Upgrade improves drainage and will extend usage

DELMAR - The grass is forever greener at Bethlehem Central High School with the completion of a synthetic turf field behind the high school. The \$5.25 million project began in April after being approved by voters as part of the \$40.7 million 2021 Facilities

Improvement Project.

On Tuesday, Sept. 5, the turf field saw its first game with the varsity boys soccer team taking on Ballston Spa High School and winning 6-0, even though renovations are not fully complete.

“We want to provide our coaching staff and our athletes with the assets the competition has, and although we’ve been strong in many sports for many years, this will continue to elevate our program,” Bethlehem Athletic Director Leonard Kies said.

In August 2021, the school’s Board of

Education voted overwhelmingly in favor of the artificial turf field, and in spring of this year, construction crews broke ground to set up the foundation for the field and install the new playing surface. A similar proposal for a turf football field, \$3.5 million at the time, was voted down in 2013.

According to District Spokeswoman JoEllen Gardner, the community response to the field has been very positive.

Report details potential causes of bridge collapse

Albany County releases report that blames bridge's unique design

SLINGERLANDS - Albany County released an engineer's report that discussed the causes of the July 12 collapse of the new County Rail Trail Bridge over Route 85 in Slingerlands on Thursday, Sept. 7 after refusing to release it in August, according to the Times Union.

The County commissioned the report, which was completed on August 4, to determine what caused the collapse.

The report found that the new bridge's unique design placed added stress on transition points in the girders. Girders, the long pieces of steel which make up the sides of the bridge and help support its deck,

buckled as concrete was being poured into it.

The unusual design was meant to mimic the old span, which was built in the early 1900's, and included a step design where the ends of the girders are thinner then transition to a thicker profile across the middle of the span.

The five-page report, completed by Brett Reynolds of Colliers Engineering and Design, noted that the engineering firm that designed the bridge, M.J. Engineering and Land Surveying, did not take into account that the design would put added stress on the girders.

In Reynolds' report, the unique design of the two girders used to help support the bridge's span, but had stress points in two locations where at the top of the girder, called a flange, had transitioned from deeper to shallower sections. Meaning, that the transition went in a "step" configuration from horizontal to vertical.

"The abrupt compression flange transition in the step pattern at the bridge can result in a concentration of stresses being imparted into the web at the location of the transition," the report said. "It does not appear this additional stress concentration in the webs at the transition locations were considered. As the web and vertical stiffeners are consistent across the entire length of the girder, it does not appear that the design accounted for this additional stress concentration at the webs

at the step location." In addition, Reynolds added that it does not appear that the construction means and methods were the cause of the collapse.

But other factors may have contributed to the failure. An inspection at the fabricator of the girders also found problems with design when they were manufacturing the steel spans.

"It appears that the shop inspection identified geometry issues during the fabrication of the

girders. Additional stresses from beam fabrication (eventually approved by designer) could have contributed to the overall stresses that eventually led to the failure," the report said.

Determining who pays for the replacement.

Albany County is currently discussing with insurance companies as it needs to seek reimbursement of approximately \$600,000 to cover the cost and removal of the damaged bridge and the leasing and installation of a new temporary bridge. The new bridge will have to be redesigned and fabricated and it is estimated that it will take

more than a year to get the permanent span in place.

The project originally began in March to raise the low-lying bridge over New Scotland Road and Route 85. The span was hit by trucks frequently causing DOT to shut down the road.

Construction of the temporary steel bridge will begin Monday, Oct. 2 and is slated to be completed by Tuesday, Oct. 31. The county will also install a pedestrian railing along the sidewalk of the road.

The pedestrian and bicycle detour will remain in place for the rail trail until bridge construction is complete.

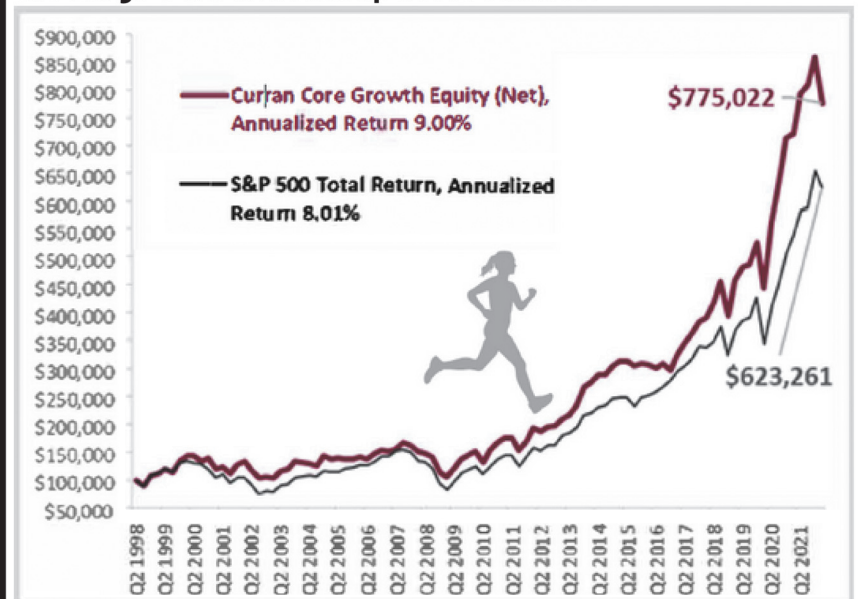

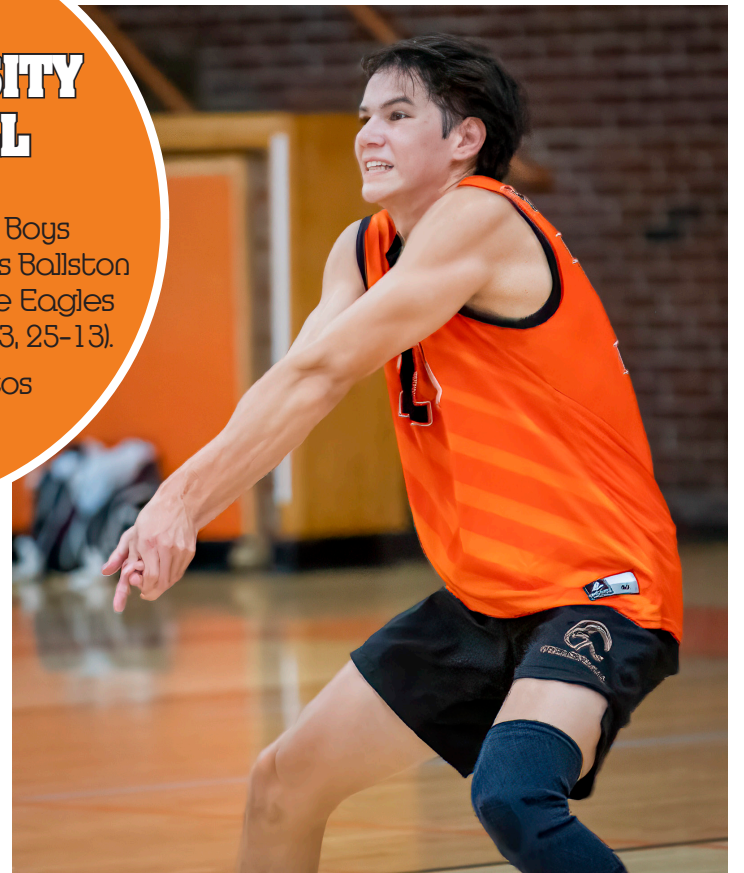

Heath Farm project moves forward

Heath Farm Advisory Committee to convene in October

DELMAR –Moving past a brief delay caused by summer vacations, the Town will spend September interviewing candidates who have applied to serve on the 10 member Historic Heath Farm Advisory Committee. Open Space Coordinator Lauren Axford expects interviews to be completed this month and that the committee will have its first meeting by late October.

Axford said the Town “cast a wide net” to attract applications from as many stakeholders as possible. She reported that applications received included ones from people who were not previously involved in Town committees.

The committee will

provide insight and technical guidance to help the town craft an overall vision for the properties and structures on the 307 acre Heath Farm property purchased by the Town last year.

In the meantime, the Town’s outside consultant will prepare a report summarizing the comments received by the Town through its interactive “story map” feedback survey that was posted on line. Axford, who has not yet seen the comments, stated that the report will be used by the Town and the Committee as a “starting point” to “inform what happens next” with the project’s direction.

Axford added that she was excited that descendants of the Heath family, whose great grandparents and grandparents operated the farm, reached out and offered to provide old photos of the farm during its “heyday”. “The family was thrilled with the project,” she said.

“Most of the feedback that we’re seeing from here are from athletic teams, who are starting to use the facility for their practices, and they are thrilled,” she said.

Apart from the turf itself, several other improvements are in the works for the new field, including bleachers seating up to 1,000 people, a scoreboard, a press box, new lights and a concession building with restrooms. The scoreboard is expected to be completed by early October, and the bleachers are expected by early to mid-October. The entire project, including lighting, brickwork and the concession building, is expected to be done before Thanksgiving, according to Kies.

“We expect it to be the absolute finest facility for [lacrosse, field hockey, and soccer] in the area,” Kies said, adding that he hopes that these capital improvements will bring greater visibility to the school and local community, and potentially make Bethlehem a candidate for hosting sectional, regional, or even state championships.

The turf field will be primarily used by the boys and girls soccer and lacrosse teams, as well as the girls field hockey team. The field is also intended for use by physical education teachers during the school day. Other sports teams, such as the football team, can

also use the field to practice. However, the primary teams, which Kies said needed the dry playing surface more, will take precedence.

Other upgrades

Other capital improvements have been made to Bethlehem’s athletic facilities. The track and tennis courts have been resurfaced and restriped, and the softball field is currently undergoing construction to add permanent fences, foul poles, and new dugouts. Renovations have also been made to one of the school’s three gyms (Gym A) by replacing the wall pads, basketball backboards and hoops.

A ribbon-cutting ceremony is planned for the full completion of the field, although no date has been set. Officials hope that the ribbon-cutting will coincide with the school’s homecoming events.

Leveling the playing field

While the similar proposal from 2013 was voted down at the time, the popularity of turf fields in the area has grown in recent years. Shaker, Guilderland, Niskayuna, Shenendahawah, Troy and Albany high schools, among others in upstate New York, have installed synthetic turf fields. Such fields have improved drainage over grass fields, extending playing seasons.

Due to heavy rains, the grass fields at Bethlehem are often swamped, sometimes rendering them unusable.

“It was very disruptive not only to the athletics schedule but also to

the instructional schedule,” Gardner said. According to Kies, such drainage issues have caused many cancellations, and forced teams to move to modified fields for sectional playoffs and other important games.

In 2019, the Bethlehem girls’ lacrosse team lost a regular season championship. The team had the best overall record in the league at the time, and was preparing for their final game of the season before playoff spots would be determined. However, the grass fields and the football field at Bethlehem were all too wet to play on. The school asked Columbia to play on their field, but they declined. The final game went unplayed, setting the Bethlehem team behind in playoffs.

The new turf field at Bethlehem, however, sports much better drainage than the grass before it. During the construction and testing process, 75 gallons of water were dumped in an area on the field. Within a couple of minutes, the turf was dry again.

With the installation of the new turf, Bethlehem sports teams and physical education classes alike will be on more equal footing with the rest of the state, according to Kies. Alongside the permanent stitched lines on the field, the improved drainage will allow for longer and more consistent use.

“You provide our coaching staff and our athletes with the assets the competition has,” Kies said, “and although we’ve been strong in many sports for many years, this will continue to elevate our program.”

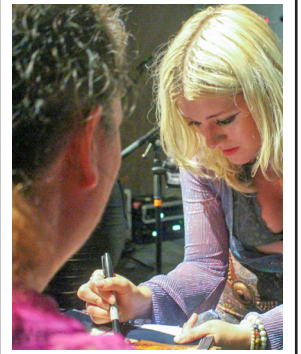

Event celebrates area's harvest

Apple and Wine Festival to feature tastings, music and more

ALTAMONT — Returning to the Capital District for the 29th year is the Capital Apple and Wine Festival. The family-friendly festival, hosted by Starbird Events, will take place at the Altamont Fairgrounds on Sept. 16 and 17.

“We are excited to bring back this popular event now in its 29th year,” said Cheryl Dooley who co-founded Starbird Events with her husband, Charley.

The event was originated by Altamont Orchards. Starbird Events took over the festival last year, following its hiatus due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

“We will be providing pours of New York State beer and wine— and of course, Nine Pin Cider,” said Nine Pin Cider event coordinator Jessica Riordan.

Live music will be performed on both days. Mentioned in Billboard Magazine as one of Irish

music’s biggest sellers, the renowned Celtic band Hair of the Dog will take the stage on Saturday. “They are a regional music treasure,” noted the Daily Freeman in 2008.

On Sunday, the Tom Petty tribute band The Broken Hearted will perform. The band melds their love of performing with Petty’s iconic style of Tom Petty.

The festival, which is estimated to draw crowds of more than 100,000 people over the course of four days, is free to attend and offers visitors an opportunity to explore the aviation tradition that inspired its founder, Walter Grishkot. The Adirondack Balloon Festival ranks as the third largest in the country.

“It’s an event like no other,” said Coker, describing how the Adirondack Balloon Festival is “a tradition for families and pilots across the state, country and also internationally.”

The Adirondack Balloon Festival has been named one of the Top 100 events in North America and has received accolades from the Weather Channel, Food Network, and other media outlets. Throughout the years, the event has drawn international exposure for the Glens Falls region, with relationships being formed worldwide from Saga, Japan, to Gatineau, Quebec.

The event is entirely organized by volunteers who

work to uphold the values originally implemented half a century ago.

“People tend to be very surprised when they find out that a core of 15 people, all volunteers, put together such an amazing and successful event each year,” said Coker. “There has always been a sense of pride that the event is run strictly by volunteers.”

Coker said the festival has far-reaching effects on the local economy and community.

“We can’t have a successful event without the support of Warren County, as well as local businesses that generously support the event,” he said. “It’s an amazing event that really does benefit local

businesses like restaurants, hotels and more.”

One of the festival’s most important goals is to remain non-commercial and free, as well as a significant fundraiser for local non-profit groups such as Rotary, World Awareness Children’s Museum, The Open Door Mission, and others. Over the past 49 years, the event has raised close to a million dollars for the organizations.

To celebrate the landmark anniversary, this year’s event includes a gala on Sept. 20 at Hiland Park Golf Club in Queensbury. The cost is \$40 to attend and is open to the public, with tickets available on their website. The gala will feature memorabilia and the commemoration of the “pioneer pilots” who attended the event within the first couple years of its creation.

To end the gala, a particularly dazzling show is planned.

“Lastly, we will have a moonglow with roughly 10 balloons close to sunset,” said Coker.

balloons will launch into the air in mass ascensions of 70 or more, including the fan favorite “special shape” balloons.

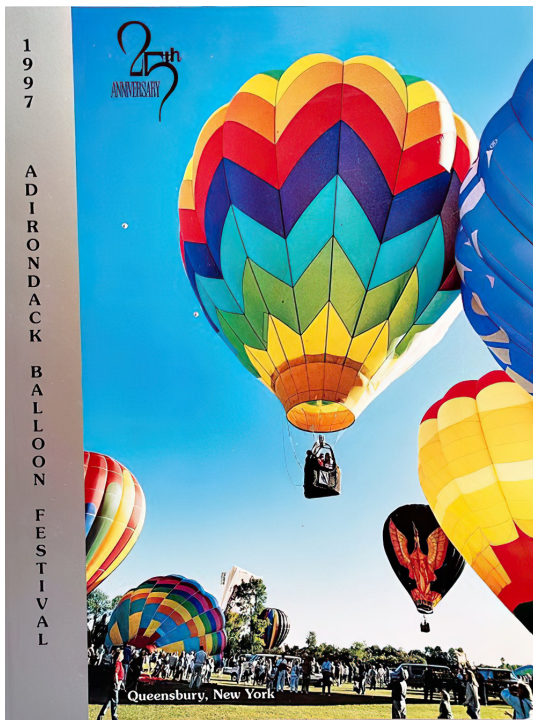
“We will have a record number of ‘special shapes’ from national and international pilots,” said Coker.

Local playwright brings life story to stage

Brian Sheldon's 'Custom Cuts' set in Schenectady'

AVERILL PARK - Playwright and executive director of Sand Lake Center for the Arts in Averill Park Brian Sheldon's original screenplay will make its world premiere at the Albany Barn later this month.

Sheldon said "Custom Cuts," which is based on his life in the City of Schenectady, is about learning who you are and having the courage to trust yourself.

A free preview will be held Wednesday, Sept. 20, with an official opening Thursday, Sept. 21. The play will run through Sept. 30. There will be Talkback Fridays on both Sept. 22 and Sept. 29 as a way for the audience to connect to the production and ask the playwright and the production team questions.

"Custom Cuts" is directed by Angela Ledtke and assisted by Olivia Walton, produced by Amy Hausknecht and stage managed by Lisa Brynk. Also making their stage debut is a diverse cast featuring Aaliyah Al-Fuhaid (as Jo), Debby Bercier (Janet), Tyler Cardona (Anthony), Peter Delocis (Danny), Gabriel Fabian (Matt), and Jason Stewart (Stone) as Al.

The play is Harbinger Theatre's first world premiere according to White. "Custom Cuts" is a locally written play and White wants to give Sheldon the "absolutely best production that we can for his play," he said.

The story takes place inside a dining room of an Electric City apartment that is shared by Danny (Delocis) and his son, Anthony (Cardona). Danny is having difficulty cleaning up the remains of his failed salon business. Anthony, who is a full-time cosmetology student, is also working in a full-time factory position. Although Danny is well-loved by his clients and has full-support from his son, he continues to walk a thin line between maintaining the business that he had always dreamed of and also wanting a social life. Tensions begin to run high between Danny and Anthony as the debts from the business pile up.

Meanwhile, Anthony's sister Jo (Al-Fuhaid) wants her father and step-father, Al (Stewart "Stone"), to walk her down the wedding aisle. However, Danny's pride remains dominant in giving into Jo's request.

The divide between Danny and Al eventually tests Anthony's love and loyalty, thus opening the door to his own personal and professional freedom.

In addition to Sheldon, the play will be produced by Harbinger Theatre's co-founder, acting coach, and theater journalist Patrick White. "Custom Cuts", according to White, is the tenth Capital Region Premiere and the 10th play that Harbinger Theatre has produced since their premiere production of "The Christians" by Lucas Hnath in December 2021.

White and other committee members in the theater group chose "Custom Cuts" for the 2023 play season. White and his production team had commissioned Emily Kleinland to create the play's poster and also worked with the REP to use 12 4'x8' platforms for the Albany Barn's seating arrangement.

The Audition Process

White and Sheldon recruited director Angela Ledtke to direct "Custom Cuts". Ledtke then recommended actors Vlad Panchishak, Mike

Halkitis, and Cailyn Stevens for Harbinger's productions of "Admissions" and "Exit Strategy" as well as with her connections with Public Defenders to recruit actors Tyler Cardona, Gabriel Fabian, and Jason Stewart (Stone). White also gave Olivia Walton her first assistant director role, having previously appeared in three Harbinger productions, "Hurricane Diane", "Andy and the Orphans", and "The Agony & the Agony".

"Harbinger continues to impress me (and) I am growing more and more fond of what they are doing. When they said they wanted to do a full production of 'Custom Cuts' when I was hoping for a table read, I was floored." Sheldon said. "I am extremely proud of Harbinger's willingness to try a never before seen play. It is yet another example of how they are setting the bar higher for other Capital Region theaters."

Sheldon and White Partnership

Sheldon is no stranger to working alongside White. This summer, Sheldon served as a member of Harbinger's playwrighting committee to choose the plays to produce for the 2024 season.

Rehearsals for "Custom Cuts" have been held at The Playhouse Stage Studios and watching the actors portray Sheldon's "family" rehearse has been "exciting" for both Brian Sheldon and White.

"They (the actors) are playing so well off each other and keeping it real, it is just bursting to life." White said.

Sheldon would not be where he is in his life personally and creatively without his entire family, especially his young son Benjamin whom he wants to expose the creative arts to.

"Without art, without theater, without music and art, I would not be who I am." Sheldon said.

Quick and filling meal served up in a snap



After the lazy days of summer, fall often arrives with packed schedules and everyone getting back on track, whether for work or school. Busy families may not have much time to spend in the kitchen these days, but they don't need to devote hours to cooking. Even quick meals can serve up significant flavor.

In the time it takes to boil rice, this recipe for "Creamy Rice With Roasted Shrimp and Tomatoes," courtesy of "Real Simple Dinner Tonight: Done" (Time Home Entertainment) from the editors of Real Simple, can be put on the table. Arborio rice makes this dish creamy, but if it's unavailable, long-grain rice also can be used — just follow the package directions for cooking.

Creamy Rice With Roasted Shrimp and Tomatoes

Serves 4

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 onion, finely chopped
- 1 cup Arborio rice
- 1 cup dry white wine
- Kosher salt and black pepper
- 1 pound peeled and deveined medium shrimp
- 2 pints grape tomatoes
- 8 sprigs fresh thyme
- 2 cloves garlic

Heat oven to 400 F. Heat 1 tablespoon of the oil in a large saucepan over medium heat. Add the onion and cook until soft, 5 to 7 minutes. Add the rice and wine and cook, stirring, until the wine is absorbed, 1 to 2 minutes.

Add 2 cups water and 1/4 teaspoon each salt and pepper to the saucepan. Simmer, covered, until the water is absorbed and the rice is tender, 18 to 20 minutes.

Meanwhile, on a rimmed baking sheet, toss the shrimp, tomatoes, thyme, and garlic with the remaining tablespoon of oil and 1/2 teaspoon each salt and pepper. Roast until the shrimp are opaque throughout, 15 to 20 minutes. Serve over the rice.

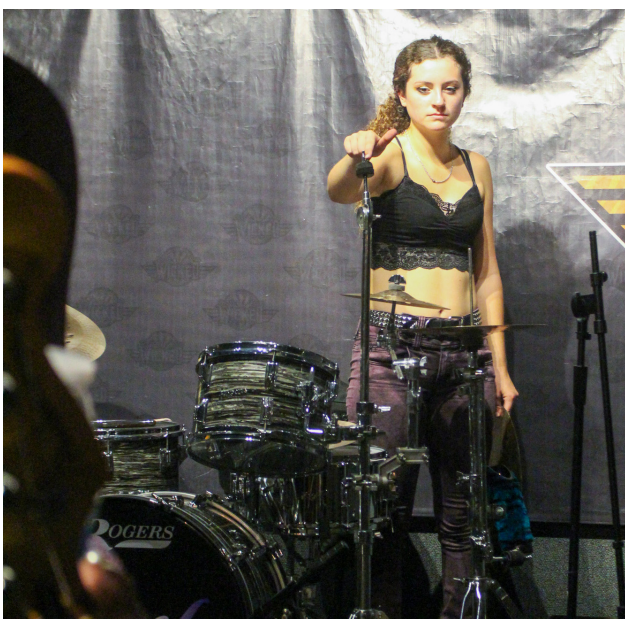

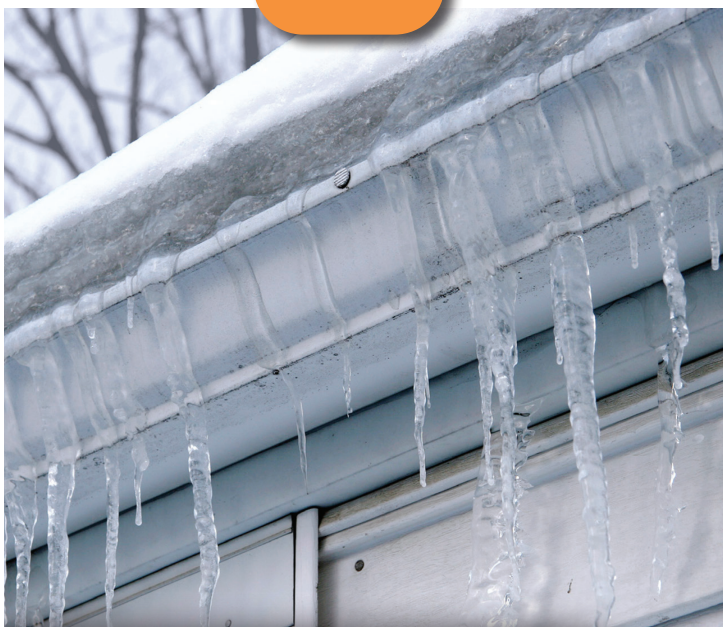
