural fit for her board.

As Nolan recounted in his memoir, after joining the TRF Board, he was driving home from his Blue Sky Horse farm, which is near the Wallkill State Correctional Facility in Goshen, and noticed that the prison had a farm on its grounds. As he drove by, he thought, “Wouldn’t this be great if we could join with the state and find something to do for the prisoners?”

That idea provided the vision for a program, and in 1984, he started TRF Second Chances, which pairs inmates with retired race horses. Inmates participating in the program learn valuable horseman skills, such as anatomy, how to care for injuries and equine nutrition. According to the TRF website, after being released from prison, graduates of the program have found jobs as farriers, veterinarian assistants and animal caretakers. They also gain confidence, empathy and trust from caring for another living being, all of which are qualities that help them avoid re-entering the correctional system. TRF states that studies have shown a reduction in recidivism in correctional facilities that host the Second Chances Program.

The program has now been adopted in five other states, including Florida, California, Kentucky, Maryland and South Carolina, with eight farms located at state correctional facilities.

Joe McMahon, owner of McMahon of Saratoga



Thoroughbreds, was Nolan’s friend and business partner. He thought Nolan was way ahead of his time when he thought of pairing inmate rehabilitation with horse training.

“Howard was always very aware of social justice” and “was way out in front of it,” reflected McMahon. “He had a lot of foresight about that and did a good job, and the proof is that the program has now existed for nearly 50 years.”

Nolan melded his passion for helping people with his work in the State Senate. Most notably, he and then Assembly members Michael McNulty and Richard Conners pooled the entirety of their member items one year to fund an innovative program – the Honor Court – a not-for-profit drug diversion program for people battling addiction as an alternative to incarceration in the City of Albany. (The Honor Court program has

which was not very popular at the time.

Herbert said Honor Court got started with the member item funding provided by Nolan and the two other state legislators that allowed them to hire drug counselors and to expand the program’s geographic reach.

“Senator Nolan espoused a lot of the principles upon which Honor Court was founded: dignity and respect for people and giving people a second chance because none of us are perfect,” she said.

The program was kept going when those funds were renewed each year.

“We recognized that addiction was a disease and that people who suffer from addiction deserve a chance at a recovery program and that they are better served by a recovery program than by prison time,” said McNulty, now retired. He said the three never regretted their decision of devoting substantial funds from their member items to the cause.

Herbert reported that over the years, thousands of individuals have graduated from the Honor Court program. Some of them have used their experience to help other recovering substance abusers and went on to work in rehabilitation programs and even assumed leadership positions in those kinds of organizations.

According to Herbert, Nolan and then McNulty’s support did not stop at funding. Nolan hired program graduates to his legislative staff. He and McNulty also often attended the annual Honor Court anniversary celebration, along with community members, past graduates and

their families.

“His attendance meant a lot to people because it showed them that people in the legislature believed they could make it,” she recounted. “They felt supported because these legislators were doing more than dropping money in, but showed that they believed that the program participants could make it.”

McNulty said in a recent interview that when he and Nolan attended Honor Court anniversary celebrations at the Courthouse and heard the personal testimonials, they witnessed someone who succeeded in recovery and could feel there was an impact on someone’s life – the evidence was right before their eyes.

“It’s not abstract, it’s not numbers. These were human beings who went through the program and put their lives back together,” he added. “Howard understood the principle that life was to give and not to take.”

Nolan also gave considerable time to children with disabilities, as one of a group of friends determined to create a program of services that would enable children with disabilities to lead as full and independent lives as possible. Those efforts led to the creation of wide-ranging services for children with disabilities and their families at what is now known as the Center for Disability Services in Albany.

Nolan’s involvement with the Center began in about 1960. “He was a pioneer, an ambassador, out in the community talking about what the Center does, giving people tours with staff and getting people involved,” said Anne Schneider

since been adopted in the towns of Bethlehem, Colonie and other surrounding towns).

“Honor Court gives people hope that there is life further on and that people respect their dignity as a human being,” said Sister Phyllis Herbert, a co-founder and current Director of Honor Court.

Nolan’s good friend and a priest in Albany, Father Peter Young (now deceased), had championed this cause,

and the court accepted, evidence through witnesses and affidavits that supported the signatures of 10 people. In addition, Mackey reviewed the signature comparisons provided by the BOE, himself, and validated an additional 15 signatures.

“The court has compared the signatures of the [15 voters] with the signature cards on file with the Board and finds that they substantially compare and are valid,” he wrote in the ruling.

The decision orders the BOE to put Rowlands on the ballot, but the BOE appealed the decision.

“The Board of Elections is not made up of Dems,” Baker said. “This is a rare opportunity where both sides, Dems and Republicans, came together. Both sides had problems with [Rowlands] petitions.”

The end result is Rowlands had 20 valid signatures beyond the requirement.



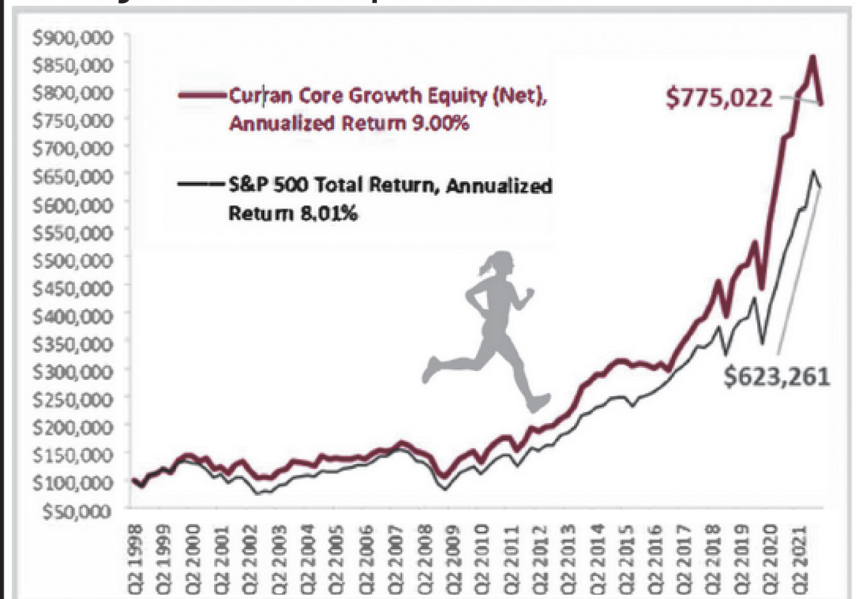

Costigan, the Center's Senior Vice President of Communications and Development who worked with Nolan since her hire in March 1985. "He was just a tireless advocate for people with disabilities and for their families."

His contributions were both large and small, according to Costigan. "It didn't matter who was calling, he would pick up the phone and if he couldn't directly help you he would reach out and find someone who would."

In 1960, Nolan was one of the creators of the Center's telethon, an event that still continues today as a community tradition and is the oldest telethon in the country. Costigan attributed much of the Center's telethon success to Nolan's participation. She described how he would secure the talent of athletes and movie stars to appear and strategize over planning each year's telethon. At the over 20 telethons he attended, Nolan greeted people, walked people to the stage, watched the numbers grow on the tote board and even counted the change and dollars put in the big "fishbowl" that grew with contributions during the telethon night.

Costigan laughed as she recalled how Nolan didn't just man the telethon phone banks taking incoming contributions, but made outgoing calls to people to actively solicit them to contribute. "Howard was involved with the Center

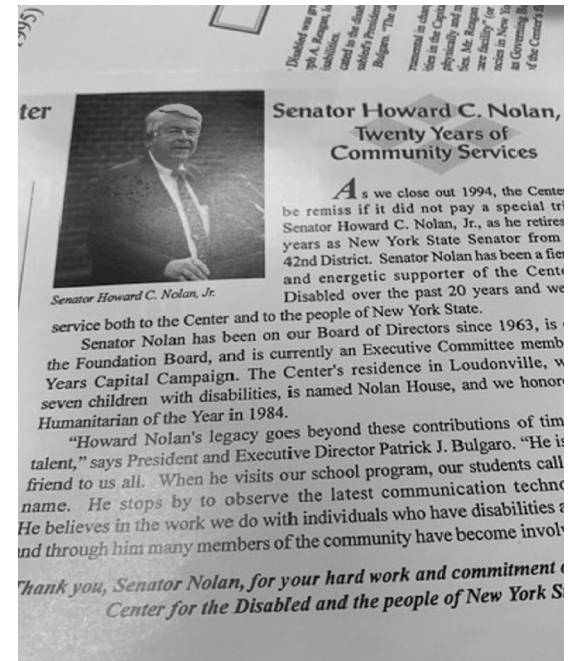
until the day he died," recounted Costigan.

I can't tell you how many hours we spent as a family at the telethons, "said Nolan Murray. She and her sisters were even enlisted as part of the "local" on-air talent and danced on the telethon stage with their ballet and tap dance classmates. "When you saw kids your own age with these disabilities, you never forget that and it makes you very thankful for what you have." She noted, however, that her parents made sure that "you didn't think of these kids any differently; it was just that they didn't have the ability to walk or talk."

On the financial side, Nolan made sure to secure

funding for the Center through his own and other State senators' and assemblymen's member items. He also made significant personal financial contributions.

When the Center began its only Capital Campaign in the late 1980s, it set the extraordinary goal of raising \$7.6 million. "Howard was at it from the start to the finish," said Costigan. "We met the goal."



After Senator Nolan passed away in June, the Center received many "In Memory" gifts. "These are the people Senator Nolan introduced the Center to," said Costigan. She reported that those "In Memory" gifts are still coming in.

Asked to describe her father's legacy to his family and the public, Nolan Murray said that she and her siblings were taught by

their parents from a very early age that "no one is better than anyone else" and that ethos was the driving force behind her father's desire to help people.

"When you were with him, it was always, 'What can I do for you?'" she added. "He just wanted to help people."

Herbert agreed. "He cared about his people. When he was involved in

a problem, he locked into it. Once he locked into something, he really worked on it."

"He didn't sit by the sidelines waiting for issues to come to him," said McMahan. "Howard went out to them."

As for the Center, Costigan said simply, "his legacy is alive here and will live on here forever."

# Lets finally deliver a commonsense immigration overhaul

To the Editor,

To deter Central American refugees from seeking safe haven, he began a controversial policy of detaining them at the Southern border. He stoked outrage and shame by herding families into makeshift cages erected on concrete floors. He deported a staggering 3 million immigrants, more than any other U.S. President.

Barack Obama was no immigration reformer.

MSNBC and Fox News will tell you differently, but here's the truth: no one party, no one figure, no branch of government is responsible for our national embarrassment of an immigration system. Failure on this scale requires years of bipartisan neglect and cynical political gamesmanship, reactionary executive patchwork replacing thoughtful congressional action.

It wasn't always like this. In 1953, President Eisenhower signed bipartisan legislation allowing 214,000 refugees fleeing Communist persecution to emigrate to the United States. It was an orderly process. Employment and housing were prearranged.

The refugees settled near citizen sponsors all over the country.

Compare President Eisenhower's approach to President Biden's.

When migrants began fleeing Venezuela last spring, the President and congressional leaders should've developed a comprehensive plan detailing how many people we could accept, what federally funded services could be provided, and where they could be resettled without straining any one state or municipalities' capacity to help while asylum cases were adjudicated.

This did not happen. The President didn't really do anything.

He idly watched as immigration officials and governors shipped 100,000 migrants to New York City. He's brushed off Gov. Hochul's ideas to use federal assets for housing. And he's denied Mayor Adams' requests for funding and additional resources.

Beleaguered and out of good options, the mayor has chosen an especially terrible one: hiring a sleazy consulting firm to ship migrants to our Upstate communities

without any notice, any communication or any detailed plan.

What should happen now?

In the short term, New Yorkers need the federal government to acknowledge that this crisis has been caused by federal failures and should be paid for by federal funds, not property taxpayers in Colonie, Rotterdam or Brooklyn for that matter. (If only the Democrats knew someone with some juice in the U.S. Senate...)

Additionally, downstate leaders must honor the resolutions passed by upstate counties and municipalities that simply do not have the resources to provide a complex array of social services for asylum seekers. Crushed by escalating Medicaid costs, a costly opioid epidemic and acute housing shortages, they're just not in a position to help solve an international crisis.

The federal government, however, is. It owns approximately 77,000 unoccupied buildings across the country. Why can't they be turned into asylum centers providing housing and support services? Why can't the federal government provide a waiver

allowing these men and women to work while their cases are adjudicated?

Above all, this humanitarian crisis has proven that a broken immigration system provides everyone with exclusively bad options. Overly restrictive legal pathways tied up in red tape push far too many people to seek asylum. A backlog of 1.6 million asylum cases means desperate people resign themselves to living in the shadows as undocumented immigrants. Perpetuating this status quo is good for talking heads who want to scare you on cable news and for immoral people who want to exploit a permanent underclass of workers who don't have rights. It's bad for everyone else.

This session, I helped pass bipartisan immigration reform in the Senate. The bill would expedite the naturalization process for the undocumented family members of servicemembers and veterans. We need lawmakers in Washington to embrace the same spirit of collaboration and finally deliver the commonsense immigration overhaul we've needed for decades.

# Builder charged with more counts

Additional charges added to those in June

**GUILDERLAND** - A Guilderland builder faces additional counts of fraud after he was arrested in June after additional victims came forward in Bethlehem and Guilderland.

Aaron R. Godlewski, 31, of Altamont, was charged on August 7 with three counts of scheme to defraud, all felonies, and three counts of illegal diversion of labor/equipment, all misdemeanors.

On June 13, 2023, State Police first arrested Godlewski for grand larceny, three counts of scheme to defraud in the first degree- issuing a bad check and scheme to defraud in the second degree, all felonies, and two counts of theft of services and petit larceny, all misdemeanors.

On May 1, Troopers received a complaint from

a contractor reporting they were issued a bad check by an Albany County Builder.

The investigation determined Godlewski was acting as a home builder and general contractor under the company name of Godlewski Builders LLC. In the course of the investigation, additional victims were discovered.

Godlewski allegedly was hired by multiple individuals and paid for contracted work. He allegedly hired numerous subcontractors who completed parts of the project but then failed to reimburse them and, in one incident, issued a payment from an account known to have insufficient funds. These crimes occurred in New Scotland, Altamont, and Bethlehem from 2021 through 2023 and resulted in the theft of services and more than \$1,000.

Godlewski surrendered himself to State Police in New Scotland, where he was arrested and processed. He was issued appearance

tickets returnable to the multiple courts on later dates.

“The book is not just my journey,” said Katsoudas, 24, of Colonie. “I know that there’s somebody out there with the same journey.”

The seed was planted for “Gardens in Graveyards” shortly after she completed her first poetry book, “Supernovas of the Heart.”

“I wrote down this idea that the title ‘Gardens in Graveyards’ is going to stand for all of the beautiful things that can grow from things that have died and passed on,” she said.

The initial concept was that the title would reflect friendships that had dissolved in her life. However, the expression “gardens in graveyards” became a mantra for Katsoudas as she underwent unexpected loss, death and change within a short period of time.

“The title took on a whole new meaning — not just mourning things in my life that have changed due to time and space between people, but also the space between the living and the

dead. It became my mantra for life. I feel like it was a tree, and it grew all these different limbs. Each limb was a different season of my life,” said Katsoudas.

Writing became an opportunity to express herself through the difficult time.

“What has always inspired me to write is that they’re my feelings. Writing is my outlet; it helps me to cope and navigate things. It’s been part of my growing process, like growing up and dealing with the normal bumps in life — the good and the bad,” she said.

The poems were primarily composed within the past three to four years. Katsoudas admitted that she didn’t set out with the intention of writing another book.

“I didn’t know what it was going to turn into. It’s very strange how things work out!” she said. “Every time I write something, I’m just writing it. All of those things were just fitting into

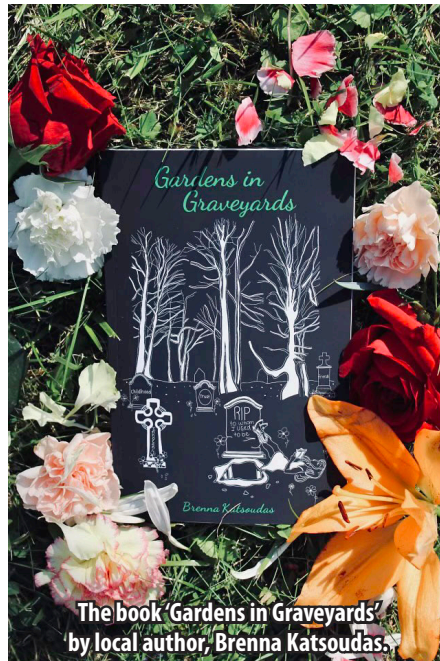
this book because everything in my life was fitting into the concept of the book.”

The book launch for “Gardens in Graveyards” was held at MochaLisa’s Caffé in Clifton Park. Co-owner Roland Van Zandt described the relationship between local authors and MochaLisa’s Caffé as a “collaboration.”

“It was wonderful,” he said regarding Katsoudas’s book signing. “She had family and friends come in, and a lot of people from the general public saw her work and saw the opportunity to come in to meet her, talk with her, hear her story, and purchase a copy of her book to have it signed.”

Copies of “Gardens in Graveyards” are available to purchase at MochaLisa’s Caffé. The cafe is dedicated to providing a place for local authors, artists, and craftspeople to sell their goods, work, and get exposure.

“It’s been extremely rewarding to support our local authors,” said Zandt.

The readers of “Gardens in Graveyards” will see Katsoudas’ own drawings fill the pages and accompany the poems for an added visual element to the storytelling.

“I wanted to try to bring my vision to life,” she said.

This is her first book to feature her own artwork, but her second book to carry on a promise from her youth. Katsoudas published her first poetry book, “Supernovas of the Heart” at just 20 years old. The book was dedicated to an

inspiration in her life, her grandfather.

“He always told me, ‘You’re going to write a book someday. I know I’m going to live to see the day you write a book,’” she remembered. “That inspired me and pushed me even more to write a book while he was here. It was very special that he got to see that.”

Katsoudas carried his wisdom with her when approaching her new book.

“The first book and this book are very different because one was written in such a dark place, and this was also written in such a dark place, but I was able to see the good in it as well,” she said.

“I had a graveyard full of things to be sad about, and this graveyard full of things that were dead. All of these people that were alive but no longer in my life, or they did pass on. ... But from the graveyard, I learned so many valuable lessons at the departure of all of those things and people. From the sadness, I watered those things with love and grew

flowers, and so many things grew from the things that had died; so much love and happiness,” said Katsoudas.

Her hope is that the poetry serves as a reminder to the reader that the gravestones do not define anyone, but rather that they’re part of the journey to growing as a person.

“No matter how terrible it gets and how awful the feeling is, there is always something good that comes from that, and you will be so happy that you stuck around to see all of the things grow,” she said.

“I see so much growth between the two books, not just in the writing but in my own life and mind,” she added. “Seeing that much growth just between these two makes me excited about what the next book will be.”

“Gardens in Graveyards” was printed by The Troy Book Makers and is available in local bookstores, including Market Block Books in Troy and The Book House in Stuyvesant Plaza. It is also available on Amazon, with further information listed on Katsoudas’ website, linktr.ee/bkatsoudas.

Since 2010, he's released four chart topping studio albums; toured with everyone from Jeff Beck to the Red Hot Chili Peppers; collaborated across genres with Pharrell, Bruno Mars, Mark Ronson, Foo Fighters, ZHU, Zac Brown, Normani, Ringo Starr, and countless more; played Coachella, Bonnaroo, Lollapalooza, Newport Folk, Newport Jazz, and nearly every other major festival; performed four times at the GRAMMY Awards, five times at the White House, on dozens of TV shows, and at the star-studded Sesame Street Gala, where he was honored with his own Muppet; launched the Trombone Shorty Foundation to support youth music education; and received the prestigious Caldecott Honor for his first children's book. Part of the Boston hardcore scene, Death Before Dishonor originated in 2001 from the remains of Incision, Fuse, and League of Pain. In 2002, Death Before Dishonor pressed their first CD, the four-song *Wartime* EP, but they didn't truly hit their stride until 2005, after signing to Bridge Nine Records. They released their first full-length, *Friends Family Forever*, that year and began playing out unremittingly, touring for a full year and a half alongside fellow hardcore groups Full Blown Chaos, Champion, Terror, and Agnostic Front. In 2007 *Count Me In* was released, and that album's single, "Break Through It All," earned some rotation on MTV2's *Headbangers Ball*. As their recognition increased, by 2008 they were averaging 250 performances a year, but they still showed no signs of letting up, and the group embarked on an international tour in 2008, headlining in Australia, Europe, Mexico, and Canada. Member changes ensued soon after, and a new drummer was recruited before they renewed their contract with Bridge Nine and released *Better Ways to Die* in 2009. # Stir up dinner quickly

The lazy days of summer have started to fade away, and individuals and families will once again be beholden to more rigid schedules packed with activities.

When time is of the essence, finding opportunity to cook delicious meals at home can seem challenging. But there are plenty of recipes that whip up in no time and won't disappoint hungry families.



This recipe for "Speedy Beef Stir-Fry with Chunky Vegetables" from "300 Stir-Fry Recipes" (Robert Rose) by Nancie McDermott is one such meal. It evokes the tastes of a favorite Asian restaurant without the need to order takeout.

## Speedy Beef Stir-Fry with Chunky Vegetables

Serves 4

- 1 tablespoon dry sherry or Shaoxing rice wine
- 1 tablespoon water

- 1/2 teaspoon soy sauce, optional
- 2 teaspoons cornstarch
- 8 ounces lean boneless beef, thinly sliced
- 3 tablespoons chicken stock
- 2 teaspoons soy sauce
- 1/2 teaspoon granulated sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt or to taste
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 2 teaspoons chopped garlic
- 2 teaspoons finely chopped fresh gingerroot
- 1 1/2 cups baby corn
- 1/2 cup sliced water chestnuts
- 1/2 cup frozen tiny peas

1. In a bowl, combine sherry, water, dark soy sauce, if using, and cornstarch and stir well into a smooth paste. Add beef and stir to coat well. Set aside for 10 minutes.

2. In a small bowl, combine chicken stock, soy sauce, sugar and salt and stir well.

3. Heat a wok or a large deep skillet over high heat. Add oil and swirl to coat pan. Add garlic and ginger and toss well until fragrant, about 15 seconds. Add beef mixture and spread into a single layer. Cook, undisturbed, until edges change color, about 1 minute. Toss well.

4. Add chicken stock mixture, baby corn and water chestnuts. Cook, tossing occasionally, until beef is cooked through, about 2 minutes more. Add peas and cook, tossing once for 1 minute more. Transfer to a serving plate. Serve hot or warm.
