SLINGERLANDS – Health care is moving around in the Capital Region. In the last five years, Community Care Physicians has closed its Delmar urgent care office, beginning in February 2024 CDPHP and Community Care will start consolidating their physical operations to a new location in Latham and effective September 13, an

Pine Hollow Arboretum achieves new honor

Upgraded accreditation boosts status of botanical wonderland among arboreta worldwide

SLINGERLANDS – The Pine Hollow Arboretum has reached another milestone in the world of arboreta.

The Slingerlands arboretum was upgraded to a Level II accreditation by the ArbNet Arboretum Accreditation Program and the Morton Arboretum. This new status recognizes its arboretum for achieving certain standards and practices that were deemed important in the world of arboreta and botanical gardens.

The organization's recognition in the Morton Register of Arboreta will allow it to be in a database featured among other world arboreta and gardens dedicated to woody plants.

The level of recognition was exciting to Executive Director Gabrielle Sant'Angelo and the rest of the Pine Hollow crew.

"It is exciting. There's a lot of Level I arboreta out there, but there's not that many Level II," Sant'Angelo said. "Overall, there's 300 accredited arboreta in the country, half of them are Level I. But as you get higher up (there's four levels), there's less and less. So yeah, we're

pretty excited about it."

According to Sant'Angelo, the arboretum reached its Level I status in 2015. In order to obtain its accreditation (Level II), PHA created an enhanced database on of the arboretum's entire collection. It contains information on their native and non-native plants and their handling, what PHA is bringing to their facility to plant, and what they're taking out.

Horticulturist Sandy Broussard spent time sifting through old invoices that founder John W. Abbuhl had filed away. The invoices had notes written on them about the trees or plants that were planted and which ones were planted near each other within the arboretum.

In the future, Sant'Angelo would like to place the database into a GPS format. Visitors in the future would be able to go on PHA's website to look at the map of everything featured at the arboretum and pick out where the trees are located to study them.

Stephanie Abbuhl, board member and daughter of the founder also shared a statement about the accreditation.

"Pine Hollow Arboretum is thrilled to have achieved Level II Arboretum accreditation, a measure of the dedication of the 'village' that supports this local non-profit gem of 23 acres in Slingerlands," she said. "This recognition is the result of the

outstanding leadership of the executive director, Gabrielle Sant'Angelo, along with Sandy Broussard, horticulturist, and the many volunteers, donors, and board members who work to plant, weed, mulch, prune, clear trails, support with donations, and find joy in the beauty of nature and the wisdom of trees."

About John W. Abbuhl

John W. Abbuhl originally had ties to Rensselaer County prior to living in Slingerlands and forming PHA. Born in Troy June 27, 1926, he moved to Cropseyville with his parents at the age of 4. Abbuhl graduated from The Albany Academy in 1943 and later served in the Navy, attended Albany Medical College, settled in Albany and later, Slingerlands with his family, and began a career in pediatrics spanning more than 50 years.

In 1966, Abbuhl moved his family from their original residence on New Scotland Avenue in Albany to Pine Hollow Road in Slingerlands and began planting trees at their new home. He began picking up various trees and woody specimens from all over the world, and over the years, acquired additional adjacent property and built 11 ponds on 22 acres of land.

Over the course of Abbuhl's life, more than 3,000 different species of trees and plants were planted in what became Pine Hollow Arboretum. The organization

became incorporated as a nonprofit in 2007. Upon his passing on January 6, 2018, at the age of 91, the arboretum was left to the community and open to the public.

About Pine Hollow Arboretum

The arboretum is open year-round, 365 days a year, dawn until dusk. It continues to thrive as a formal collection of specimen trees and woody plants to be enjoyed by residents and visitors. Sant'Angelo encourages patrons to check the premises out for hiking, dog walking, snowshoeing or cross-country skiing.

Coming soon to PHA will be Autumn at the Arboretum, held Saturday, Oct. 21. The event will feature pumpkin painting, wild birds of prey, tours of the arboretum, and fall foods including doughnuts.

Other fall based activities to be held at PHA also include Autumn yoga sessions sponsored by CDPHP, Spooky Lantern Walks, winter snowshoeing/cross-country skiing expos, and soon high school students will undergo training by staff to become docents in order to help lead elementary school students who visit the arboretum in the spring for educational field trips.

internal medicine practice group that is part of St. Peter's Health Partners Medical Associates, will close its Slingerlands office at 1240 New Scotland Road affecting over 4,500 patients.

According to an August 1 patient letter from SPHPMA Practice Administrator Kelley Williams, patients' care will be transferred automatically to Capital Region Family Health Care at 2 Empire Drive in East Greenbush, unless they opt for care outside of SPHPMA. The office's two doctors and its family nurse practitioner will also transfer to the new location, but the physician assistant will not.

No reason was given in the letter for the closing. However, when asked why the New Scotland Road location was closing, Robert Webster, Manager of Public Relations & Digital Communications, Corporate Communications for St. Peter's Health Partners stated that SPHPMA "is regularly looking to create efficiencies throughout our system of care, without compromising patient access or quality of care." He further explained, "As part of this effort, we work to identify opportunities where we can provide access to primary care providers who are also located near specialty offices and ancillary services. This increases the ability of our patients to engage with multiple health care services in a single location with ease."

During normal traffic, the relocation will add 15-25 minutes for Town of Bethlehem residents to get to the new location from the New Scotland Road office. Webster said that the practice's relocation of its three providers to the other SPHPMA site is "not expected to negatively impact patients' access, as those providers will still be available to their existing patients."

Although Webster said that it has been a mostly positive response from patients, individuals interviewed for this article about the re-location were split about the change, with younger patients seeming less concerned about the move.

"I didn't inquire about a closer practice because I am comfortable with the doctor I see, so I decided to stay even though it means going a

little further, said Glenmont resident Christina Shroud, 49.

Patient Kim Matura, 54, concurred. "The practice has been in about three different locations over the last 10 years. I will go wherever the doctor is because she's a rock star."

"It's just business. It's just the way it goes so I will go to the new office in Rensselaer," Joshua Blow, 51 a City of Albany resident said.

The practice's website touts that it is "conveniently located" and "offers patients the chance to establish relationships with our entire health care team."

Patients in their 60's and older who were interviewed were upset by the move because of the additional distance to see their primary care doctor. Elizabeth Blaber, 77, a Delmar resident, said she was very disappointed to get the letter. Blaber may leave the practice because of the longer travel distance.

"As I get older, I don't want to travel as far," she said, "I want something more convenient."

Blaber added she has spoken with two other practice patients who are very upset about the practice's move to East Greenbush.

"One person's husband is 88 and they live in Delmar and she is deciding what to do because of the distance." She said the other patient, like herself, is in her 70s, and is not a good driver and likes to stay close to home.

Both the August 1 letter and Webster indicated that patients could seek services from an SPHPMA primary care practice that is

geographically closer if the East Greenbush location is not convenient. According to Webster, five SPHPMA primary care sites are located within five miles of the 1240 New Scotland Road location, including 1444 Western Avenue and 400 Patroon Creek.

However, at least one patient reported when he called, he was told that those practices are not accepting new patients.

"I called them and they were clear that there is no choice," he stated. "Neither office is in a position to take patients from Bethlehem."

Another patient said he was accepted for care at the SPHPMA Western Avenue office and would move there because it is closer to his Delmar home. At the same time, he expressed "great sadness" at having to give up his long term doctor.

"I was heartbroken because I have seen this doctor for about 15 years since the practice was on Delaware Avenue", said Homi Mistry, 70. "I have to start with a new doctor and that is unfortunate because this doctor knows my medical history."

One patient in his 60s voiced the same concern. "The PA I dealt with is not moving to the new office so I have to start all over with building the relationship and familiarity with my case."

The picture of the general practitioner toting their medical bag that over years learns their patient's history and monitors the patient for new ailments is part of the American psyche. Today, however, only a fraction of all doctors in the U.S. are primary care doctors and most of them do not work for practices they own or even for other physicians, but are

employed by private equity investors or other corporate entities driven by economics.

If the SPHPMA patients opt to leave its network, the prime beneficiary of the Slingerlands office closing may be Community Care Physicians, a rival primary care practice located on Delaware Avenue in Delmar.

"We don't have any primary care practices closing and no changes in Delmar occurring," reported Alexis Musto, Senior Vice President, Marketing, Communications and Strategy for Community Care Physicians.

However, while Community Care has no plans to close its Delmar primary care practice, it already closed its urgent care facility located in Delmar.

Musto said the Delmar urgent care was closed "because of the proliferation of urgent cares in the area and expanded access in our offices, so there was less of a demand for this service." She added, "we currently have one urgent care in Latham."

Town residents seeking urgent care locally can go to either Medrite Delmar Urgent Care on Delaware Avenue or Albany Med

EmUrgent Care site on Glenmont Road in Glenmont.

Community Care and CDPHP moving in together in brand new space

While not moving its Delmar Delaware Avenue primary care office, Community Care will move all of its Latham offices, currently located at the Capital Region Health Park at 711-713 Troy Schenectady Road to a new \$90 million 260,000 square foot facility that it will share about 85,000 square feet with CDPHP. The building will house CDPHP's corporate headquarters that will move from Washington Avenue. Combined, CDPHP and Community Care will leave behind about 210,000 square feet of space currently used for administrative and clinical services. The facility is being built at a new location two miles away from the current Capital Region Health Park on Autopark Drive off of Route 9 and which has been renamed Wellness Way. The Latham urgent care will move with it.

Musto stated Community Care currently expects to open offices on the ground floor of the new building and will move in in phases beginning in February 2024 and the move completed by April 2024.

"Luckily, Wellness Way is only about two miles away [from the Latham offices] so the location will still be convenient for patients and our teams", said Musto.

Across the United States, a shortage of primary health care practitioners is growing.

Primary care doctor shortages delay access to primary care, a critical component of improving health and reducing overall health costs. Additional strain gets placed on hospital emergency rooms when primary care doctors are not available. "What happens in the middle of January when the snow is falling?" posed one practice patient. "My option will be to go to urgent care or the emergency room or to go see a doctor in East Greenbush." He suggested that East Greenbush will not be his choice.

"Leaving a family doctor is like leaving your spouse," one Slingerland's patient said.

more trails that are handicapped accessible, continue to keep their educational programs going for all ages, and maintain

their horticultural collection to a higher degree. The maintenance, however, would require additional staffing.

One day, the arboretum would like to turn John Abbuhl's home, a 1941 mid-century style home designed by architect Henry L. Blatner, into a welcome center. At the moment, staff have been able to rent out the home for small private events and

mission-related programs that help build up the funds to make necessary improvements to the home Sant'Angelo noted.

The transition of the home into a welcome center will be a big project for the arboretum and will take a great deal of fundraising,

development and volunteer work.

Sant'Angelo said the Level II accreditation as was something Abbuhl really wanted to see that happen for the Pine Hollow Arboretum.

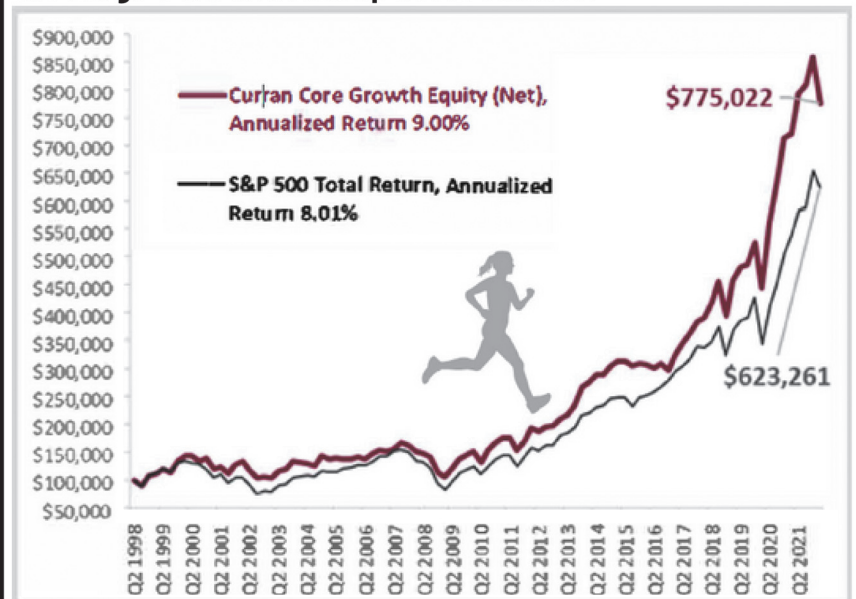

Fourth arrest in 16 days after judge releases woman

Sixth arrest for violating court orders and eight felony charges since March 8, but bail reform is not to blame

COLONIE - A Colonie woman with a long history of arrests for violating court orders of protection was arrested for the fourth time in 16 days on Sunday, Aug. 27, after Colonie Town Judge David Green told police to release the woman on an appearance ticket 10 days earlier.

According to police reports, Colonie police arrested and charged Joyia Camaj, 40, of Colonie, on Thursday, Aug. 17 at 9:12 p.m. with burglary-criminal intent, criminal intent in the first degree and aggravated family offense, all felonies.

Police contacted Green, the on-call Town Judge, to come to the court to arraign Camaj. Green requested they release her on an appearance ticket for Aug. 30, according to the police report.

Under the 2023 bail reforms that took effect in June, a judge can set bail on a charge of criminal contempt in the first degree when it involves an order of protection. This case does.

According to a New York State Office of Judicial Support document that details issuing securing orders in town and village courts, criminal contempt in the first degree is eligible “only when the underlying allegation is that the defendant violated a duly served order of protection where the protected party is a member of the defendant’s same family or house.”

A family member of Camaj, who is the victim in most of the cases, has orders of protection from Camaj by Colonie Town Court. Camaj has violated those orders no fewer than six times since March 8.

In addition, Camaj was charged with criminal contempt in the first degree four times, but bail has to be set at arraignment by a judge, and this is the third time since March she was released on an appearance ticket.

In addition to the last two, Camaj had been arrested the prior day, Aug. 16, for criminal contempt - physical contact, a felony, and harassment, a misdemeanor, and arrested on Aug. 11 for felony criminal possession of a weapon (a knife), and menacing with a weapon for an

incident on Aug. 9 where she allegedly threatened tenants who rent an apartment on the property listed as her residence.

Camaj has 20 arrests on her record, according to the Albany County District Attorney’s office. If any two of those arrests led to felony convictions, a judge would be required to remand her to jail without bail as a persistent felony offender, but none of these apply until the defendant is arraigned.

Camaj was transported from the Albany County jail on Aug. 30, where she had been housed since the last arrest, to appear in Colonie Town Court. Judge Green set bail at \$5,000 or bond. She is scheduled back in court on Sept. 18.

Camaj was in court on June 20, where she pleaded down one felony and four misdemeanor counts from three separate arrests in March. Because the final, consolidated plea was not a felony, it stayed in Colonie Town Court. In those cases, she was arrested on March 6, 8 and 22.

All of those charges stem from domestic incidents where an order of

protection was violated.

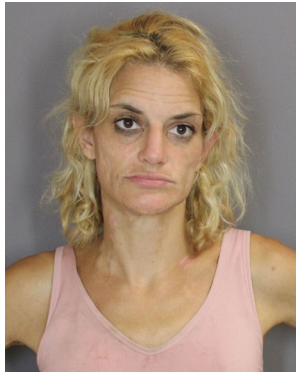
On all three arrests she was released on an appearance ticket, including one that included the felony charge. On March 8, Green was contacted by police at approximately 6 a.m., and he advised them to issue an appearance ticket for court on March 15.

At that point Green issued a no-illegal contact order of protection, where Camaj would be allowed to live or be near the victim, but not have any criminal activity near them. That was replaced with a full-stay away order in August. Neither seemed to work.

Green did not return a message for comment. Judges cannot comment on specific cases in front of them, but can speak about general policies.

Spotlight News contacted the New York State Office of Judicial Support and the Unified Court System for clarification on the most recent guidance on setting bail in Town and Village Courts.

Both responded and will clarify guidance on charges that were issued in this case. They will not comment on any specific case, but did not have a response by press time. Visit Spotlightnews.com for updates to this story.

under conditions for an earlier charge and the new charge was a felony, the judge can consider bail in this case.

McQueen was also turned over to Colonie police on Thursday, Aug. 10 on an outstanding warrant for not showing up for court, but this is not the first time in the area she has been wanted for allegedly stealing.

McQueen was detained by North Greenbush police

for other reasons and was processed on the open Colonie bench warrant. McQueen was arraigned by Colonie Town Judge David Green.

She was charged with three counts of grand larceny, a felony, and bail jumping, a misdemeanor, for three separate incidents in October.

The original charges of grand larceny charges were not bail eligible initially,

but it was not the first time in the jurisdictions that Spotlight News covers that she was charged with stealing.

On June 20, McQueen and Desiree Fowler, 19, were detained by Albany police for not showing up for court for an August 2022 larceny at Price Chopper in Slingerlands. They were put under the supervision of probation at that time, but McQueen was not released at that point because she was wanted by Glenville police on an additional warrant there.

Rebirth Brass Band headlines Albany's Riverfront Jazz Fest

Performers include a mix of seasoned musicians and those on the cusp of making it big

ALBANY — At Jennings Landing in Albany on Sept. 9, the 21st annual Albany Riverfront Jazz Festival will present a full day of family-friendly and free music, vendors and activities.

Keith Morales, special events coordinator for the City of Albany Office of Cultural Affairs, reflected recently on the festival's legacy of high-caliber musical performers, which has included Grammy-winning Samara Joy. He said people can expect more of the same this year.

"I think attendees can most look forward to a diverse and strong musical

lineup from the top to bottom," he said.

More than 20 different vendors will be part of the day of music.

Food vendor Peter Delgado, owner of Gina Foods, said he was excited to be offering festival attendees something new this year — Greek gyros.

"I'm going to be listening to amazing music and at the same time offering fantastic Greek gyros," he said.

Festivities take place from noon-8 p.m. A presentation of the Henry Johnson Community Service Award Ceremony will take place during the day. The award is bestowed upon a nominated Albany resident who has made meaningful contributions to the community.

Starting the festival at 12:30 p.m. is jazz musician Kevin McNeal and his band BluesWing. Originally from Upstate New York and now residing

in New York City, McNeal has been playing in the jazz and blues music scene for decades. From his performance in the HBO show "Boardwalk Empire," to composing, education and original music, McNeal is recognized throughout the United States and Europe as an innovator in the jazz scene.

At 2 p.m., Ashley Keiko will take the stage. As a musician, composer, and singer-songwriter, her diverse musical talents have led her to study classical piano and alto saxophone and open Keiko Studios. Festival attendees can enjoy Keiko's original, expressive style that smoothly combines the genres of hip-hop, R&B, pop, and gospel.

At 3:30 p.m., innovative drummer Roni Kaspi will

perform. In 2020, Kaspi had a massive break into the music scene as the international touring drummer in the global jazz bass sensation Avishai Cohen trio. Her genre-bending music is a creative, all-embracing meld of alt-pop, soul, world music and electronica.

"We always bring in the top rising jazz artists in the genre, along with one or two already established artists, like the Grammy



award-winning Rebirth Brass Band," said Morales. "That's what makes the lineup so special. We strive to find the next big jazz artist like Ashley Keiko, Roni Kaspi, and The String Queens, who are on this year's lineup and on the cusp of breaking out."

At 5 p.m., The String Queens will present an authentic, soulful and orchestral sound that seamlessly glides through decades and styles. With a diverse musical repertoire that spans from the Baroque era to the Billboard Top 100 Chart, they guide audiences on a musical journey through time and genres.

The Grammy-winning Rebirth Brass Band will close out the night of performances at 6:30 p.m. They are a pillar of the New

Orleans music scene with their iconic, long-standing presence at the Tuesday night gig at the Maple Leaf Bar. Since their formation in 1983 by the Frazier brothers, the Rebirth Brass Band has melded brass band music, funk, jazz, soul and hip-hop together with their signature style.

"Attendees can look forward to an amazing vibe with great food vendors and an amazing fireworks display following the show over the river," said Morales.

At 8 p.m., a fireworks show is planned as a dazzling end to the evening of festivities.

“That’s just amazing to me because it’s something that requires a lot of work,” Sajan said. “This is super unique because, with mentorships, internships, and even doing a passion project, a lot of people do it on their own and without guidance. In this program, we give you the guidance that you need.”

Board member Hanh Nguyen said Saturday Scholars’ main initiative right now is mentorship.

“[Saturday Scholars] has been around for about two years now, and we’ve had good success with that,” Nguyen said. “Two hundred students have gone through the mentorship programs, and 100 passion projects have been made. That has been our most successful initiative so far.”

Current programs include mentorship programs, virtual shadowing sessions with STEM professionals and career webinars. Organizers plan to eventually use libraries and schools as resources to allow students to explore science topics and do easy experiments.

From showing their high school peers how to craft a resume to joining an internship program, the Saturday Scholars’ plan is to keep branching out to K-12 students.

“We want to have multiple opportunities available,” said Nguyen.

The mentorship program is three months long. Board member Nguyet-Vien Le took part

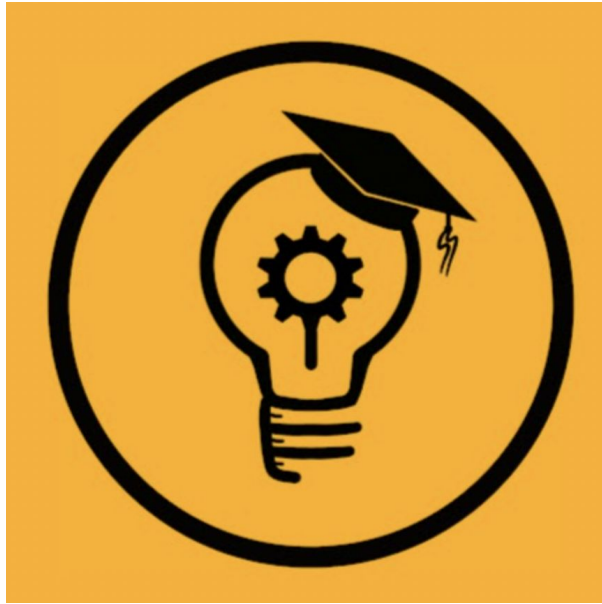
over the winter session. For her, it solidified her focus on what STEM can do for the world and the importance of making it accessible to everyone.

“When we look at STEM, a lot of people view

it as this daunting thing that a lot of people are afraid to go into,” she said. “It seems like there’s so much knowledge and connections needed. But STEM was never intended to keep people out. Accessibility breaks down the wall that people create when they look at STEM. By having it be accessible, people can see it for what it really is, and by having more opportunities for people to pursue STEM, it increases people’s interests and makes them less afraid.”

Le acknowledged how STEM can be late nights spent reading thick books, lab coats and beakers, or complex math equations. But beyond the perceptions and realities of it, “it’s one of the many things that’s propelling our world forward,” she emphasized. “It’s finding solutions to the problems that people may be having.”

By expanding to include a younger audience of children, the intent is to



encourage people to see it as not just a career path but also as something with daily application for everyone.

“Right now, people know about STEM, but they just see it as a career option. I feel like students, especially younger children, don’t really understand the benefits of STEM, the potential it has, the different categories, and the different careers and opportunities that come with STEM,” said Sajan. “Part of where we are expanding is having these events for younger kids. It shows not the career part of STEM but the fun part of STEM because STEM is fun and it shouldn’t be just an educational thing. There are many aspects to it. It’s not just something you look into when looking for a job or thinking about your future.”

Sajan connects her childhood spent building with Legos, dried pasta and cardboard to the engineering and STEM fields that she is now interested in.

“If you’re exposed to it when you’re younger, you’ll know what courses you want to take and be on the right path,” she said.

Nguyen said that for younger kids, the way that

schools teach science, engineering and math may not be compatible with their way of learning, and this might be their only chance to enjoy these subjects.

“A lot of times, the way that the school curriculum is structured, there isn’t much room for fun and exploration, especially in science,” said Nguyen. “A lot of things become graded as you get older, and there are stakes in each assignment. I think that’s the main reason why we wanted to start these programs for younger kids. They have the chance to explore STEM for what it is, to enjoy it, and to have fun. There are no stakes and no pressure.”

Many STEM programs are not easily accessible for all students and are often affiliated with a college or a prestigious institution.

“Our program is so that STEM can be accessible to anyone, and it’s not too difficult to join the mentorship programs

or a webinar,” said Nguyen. “Students have freedom to explore what they want to do versus what they don’t.”

Sajan being virtual gives the program a greater reach.

“I think this program is special because there are just so many tools available, and we’re adding more tools that are helpful to high school students, little kids, and middle school students — a really large audience,” said Sajan.

The September calendar for The Saturday Scholars is busy, with sign-ups available for the workshops that center on resume-building and internship applications. Plans include an in-person event in October that is

designed especially for children to educate them about cancer. From October to December, there is the STEM mentorship program. Mentors are a wide range of STEM professionals, from neuroscientists to engineers.

Individuals are encouraged to reach out on the Saturday Scholars website or social media if they are interested in pursuing the program as students or for their children.

“Through Saturday Scholars, it makes it easier because they help you along the way,” said Le. “In the end, we all get more opportunities to benefit from and pursue STEM to our hearts content.”

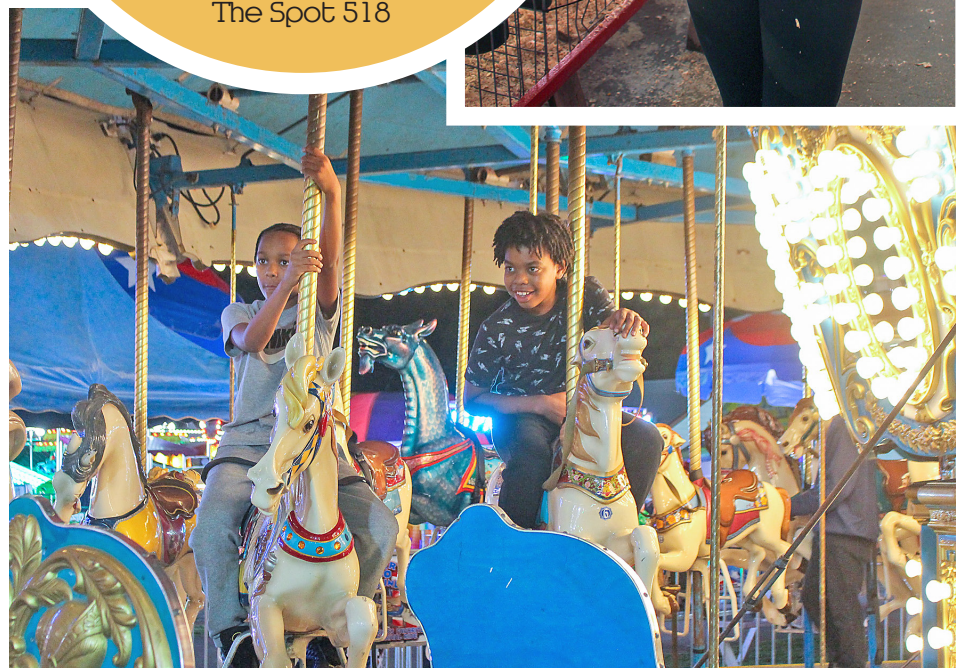

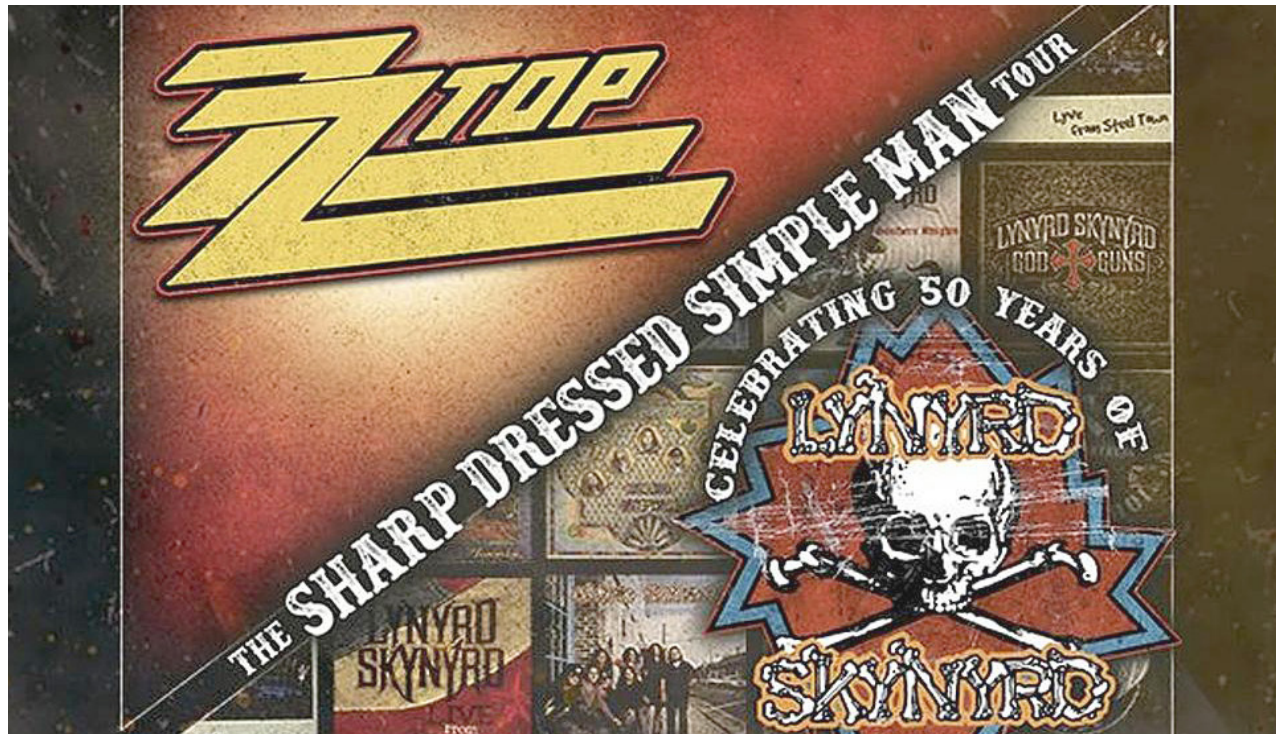

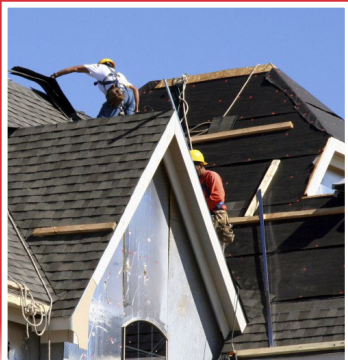

Kitchen cabinets: reface or replace?

The kitchen is a busy room in many homes. That popularity likely has something to do with why so many homeowners spend sizable sums renovating their kitchens. According to highlights from the 2022 U.S. Houzz Kitchen Trends Study, the median spend on major kitchen remodels grew by 14 percent from the previous year, and minor remodels increased by 25 percent. Spurred on by increased time spent at home during the pandemic, the main impetus for kitchen remodels according to the study was that homeowners wanted to make



these improvements all along and finally had the time and means to do so.

There are many aspects of a kitchen that homeowners can change. Houzz found 94 percent of renovators either

fully or partially replaced cabinets in their improvement plans. Cabinets are a major component of kitchen layouts. Cabinets help to establish the aesthetic of a kitchen and serve a useful function, providing

necessary storage space to ensure the room does not appear cluttered.

Homeowners have different options when it comes to cabinet renovations, and they may need to decide if they need to replace or reface their cabinets.

Replacement

Cabinet replacement involves removing all of the existing cabinets before new cabinets are leveled and installed. According to the home improvement resource The Spruce, homeowners can expect to pay between \$13,000 and \$30,000 for contractor grade cabinets. Cabinet replacement is a good idea when homeowners want to add more cabinet space or create a new layout in the room.

Refacing

Cabinet refacing is less messy and less disruptive than replacement. All cabinets remain the same size and in the same location. The cabinet boxes must be in good shape to facilitate a refacing. The process involves installation of new drawer fronts and cabinet doors, as well as veneering of the cabinet boxes. New hardware typically is installed as well. The insides of the cabinets typically remain the same. The Spruce says cabinet refacing can be 30 to 50 percent cheaper than a replacement.

Most people call in professionals to change their cabinets. Cabinet replacement can be a do-it-yourself job, but it involves measuring and ensuring everything fits and is leveled appropriately. Homeowners who choose to reface their cabinets themselves may opt to paint or restain. Wood veneer or a new door and drawer panel installation can be complicated and is best left to qualified contractors.

Chocolate dessert with a healthy twist



People often hear the word “dessert” and immediately think of a calorie- and fat-laden decadence that may set them back several hours on the treadmill. While it is true that some desserts can pack a heavy punch, others need not make people fear for their waistslines.

Desserts that feature healthy ingredients can tempt your sweet tooth and provide nutritional benefits. Such is the case when combining pomegranate and dark chocolate, two ingredients that are rich in antioxidants that can contribute to a healthier immune system. “Chocolate Covered Pomegranate Clusters” can be served as the culmination of a fancy dinner in decorative martini glasses, or taken along as a

healthy trail mix of sorts in school or work lunch boxes. Enjoy this recipe, courtesy of John La Puma, M.D., ChefMD. At only 108 calories per serving, this dessert likely won't compromise any meal plans.

1/4 cup fresh basil, stemmed and julienned
 * 2/3 cup (4 ounces) high quality dark chocolate, chopped fine,
 may replace the chocolate chips

Chocolate Covered Pomegranate Clusters

Servings: 4

- 1 cup (8 ounces) pomegranate arils
- 2/3 cup (4 oz) organic bittersweet chocolate chips, such as Ghirardelli 60%
- 1/4 teaspoon turmeric
- 1/8 teaspoon black pepper

Set the pomegranate arils on paper towels to absorb any excess moisture. Melt chocolate chips in a heavy-bottomed small saucepan over low-to-medium heat, stirring frequently, 2 to 3 minutes. Remove saucepan from the burner. Add pomegranate seeds and stir in spices. Use a fork to scoop out small chocolate-covered clusters, and place each on a wax paper-lined plate. Garnish with mint. Refrigerate until chocolate is firm, about 15 minutes.
